

REVIEW lessons 1-3

Luke 16:16 (NKJV) ""The law and the prophets *were* **until John**. Since that time the kingdom of God has been preached, and everyone is pressing into it."

Mat 13:52 (NKJV) "Then He said to them, "Therefore every scribe **instructed concerning the kingdom of heaven** is like a householder who brings out of his **treasure things new and old.**"

2Pt 1:20 "knowing this first, that no^t prophecy of scripture at ^{every}all is becoming- **its own** [idios:G2398] explanation." [The Concordant Literal version]

Psa 119:160 (NASB) "**The sum of Thy word is truth**, And every one of Thy righteous ordinances is everlasting."

1 Cor 2:14 (NKJV) "But the **natural man** does not receive **the things of the Spirit of God**, for **they are foolishness to him**; nor can he know *them*, **because they are spiritually discerned.**"
[Was Adam created a natural man or spirit being?]

1 Cor 2:6-7 (NKJV) "However, we speak wisdom among those who are **mature**, yet **not the wisdom of this age**, **nor of the rulers of this age**, who are coming to nothing. [7] **But we speak the wisdom of God in a mystery**, the **hidden wisdom which God ordained before the ages for our glory**,"

Prov 25:2 (NKJV) "**It is the glory of God** to conceal a matter, But **the glory of kings is to search out a matter.**"

1 Cor 2:10-13 (NKJV) "But **God has revealed them to us through His Spirit**. For the Spirit searches all things, yes, the deep things of God. [11] For what man knows the things of a man except the spirit of the man which is in him? Even so no one knows the things of God except the Spirit of God. [12] Now **we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, that we might know the things that have been freely given to us by God.** [13] These things we also speak, not in words which man's wisdom teaches but which **the Holy Spirit teaches, comparing spiritual things with spiritual.**"

Rom 1:20 (KJV) "**For the invisible things of him from the creation of the world are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made**, *even* his eternal power and Godhead; so that they are without excuse:"

Rom 7:14 (NKJV) "For we know that **the law is spiritual**, but **I am carnal**, sold under sin."

Psa 13:3 (NKJV) "Consider *and* hear me, O LORD my God; **Enlighten [owr] my eyes, Lest I sleep the sleep of death;**"

Psa 51:5 (NKJV) "Behold, I was brought forth in iniquity, And **in sin my mother conceived me.**"

Psa 139:15 (NASB) "My frame was not hidden from Thee, When I was made in secret, *And skillfully wrought* **in the depths of the earth.**"

Rom 7:24 (NKJV) "O wretched man that I am! Who will deliver me from **this body of death?**"

Isa 29:18 (KJV) "And **in that day shall the deaf hear the words of the book,** and the eyes of **the blind shall see out of obscurity,** and out of **darkness.**"

Isa 42:7 (KJV) "To open the blind eyes, to bring out the prisoners from the prison, *and* them that sit in **darkness** [**choshek**] out of the prison house."

John 9:39 "*...that those who do not see may see, and that those who see may be made blind.*"

Acts 9:8-9 (NIV) "Saul got up from the ground, but when he opened his eyes **he could see nothing.** So they led him by the hand into Damascus. [9] **For three days he was blind,** and did not eat or drink anything."

John 9:40 (NIV) "Some Pharisees who were with him heard him say this and asked, "What? Are we blind too?""

Phil 3:5-6 (KJV) "Circumcised the eighth day, of the stock of Israel, *of* the tribe of Benjamin, an Hebrew of the Hebrews; as touching the law, a Pharisee; [6] Concerning zeal, **persecuting the church; touching the righteousness which is in the law, blameless.**"

1 Tim 1:15 (NIV) "Here is a trustworthy saying that deserves full acceptance: Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners--**of whom I am the worst.**"

Psa 119:18-19 (NKJV) "Open my eyes, that **I may see Wondrous things from Your law.** [19] *I am* a stranger in the earth; **Do not hide Your commandments** from me."

2 Cor 4:18 (KJV) "**While** we look **not** at the things which are seen, but at **the things which are not seen: for the things which are seen are temporal;** but the things which are not seen *are* eternal."

John 6:63 (NKJV) ""**It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh profits nothing. The words that I speak to you are spirit, and they are life.**"

Eph 3:14-15 (NKJV) "For this reason I bow my knees to the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, [15] from whom **the whole family in heaven and earth is named,**"

1 Cor 2:7 (KJV) "But we speak the **wisdom of God in a mystery**, even the **hidden wisdom**, which God **ordained before the world** unto our glory:"

Back to Genesis

Gen 1:1-3 (NKJV) "In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. [2] The earth was without form, and void; and darkness *was* on the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters. [3] Then God said, "Let there be light"; and there was light."

