Luke 21:26 (NKJV) **men's hearts failing them from fear** and the expectation of **those things which are coming on the earth, for [because] the powers of heaven will be shaken.**

Deu 8:5 (NKJV) You should **know in your heart** that **as a man chastens his son, so the LORD your God chastens you.**

Prov 13:24 (NKJV) He who spares his rod hates his son, **But he who loves him disciplines him promptly.**

Ecl 1:13 (CLV) I applied my heart to inquiring and exploring by wisdom concerning all that is done under the heavens: **it is an experience of evil Elohim has given to the sons of humanity to humble [ana H6031] them by it.**

Gen 22:1 (KJV) And it came to pass after these things, that **God did tempt [nasah H5254] Abraham, ...**

Psa 26:2 (KJV) Examine me, O LORD, and **prove [nasah H5254] me; try my reins and my heart.**

Mat 6:13 (NKJV) **And do not lead us into temptation, [peirasmos G3986] But deliver us from the evil one. For Yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen.**

Mat 4:1 (KJV) Then was **Jesus led up of the Spirit** into the wilderness **to be tempted [peirazo G3985] of the devil.**

Heb 11:17 (NKJV) **By faith Abraham, when he was tested, [peirazo G3985] offered up Isaac, and he who had received the promises offered up his only begotten son,**

James 1:12 (NKJV) **Blessed is the man who endures temptation [peirasmos G3986]; for when he has been approved, he will receive the crown of life** which the Lord has promised to those **who love Him.**

1Peter 1:6-9 (NKJV) In this you greatly rejoice, though now for a little while, if need be, you have been grieved by various **trials, [peirasmos G3986]**^[7] that the **genuineness of your faith, being** much more precious than gold that perishes, **though it is tested by fire,** may be found to praise, honor, and glory at the revelation of Jesus Christ,^[8] whom having not seen you love. Though now you do not see *Him*, yet believing, you rejoice with joy inexpressible and full of glory,^[9] **receiving the end/goal of your faith--the salvation of your souls.**

Rev 2:10 (NKJV) **Do not fear any of those things which you are about to suffer. Indeed, the devil is about to throw some of you into prison, that you may be tested, [peirazo G3985] and you will have tribulation ten days. Be faithful until**

Eph 1:11 (NKJV) **In Him** also we have obtained an inheritance, **being predestined** according to the purpose of Him **who works all things according to the counsel of His will,**

Mat 24:3-13 (NKJV) Now as He sat on the Mount of Olives, the disciples came to Him privately, saying, "Tell us, when will these things be? And **what will be the sign of Your coming, and of the end of the age?"**^[4] And Jesus answered and said to them: "**Take heed that no one deceives you.**"^[5] **For many will come in My name, saying, 'I am the Christ,' and will deceive many.**^[6] **And you will hear of wars and rumors of wars. See that you are not troubled; for all these things must come to pass, but the end is not yet.**^[7] **For nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom. And there will be famines, pestilences, and earthquakes** in various places.^[8] **All these are the beginning of sorrows.**^[9] **Then they will deliver you up to tribulation and kill you, and you will be hated by all nations for My name's sake.**^[10] **And then many will be offended, will betray one another, and will hate one another.**^[11] **Then many false prophets will rise up and deceive many.**^[12] **And because lawlessness will abound, the love of many will grow cold.**^[13] **But he who endures to the end shall be saved.**

Mat 24:35 (KJV) Heaven and earth shall pass away, **but my words shall not pass away.**

Rev 1:8 (NKJV) "I am the Alpha and the Omega, *the Beginning and the End,*" says the Lord, "**who is and who was and who is to come, the Almighty.**"

Mat 6:34 (NKJV) Therefore **do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will worry about its own things. Sufficient for the day is its own trouble.**

James 4:14 (NKJV) whereas you do not know what *will happen* tomorrow. For **what is your life?** It is even **a vapor that appears for a little time and then vanishes away.**

Mat 24:37-39 (NKJV) **But as the days of Noah were, so also will the coming of the Son of Man be.**^[38] **For as in the days before the flood, they were eating and drinking, marrying and giving in marriage, until the day that Noah entered the ark,**^[39] **and did not know until the flood came and took them all away, so also will the coming of the Son of Man be.**

Mat 5:10-12 (NKJV) Blessed are those **who are persecuted for righteousness' sake**, For theirs is **the kingdom of heaven.** ^[11] "**Blessed are you when they revile and persecute you**, and say all kinds of evil against you falsely for My sake. ^[12] **Rejoice and be exceedingly glad, for great is your reward in heaven**, for so **they persecuted the prophets** who were before you.

