Mat 12:33-37 (KJV) "**Either make the tree good, and his fruit good; or else make the tree corrupt, and his fruit corrupt: for the tree is known by his fruit. [34] O generation of vipers, how can ye, being evil, speak good things? for out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaketh. [35] A good man out of the good treasure of the heart bringeth forth good things: and an evil man out of the evil treasure bringeth forth evil things. [36] But I say unto you, That every idle word that men shall speak, they shall give account thereof in the day of judgment. [37] For by thy words thou shalt be justified, and by thy words thou shalt be condemned.**"

Luke 6:43-45 ""**For a good tree does not bear bad fruit, nor does a bad tree bear good fruit. [44] For every tree is known by its own fruit. For men do not gather figs from thorns, nor do they gather grapes from a bramble bush. [45] A good man out of the good treasure of his heart brings forth good; and an evil man out of the evil treasure of his heart brings forth evil. For out of the abundance of the heart his mouth speaks.**"

Luke 6:46-49 (KJV) "**And why call ye me, Lord, Lord, and do not the things which I say? [47] Whosoever cometh to me, and heareth my sayings, and doeth them [shema], I will show you to whom he is like: [48] He is like a man which built an house, and digged deep, and laid the foundation on a rock: and when the flood arose, the stream beat vehemently upon that house, and could not shake it: for it was founded upon a rock. [49] But he that heareth, and doeth not, is like a man that without a foundation built an house upon the earth; against which the stream did beat vehemently, and immediately it fell; and the ruin of that house was great.**"

Rom 2:13 (NIV) "For it is not those who hear the law who are righteous in God's sight, but **it is those who obey the law who will be declared righteous.**"

Psa 69:13-15 (NKJV) "But as for me, **my prayer is to You, O LORD, in the acceptable time; O God, in the multitude of Your mercy, Hear me in the truth of Your salvation [yesha':H3468]. [14] Deliver me out of the mire, And let me not sink; Let me be delivered from those who hate me, And out of the deep waters. [15] Let not the floodwater overflow me, Nor let the deep swallow me up; And let not the pit shut its mouth on me.**"

Prov 18:4 (NKJV) "The **words of a man's mouth are deep waters; The wellspring of wisdom is a flowing brook.**"

1 John 4:1 (NKJV) "Beloved, do not believe every spirit, but **test the spirits**, whether they are of God; because **many false prophets have gone out into the world.**"

Rev 12:15-16 (KJV) "**And the serpent cast out of his mouth water as a flood after the woman, that he might cause her to be carried away of the flood.** [16] And the earth helped the woman, and **the earth opened her mouth**, and swallowed up the **flood** which the dragon cast out of his mouth."

John 3:19 (KJV) "**And this is the condemnation, that light is come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil.**"

2 John 1:6 (NKJV) "**This is love, that we walk according to His commandments [Not ours].** This is the commandment, that as **you have heard from the beginning**, you should walk in it."

1 Sam 15:22 (NKJV) "Then Samuel said: "Has the LORD *as great* delight in burnt offerings and sacrifices, **As in obeying the voice of the LORD? Behold, to obey is better than sacrifice, And to heed than the fat of rams.**"

Titus 2:11-14 (KJV) "For **the grace of God that bringeth salvation** hath appeared to all men, [12] **Teaching** us that, **denying ungodliness** and **worldly lusts**, we **should live soberly, righteously, and godly, in this present world;** [13] Looking for that blessed hope, and the glorious appearing of the great God and our Saviour Jesus Christ; [14] Who gave himself for us, that he might **redeem us from all iniquity, and purify** unto himself a **peculiar people, zealous of good works.**"

Prov 10:21 (NKJV) "The lips of the righteous feed many, But **fools die for lack of wisdom.**"

Prov 12:13 (NKJV) "**The wicked is ensnared by the transgression of his lips**, But the **righteous** will come **through trouble.**"

3 John 1:11 (NKJV) "Beloved, **do not imitate what is evil**, but what is good. He **who does** good is of God, but **he who does evil has not seen God.**"

Prov 14:32 (NKJV) "The wicked is banished in his wickedness, **But the righteous has a refuge in his death.**"

John 12:25 (NKJV) ""**He who loves his life will lose it, and he who hates his life in this world will keep it for eternal life.**"

John 12:24 (NKJV) ""**Most assuredly, I say to you, unless a grain of wheat falls into the ground and dies, it remains alone; but if it dies, it produces much grain.**"

Gen 4:11 (NKJV) ""So now you *are* cursed from **the earth, which has opened its mouth to receive your brother's blood** from your hand."