Rom 11:16 (KJV) "For if the **firstfruit** [aparche:G536] *be* holy, the lump *is* also *holy*: and if the root *be* holy, so *are* the branches."

1 Cor 15:20 (KJV) "But now is Christ risen from the dead, *and* become the **firstfruits** of **them that slept**."

1 Cor 15:23 (KJV) "But every man in his own order: Christ the **firstfruits**; afterward they that are Christ's at his coming."

According to Strong's The Greek word for Firstfruit is,

aparche:G536 "from a comp. of G575 and **G756**; **a beginning of sacrifice**, i.e. the (Jewish) first-fruit (fig.):--first-fruits.

In Gen 1:1 the Septuagint translates "beginning" with the Greek word "**G746. arche**, ar-khay'; **from G756**;" which is use of Messiah in Rev 3:14. So we could actually read Gen 1:1 as follows,

Gen 1:1 "In the firstfruit" or, in Yeshua Messiah - Elohim created (fatted/filled-in) the heavens and the earth"

John 1:3 (KJV) "All things were made **by him**; and **without him** was not any thing made that was made."

Col 1:16-17 (KJV) "For **by him** were **all things created**, that are in heaven, and that are in earth, **visible and invisible**, whether *they be* thrones, or dominions, or principalities, or powers: all things were created **by him**, and **for him**: [17] And **he is before all things**, and **by him** all things consist."

Rev 3:14 (KJV) "And unto the angel of the church of the Laodiceans write; These things saith the Amen, the faithful and true witness, **the beginning** [arche:G746] **of the creation of God**;"

1 John 1:5 (NKJV) "This is **the message** which **we have heard from Him** and declare to you, that **God is light and in Him is no darkness at all.**"

Eph 1:3-5 (NKJV) "Blessed *be* the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has blessed us with every spiritual blessing in the heavenly *places* in Christ, [4] **just as He chose us in Him before the foundation of the world**, that we should be holy and without blame before Him in love, [5] **having predestined us to adoption as sons** by Jesus Christ to Himself, according to the good pleasure of His will,"

Rom 8:15-16 (NKJV) "For you **did not receive the spirit of bondage again to fear**, but **you received the Spirit of adoption** by whom we cry out, "Abba, Father." [16] The Spirit Himself bears witness with our spirit that we are children of God,"

Rom 8:23-25 (NKJV) "Not only *that*, but we also who have the **firstfruits of the Spirit**, even **we ourselves groan within ourselves**, **eagerly waiting for the adoption, the redemption of our body**. [24] For we were saved in this hope, **but hope that is seen is not hope**; for why does one still hope for what he sees? [25] **But if we hope for what we do not see**, we eagerly wait for *it* with perseverance."

2 Cor 5:1-7 (NKJV) "For we know that if our **earthly house**, *this* tent, is destroyed [**Remember Job 4:21 NIV**], **we have a building from God, a house not made with hands, eternal in the heavens**. [2] **For in this we groan**, earnestly desiring to be **clothed with our habitation which is from heaven**, [3] if indeed, having been clothed, **we shall not be found naked**. [4] For **we who are in this tent groan**, being burdened, not because we want to be unclothed, but further clothed, that **mortality may be swallowed up by life**. [5] Now **He who has prepared us for this very thing is God**, who also **has given us the Spirit as a guarantee**. [6] So *we are* always confident, knowing that while we are at home in the body we are absent from the Lord. [7] **For we walk by faith, not by sight.**"

1 Pet 1:23-24 (NKJV) "having **been born again, not of corruptible seed but incorruptible, through the word of God which lives and abides forever**, [24] because "All flesh *is* as grass, And all the glory of man as the flower of the grass. **The grass withers**, And its flower falls away,"

Eph 1:10-12 (KJV) "That in **the dispensation of the fulness of times** he might **gather together in one all things in Christ**, both which are in heaven, and which are on earth; *even* in him: [11] In whom also we have obtained an inheritance, **being predestinated** according to the purpose of him **who worketh all things after the counsel of his own will**: [12] That **we should be to the praise of his glory**, who first trusted in Christ." [**What does Judah means? Gen 29:35 Yeshua is the King of the Jews because His life is to praise the Father**]