Luke 6:21-23 (NKJV) **Blessed are you who hunger now**, For you shall be filled. **Blessed are you who weep now**, For you shall laugh. ^[22] Blessed are you **when men hate you**, And when they **exclude you**, And **revile you**, and **cast out your name as evil**, For the Son of Man's sake. ^[23] **Rejoice in that day and leap for joy!** **For indeed your reward is great in heaven**, For **in like manner their fathers did to the prophets.**

Luke 12:32 (KJV) **Fear not, little flock**; for it is your Father's good pleasure **to give you the kingdom.**

2 Tim 2:3-4 (NKJV) You therefore **must endure hardship as a good soldier of Jesus Christ.** ^[4] **No one engaged in warfare entangles himself with the affairs of this life**, that he may please him who enlisted him as a soldier.

2 Cor 1:3-7 (NKJV) Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of mercies and **God of all comfort**, ^[4] **who comforts us in all our tribulation**, that **we may be able to comfort** those who are in any trouble, with the comfort with which we ourselves are comforted by God. ^[5] **For as the sufferings of Christ abound in us, (Col 1:24) so our consolation also abounds through Christ.** ^[6] Now if we are afflicted, *it is* for **your** consolation and salvation, which is effective for **enduring the same sufferings which we also suffer**. Or if we are comforted, *it is* for your consolation and salvation. ^[7] And our hope for you *is* steadfast, because we know that as **you are partakers of the sufferings**, so also *you will partake* of the consolation.

2 Tim 4:6-7 (NKJV) For I am already being poured out as a **drink offering**, and the time of my departure is at hand. ^[7] **I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith.** ^[8] Finally, **there is laid up for me the crown of righteousness,**

John 17:3 (NKJV) **And this is eternal life, that they may know You, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent.**

Luke 12:40 (NKJV) **Therefore you also be ready, for the Son of Man is coming at an hour you do not expect."**

Rev 3:20 (NKJV) Behold, I stand at the door and knock. **If anyone hears My voice and opens the door, I will come in to him and dine with him, and he with Me.**

Mat 28:20 (NKJV) **teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you**; and lo, **I am with you always, even to the end of the age."** Amen.

Mat 24:24-25 (NKJV) **For false christs and false prophets will rise and show great signs and wonders to deceive, if possible, even the elect.** ^[25] **See, I have told you beforehand.**

Deu 11:16 (NKJV) **Take heed to yourselves, lest your heart be deceived, [is this not the same words of Messiah of: "take heed that no one deceives you"]** and you turn aside and serve other gods and worship them,

Jer 29:8-9 (NKJV) For thus says the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel: **Do not let your prophets and your diviners who are in your midst deceive you**, nor listen to your dreams which you cause to be dreamed. ^[9] **For they prophesy falsely to you in My name**; I have not sent them, says the LORD.

Jer 9:4-8 (NKJV) **"Everyone take heed to his neighbor, And do not trust any brother; For every brother will utterly supplant, And every neighbor will walk with slanderers.** ^[5] **Everyone will deceive his neighbor, And will not speak the truth; They have taught their tongue to speak lies; They weary themselves to commit iniquity.** ^[6] **Your dwelling place is in the midst of deceit; Through deceit they refuse to know Me,"** says the LORD. ^[7] Therefore thus says the LORD of hosts: "Behold, **I will refine them and try them**; For how shall I deal with the daughter of My people? ^[8] **Their tongue is an arrow shot out; It speaks deceit; One speaks peaceably to his neighbor with his mouth, But in his heart he lies in wait.**

Gen 12:10 (NKJV) Now **there was a famine in the land**, and Abram ...

Gen 26:1 (NKJV) There was a **famine in the land**, besides the first famine that was in the days of Abraham. ...

Gen 41:56 (NKJV) The **famine was over all the face of the earth**, and Joseph ...

Ruth 1:1 (NKJV) Now it came to pass, in the days when the **judges** ruled, that there **was a famine in the land**. ...

2Sam 21:1 (KJV) Then there was a **famine in the days of David** three years, ...

2 Kings 6:25 (NKJV) And there was a **great famine in Samaria**; ...

2Sam 24:15 (KJV) So **the LORD sent a pestilence upon**

Acts 11:28 (NKJV) Then one of them, named Agabus, stood up and showed by the Spirit that there was going to be a **great famine throughout all the world**, which also happened in the days of Claudius Caesar.