Exo 15:9-13 (NKJV) "**The enemy said, 'I will pursue, I will overtake, I will divide the spoil; My desire shall be satisfied on them. I will draw my sword, My hand shall destroy them.'** [10] You blew with Your wind, The sea covered them; They sank like lead in the mighty waters. [11] "Who *is* like You, O LORD, among the gods? Who *is* like You, glorious in holiness, Fearful in praises, doing wonders? [12] **You stretched out Your right hand; The earth swallowed them.** [13] You in Your mercy have led forth The people whom You have redeemed; You have guided *them* in Your strength To Your holy habitation."

Num 16:30-32 (NKJV) ""But if the LORD creates a new thing, and **the earth opens its mouth and swallows them up** with all that belongs to them, and they go down **alive into the pit**, then you will understand **that these men have rejected the LORD.**" [31] Now it came to pass, as he finished speaking all these words, that the ground split apart under them, [32] and **the earth opened its mouth and swallowed them up**, with their households and all the men with Korah, with all *their* goods."

Isa 5:13-15 (NKJV) "Therefore my people have gone into captivity, Because **they have no knowledge; Their honorable men are famished, And their multitude dried up with thirst.** [14] **Therefore Sheol has enlarged itself And opened its**

mouth beyond measure; Their glory and their multitude and their pomp, And he who is jubilant, shall descend into it. [15] **People shall be brought down, Each man shall be humbled, And the eyes of the lofty shall be humbled."**

1 Cor 2:8 (NKJV) "which none of the rulers of this age knew; for had they known, they would not have crucified the Lord of glory."

John 5:28-29 (NKJV) ""Do not marvel at this; for the hour is coming in which all who are in the graves will hear His voice [29] "and come forth; those who have **done good**, to the **resurrection of life**, and those who have **done evil**, to the **resurrection of condemnation**."

1 Cor 15:26 (NKJV) "The **last enemy that will be destroyed is death**."

Prov 15:3-4 (KJV) "The eyes of the LORD *are* in every place, beholding the evil and the good. [4] **A wholesome tongue is a tree of life: but perverseness therein is a breach in the spirit.**"

1 Pet 2:21-22 (NKJV) "For to this you were called, because Christ **also suffered for us, leaving us an example, that you should follow His steps:** [22] "Who **committed no sin, Nor was deceit found in His mouth**";"

Prov 18:20-21 (NKJV) "A man's stomach shall be satisfied from **the fruit of his mouth**, From the produce **of his lips he shall be filled**. [21] **Death and life are in the power of the tongue, And those who love it will eat its fruit.**"

Rom 7:20-21 (NKJV) "Now if I do what I will not *to do*, it is no longer I who do it, but **sin that dwells in me**. [21] I find then a law, that **evil is present with me**, the one who wills to do good."

James 3 (NKJV) "My brethren, let not many of you become teachers, knowing that we shall receive a stricter judgment. [2] **For we all stumble in many things**. If anyone does not stumble in word, **he is a perfect man**, able also to bridle the whole body. [3] Indeed, we put bits in horses' mouths that they may obey us, and we turn their whole body. [4] Look also at ships: although they are so large and are driven by fierce winds, they are turned by a very small rudder wherever the pilot desires. [5] **Even so the tongue is a little member and boasts great things. See how great a forest a little fire kindles!** [6] **And the tongue is a fire, a world of iniquity. The tongue is so set among our members that it defiles the whole body**, and **sets on fire the course of nature**; and **it is set on fire by hell** [This is what is meant to not kindle a fire on Shabbat – words that defile the whole body – congregation].