1 Cor 15:36-37 (NIV) "**How foolish!** What you sow **does not come to life unless it dies**. [37] When you sow, **you do not plant the body that will be**, **but just a seed**, perhaps of wheat or of something else." **Satan planted Tares**

1 Cor 15:46-50 (NKJV) "However, **the spiritual is not first, but the natural [1 Cor 2:14], and afterward the spiritual.** [47] **The first man was of the earth, made of dust; the second Man is the Lord from heaven.** [48] As **was the man of dust, so also are those who are made of dust;** and as *is* the heavenly *Man*, so also *are* those *who are* heavenly. [49] And as we have borne the image of the *man* of dust, **we shall also bear the image of the heavenly Man.** [50] Now this I say, brethren, that **flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God; nor does corruption inherit incorruption.**"

2 Cor 13:4 (NKJV) "For though **He was crucified in weakness,** yet **He lives by the power of God.** For we also are weak in Him, but we shall live with Him **by the power of God toward you.**"

2 Cor 4:6-7 (NKJV) "For it is the **God who commanded light to shine out of darkness,** who has shone in our hearts to *give* **the light of the knowledge of the glory** of God in the face of Jesus Christ. [7] **But we have this treasure in earthen vessels, that the excellence of the power may be of God and not of us.**"

1 Th 5:5 (NKJV) "You are all sons of light and sons of the day. We are not of the night nor of darkness."

Eph 5:8 (NKJV) "For you **were once darkness, but now** you are light in the Lord. **Walk as children of light**"

2 Sam 22:29 (NKJV) ""For You *are* my lamp, O LORD; The LORD shall enlighten my darkness."

Eph 5:13-14 (NIV) "But everything **exposed by the light** becomes visible, [14] **for it is light that makes everything visible.** This is why it is said: "Wake up, O sleeper, **rise from the dead,** and Christ will shine on you."" [Isa 26:19; 60:1]

Eph 5:13-14 (KJV) "But all things that are **reproved [elegcho] are made manifest by the light:** for whatsoever doth make manifest is light. [14] Wherefore he saith, Awake thou that sleepest, and **arise from the dead,** and Christ shall give thee light."

The word "exposed (NIV)" or "reproved (KJV)" is the Greek word,

elegcho:G1651 "elegcho, el-eng'-kho; of uncert. affin.; to confute [show to be false], admonish:--**convict**, convince, **tell a fault, rebuke**, reprove.

Rom 3:20 (NKJV) "Therefore by the deeds of the law **no flesh will be justified** in His sight, for **by the law is the knowledge of sin.**"

Rom 7:7 (NKJV) "What shall we say then? *Is* the law sin? Certainly not! On the contrary, **I would not have known sin except through the law.** For I would not have known covetousness unless the law had said, "You shall not covet.""

Rom 3:9-11 (NKJV) "What then? Are we better *than they*? Not at all. For we have previously charged **both Jews and Greeks that they are all under sin**. [10] **As it is written**: "There is **none righteous, no, not one**; [11] There is none who understands; **There is none who seeks after God**."

Rom 3:23 (NKJV) "for **all have sinned** and fall short of the glory of God,"

Luke 1:78-79 (NIV) "because of the tender mercy of our God, by which the **rising sun will come to us from heaven** [Mal 4:2] [79] **to shine on those living in darkness and in the shadow of death**, to guide **our feet** into the path of peace."

Rom 8:3 (NKJV) "For what the law could not do in that it was weak through the flesh, God *did* by sending His own **Son in the likeness of sinful flesh**, on account of sin: **He condemned sin in the flesh**,"

Mat 19:17 (NKJV) "So He said to him, "**Why do you call Me good? No one is good but One, that is, God. But if you want to enter into life, keep the commandments.**"

1 John 4:3 (NKJV) "**and every spirit that does not confess that Jesus Christ has come in the flesh is not of God**. And this is the *spirit* of the Antichrist, which you have heard was coming, and is now already in the world."

1 John 2:7-11 (NKJV) "Brethren, **I write no new commandment to you, but an old commandment which you have had from the beginning**. **The old commandment is the word which you heard from the beginning**. [8] Again, a new commandment I write to you, which thing is true in Him and in you, **because the darkness is passing away, and the true light is already shining**. [9] **He who says he is in the light, and hates his brother, is in darkness until now**. [10] He who loves his brother abides in the light, and there is no cause for stumbling in him. [11] **But he who hates his brother is in darkness and walks in darkness**, and does not know where he is going, because the darkness has blinded his eyes."