Jer 21:8-10 (NKJV) "Now you shall say to this people, **'Thus says the LORD: "Behold, I set before you the way of life and the way of death.**'^[9] He who remains in this city **shall die by the sword, by famine, and by pestilence**; but he who goes out and defects to the Chaldeans who besiege you, he shall live, and his life shall be as a prize to him.^[10] For I have set My face **against this city** for adversity and not for good," says the LORD. "It shall be given into the hand of the king of Babylon, **and he shall burn it with fire.**" '

Jer 24:10 (NKJV) And **I will send the sword, the famine, and the pestilence among them**, till they are consumed from the land that I gave to them and their fathers.' "

Jer 29:17-19 (NKJV) thus says the LORD of hosts: Behold, **I will send on them the sword, the famine, and the pestilence**, and will make them like rotten figs that cannot be eaten, **they are so bad.**^[18] And **I will pursue them with the sword, with famine, and with pestilence; and I will deliver them to trouble among all the kingdoms of the earth**--to be a curse, an astonishment, a hissing, and a reproach among all the nations where I have driven them,^[19] **because they have not heeded My words, says the LORD**, which I sent to them by My servants the prophets, rising up early and sending *them*; **neither would you heed, says the LORD.**

2Chro 7:13-14 (NKJV) When **I shut up heaven** and there is no rain, or command **the locusts to devour the land, or send pestilence among My people,**^[14] if My people who are called by My name **will humble themselves, and pray and seek My face, and turn from their wicked ways,** then I will hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin and heal their land.

Job 5:17-22 (NKJV) "Behold, **happy is the man whom God corrects; Therefore do not despise the chastening of the Almighty.**^[18] For **He bruises, but He binds up; He wounds, but His hands make whole.**^[19] He shall deliver you in **six troubles, Yes, in seven no evil shall touch you.**^[20] **In famine** He shall redeem you from death, **And in war from the power of the sword.**^[21] You shall be hidden from the scourge of the tongue, And you shall not be afraid of destruction when it comes.^[22] **You shall laugh at destruction and famine, And you shall not be afraid of the beasts of the earth.**

1Kings 8:37-39 (NKJV) "When there is **famine** in the land, **pestilence or blight or mildew, locusts or grasshoppers**; when their **enemy** besieges them in the land of their cities; **whatever plague or whatever sickness there is;**^[38] whatever prayer, whatever supplication is made by anyone, *or* by all Your people Israel, **when each one knows the plague of his own heart,** and **spreads out his hands toward this temple:**^[39] then **hear in heaven Your dwelling place**, and forgive, and act, and give to everyone according to all his ways, **whose heart You know** (for **You alone know the hearts of all the sons of men**),

Ecc1 9:3 (NKJV) This *is* an evil in all that is done under the sun: that one thing *happens* to all. **Truly the hearts of the sons of men are full of evil; madness is in their hearts while they live,** and after that *they go* to the dead.

Exo 15:26 (NKJV) and said, "**If you diligently heed the voice of the LORD your God and do what is right in His sight, give ear to His commandments and keep all His statutes, I will put none of the diseases on you** which I have brought on the Egyptians. For I *am* the LORD who heals you."

Jer 14:11-14 (NKJV) Then the LORD said to me, "**Do not pray for this people, for their good.**^[12] "When they fast, I will not hear their cry; and when they offer burnt offering and grain offering, I will not accept them. But **I will consume them by the sword, by the famine, and by the pestilence.**" **[signs of the end time of Mat 24]**^[13] Then I said, "Ah, Lord GOD! Behold, the prophets say to them, 'You shall not see the sword, nor shall you have famine, but I will give you assured peace in this place.'^[14] And the LORD said to me, "**The prophets prophesy lies in My name [signs of the end time of Mat 24].** I have not sent them, commanded them, nor spoken to them; they prophesy to you a false vision, divination, a worthless thing, and **the deceit of their heart.**

1Tim 2:14 (NKJV) And Adam was not deceived, but **the woman being deceived, fell into transgression.**

Rom 7:11 (NKJV) **For sin**, taking occasion by the commandment, **deceived me**, and by it killed *me*.