[7] For every kind of beast and bird, of reptile and creature of the sea, is tamed and has been tamed by mankind. [8] **But no man can tame the tongue. It is an unruly evil, full of deadly poison [serpent]**. [9] With it we bless our God and Father, and with it we curse men, who have been made in the similitude of God. [10] Out of the same mouth proceed blessing and cursing. My brethren, these things ought not to be so. [11] Does a spring send forth fresh *water* and bitter from the same opening? [12] Can a fig tree, my brethren, bear olives, or a grapevine bear figs? Thus no spring yields both salt water and fresh. [13] **Who is wise and understanding among you? Let him show by good conduct that his works are done in the meekness of wisdom**. [14] But if you have **bitter envy** and **self-seeking** in your hearts, do not boast and lie against the truth. [15] **This wisdom does not descend from above, but is earthly, sensual, demonic**. [16] For where envy and self-seeking *exist*, confusion and every evil thing *are* there. [17] **But the wisdom that is from above is first pure, then peaceable, gentle, willing to yield, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality and without hypocrisy**. [18] Now **the fruit of righteousness is sown in peace** by those who make peace."

Prov 11:30 (NKJV) "**The fruit of the righteous is a tree of life**, And he who wins souls *is* wise."

Isa 14:11-15 (NKJV) "Your pomp is brought down to Sheol, *And the sound of your stringed instruments*; The maggot is spread under you, And worms cover you.' [12] "**How you are fallen from heaven, O Lucifer, son of the morning!** *How* you are cut down to the ground, **You who weakened the nations!** [13] **For you have said in your heart: 'I will ascend into heaven, I will exalt my throne above the stars of God; I will also sit on the mount of the congregation [mow'ed:H4150] On the farthest sides of the north; [14] I will ascend above the heights of the clouds, I will be like the Most High.'** [15] Yet you shall be brought down to Sheol, To the lowest depths of the Pit."

Ezek 28:1-19 (NKJV) "The **word of the LORD** came to me again, saying, [2] "Son of man, **say to the prince of Tyre**, "Thus says the Lord GOD: "**Because your heart is lifted up, And you say, 'I am a god, I sit in the seat of gods, In the midst of the seas,'** Yet you *are* a man, and not a god, **Though you set your heart as the heart of a god** [3] (Behold, you *are* wiser than Daniel! There is no secret that can be hidden from you! [4] **With your wisdom and your understanding** You have gained riches for yourself, And gathered gold and silver into your treasures; [5] By **your great wisdom** in trade you have increased your riches, **And your heart is lifted up because of your riches**)," [6] "Therefore thus says the Lord GOD: "**Because you have set your heart as the heart of a god**, [7] Behold, therefore, I will bring strangers against you, The most terrible of the nations; And they shall draw their swords **against the beauty of your wisdom**,

And **defile your splendor**. [8] They shall throw you down into the Pit, And you shall die the death of the slain In the midst of the seas. [9] "Will you still say before him who slays you, **'I am a god'**? But you *shall be* a man, and not a god, In the hand of him who slays you. [10] You shall die the death of the uncircumcised By the hand of aliens; For I have spoken," says the Lord GOD." [11] Moreover the word of the LORD came to me, saying, [12] "Son of man, take up a lamentation **for the king of Tyre**, and say to him, "Thus says the Lord GOD: "**You were the seal of perfection, Full of wisdom** and perfect in beauty. [13] **You were in Eden, the garden of God**; Every precious stone *was* your covering: The sardius, topaz, and diamond, Beryl, onyx, and jasper, Sapphire, turquoise, and emerald with gold. The workmanship of **your timbrels and pipes** Was prepared for you on the day you were created. [14] "You *were* the anointed cherub who covers; I established you; **You were on the holy mountain of God**; You walked back and forth in the midst of fiery stones. [15] **You were perfect in your ways from the day you were created, Till iniquity was found in you**. [16] "By the abundance of your trading You became filled with **violence** within, And you sinned; Therefore I cast you as a profane thing **Out of the mountain of God**; And I destroyed you, O covering cherub, From the midst of the fiery stones. [17] "**Your heart was lifted up because of your beauty; You corrupted your wisdom for the sake of your splendor**; I cast you to the ground, I laid you before kings, That they might gaze at you. [18] "**You defiled your sanctuaries** By the multitude of your iniquities, By the iniquity of your trading; Therefore I brought fire from your midst; It devoured you, And I turned you to **ashes upon the earth** In the sight of all who saw you. [19] All who knew you among the peoples are astonished at you; You have become a horror, And *shall be* no more forever." ""