1Cor 6:9 (NKJV) Do you not know that the **unrighteous will not inherit the kingdom of God? Do not be deceived.** Neither **fornicators**, nor **idolaters**, nor **adulterers**, nor **homosexuals**, nor **sodomites**,

2Tim 3:13 (NKJV) But **evil men and impostors** will grow worse and worse, **deceiving and being deceived.**

Titus 3:1-3 (NKJV) Remind them to be subject to rulers and authorities, to obey, to be ready for every good work,^[2] to **speak evil of no one**, to be peaceable, gentle, **showing all humility to all men.**^[3] For **we ourselves were also** once **foolish, disobedient, deceived, serving various lusts and pleasures, [these are the idols of the heart]** living in malice and envy, hateful and **hating one another. (same as Jer 9)**

Rev 19:20 (NKJV) Then **the beast** was captured, and with him **the false prophet** who **worked signs** in his presence, by which **he deceived those who received the mark of the beast and those who worshiped his image**. These two were cast alive into the lake of fire burning with brimstone.

Heb 8:10 (NKJV) For **this is the covenant** that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, says the LORD: **I will put My laws in their mind and write them on their hearts**; and **I will be their God, and they shall be My people**. [See Exo 13:9]

Acts 7:47-51 (NKJV) But **Solomon** built Him a house. ^[48] However, the **Most High does not dwell in temples made with hands**, as the prophet says: ^[49] **'Heaven is My throne, And earth is My footstool**. *What house will you build for Me? says the LORD, Or what is the place of My rest?* ^[50] **Has My hand not made all these things?'** ^[51] **"You stiffnecked and uncircumcised in heart and ears! You always resist the Holy Spirit; as your fathers did, so do you.**

John 2:19 (NKJV) Jesus answered and said to them, **"Destroy this temple, and in three days I will raise it up."**

Mat 26:61 (KJV) And said, This fellow said, **I am able to destroy the temple of God**, and to build it in three days.

Mark 14:58 (KJV) We heard him say, I will destroy **this temple that is made with hands**, and within three days **I will build another made without hands**.

John 2:21 (KJV) **But he spake of the temple of his body**.

1 Cor 3:16 (NKJV) Do you not know that **you are the temple of God** and that the Spirit of God dwells in you?

Heb 9:8 (NKJV) the Holy Spirit indicating this, that **the way into the Holiest of All was not yet made manifest while the first tabernacle was still standing**.

1 Cor 3:17-18 (KJV) **If any man defile the temple of God, him shall God destroy**; for the temple of God is holy, **which temple ye are**. ^[18] **Let no man deceive himself**. If any man among you seemeth to be wise in this world, let him become a fool, that he may be wise.

Mat 15:18-20 (NKJV) **But those things which proceed out of the mouth come from the heart, and they defile a man**. ^[19] **For out of the heart** proceed evil thoughts, murders, adulteries, fornications, thefts, false witness, blasphemies. ^[20] **These are the things which defile a man, but to eat with unwashed hands does not defile a man."**

Luke 17:20-21 (NKJV) Now when He was asked by the Pharisees when the kingdom of God would come, He answered them and said, **"The kingdom of God does not come with observation; ^[21] nor will they say, 'See here!' or 'See there!' For indeed, the kingdom of God is within you."**

Mark 7:15-16 (NKJV) ^[15] **There is nothing that enters a man from outside which can defile him; but the things which come out of him, those are the things that defile a man**. ^[16] **If anyone has ears to hear, let him hear!"**

Mark 7:20-23 (NKJV) And He said, **"What comes out of a man, that defiles a man**. ^[21] For from within, **out of the heart of men**, proceed evil thoughts, adulteries, fornications, murders, ^[22] thefts, covetousness, wickedness, deceit, lewdness, an evil eye, blasphemy, pride, foolishness. ^[23] **All these evil things come from within and defile a man."**

Eph 2:8-9 (NKJV) For by grace **you have been saved through faith**, and that not of yourselves; **it is the gift of God**, ^[9] not of works, lest anyone should boast.

1 Tim 6:12 (NKJV) **Fight the good fight of faith**, lay hold on eternal life, to which you were also called and have confessed the good confession in the presence of many witnesses.

1Jn 5:4 For whatsoever is born of God overcometh the world: and **this is the victory that overcometh the world, even our faith**.

Eph 6:16 (KJV) Above all, **taking the shield of faith**, wherewith ye shall be able **to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked**.

Rom 8:35-39 (NKJV) Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? *Shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword?* ^[36] As it is written: **"For Your sake we are killed all day long; We are accounted as sheep for the slaughter."** ^[37] Yet in all these things we are more than conquerors through Him who loved us. ^[38] For I am persuaded that neither death nor life, nor angels nor principalities nor powers, nor things present nor things to come, ^[39] nor height nor depth, **nor any other created thing**, shall be able to separate us from the love of God which is in Christ Jesus our Lord.