John 8:31-44 (NKJV) "Then **Jesus said to those Jews who believed Him**, "**If you abide in My word, you are My disciples indeed**. [32] "**And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free**." [33] They answered Him, "**We are Abraham's descendants**, and have never been in bondage to anyone. How *can* you say, 'You will be made free?'" [34] Jesus answered them, "**Most assuredly, I say to you, whoever commits sin is a slave of sin**. [35] "**And a slave does not abide in the house forever, but a son abides forever**. [36] "**Therefore if the Son makes you free, you shall be free indeed**. [37] "**I know that you are Abraham's descendants, but you seek to kill Me, because My word has no place in you** [**Remember these people are those who believe Jesus**]. [38] "**I speak what I have seen with My Father, and you do what you have seen with your father**." [39] They answered and said to Him, "Abraham is our father." Jesus said to them, "**If you were Abraham's children, you would do the works of Abraham**. [40] "**But now you seek to kill Me, a Man who has told you the truth which I heard from God. Abraham did not do this**. [41] "**You do the deeds of your father**." Then they said to Him, "**We were not born of fornication; we have one Father; God**." [42] Jesus said to them, "**If God were your Father, you would love Me, for I proceeded forth and came from God; nor have I come of Myself, but He sent Me**. [43] "**Why do you not understand My speech? Because you are not able to listen to My word**. [44] "**You are of your father the devil, and the desires of your father you want to do. He was a murderer from the beginning, and does not stand in the truth, because there is no truth in him**. When he speaks a lie, he speaks from his own resources, for he is a liar and the father of it."

Ezek 31:2-11 (NKJV) ""Son of man, **say to Pharaoh king of Egypt and to his multitude**: 'Whom are you like in your greatness? [3] Indeed Assyria *was* a cedar in Lebanon, With fine branches that shaded the forest, And of high stature; And its top was among the thick boughs. [4] **The waters made it grow; Underground waters gave it height, With their rivers running around the place where it was planted, And sent out rivulets to all the trees of the field**. [5] "Therefore **its height was exalted above all the trees of the field**; Its boughs were multiplied, And its branches became long because of the abundance of water, As it sent them out. [6] All the birds of the heavens made their nests in its boughs; Under its branches all the beasts of the field brought forth their young; And in its shadow all great nations made their home. [7] "Thus **it was beautiful in greatness and in the length of its branches, Because its roots reached to abundant waters**. [8] **The cedars in the garden of God could not hide it; The fir trees were not like its boughs, And the chestnut trees were not like its branches; No tree in the garden of God was like it in beauty**. [9] **I made it beautiful with a multitude of branches, So that all the trees of Eden envied it, That were in the garden of God**.' [10] "Therefore thus says the Lord GOD: 'Because you have increased in height, and it set its top among the thick boughs, and **its heart was lifted up in its height**, [11] 'therefore I will deliver it into the hand of the mighty one of the nations, and he shall surely deal with it; I have driven it out for its wickedness.'"

Isa 53:2-3 (NKJV) "For He shall grow up before Him as a **tender plant**, And as a **root out of dry ground**. He has **no form or comeliness**; And when we see Him, **There is no beauty that we should desire Him**. [3] He is despised and rejected by men, A Man of sorrows and acquainted with grief. And we hid, as it were, *our* faces from Him; **He was despised, and we did not esteem Him**."
