

## Lesson 6 Genesis 2 Part 2

### Scriptures Used

Col 1:27 (NKJV) "To them God willed to make known what are **the riches of the glory of this mystery** among the Gentiles: **which is Christ in you, the hope of glory.**"

Isa 48:12 (NKJV) ""Listen to Me, O Jacob, And Israel, **My called**: I *am* He, **I am the First, I am also the Last.**"

Rev 1:17 (NKJV) "And when I saw Him, I fell at His feet as dead. But He laid His right hand on me, saying to me, "**Do not be afraid; I am the First and the Last.**"

Exo 33:13 (NIV) "If you are pleased with me, **teach me your ways so I may know you** and continue to find favor with you. Remember that this nation is your people.""

John 17:3-4 (NKJV) ""**And this is eternal life, that they may know You, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent.** [4] "**I have glorified You on the earth. I have finished the work which You have given Me to do.**"

Mark 10:31 (NKJV) ""**But many *who are* first will be last, and the last first.**""

Hosea 11:1 (NKJV) ""When **Israel was a child**, I loved him, And **out of Egypt I called My son.**"

Exo 4:22-23 (NKJV) ""Then you shall say to Pharaoh, "Thus says the LORD: "**Israel is My son, My firstborn.** [23] "So I say to you, **let My son go that he may serve Me.** But if you refuse to let him go, indeed **I will kill your son, your firstborn.**"" ""

1 Cor 10:11 (NKJV) "Now all these things happened to them as examples, and **they were written for our admonition, upon whom the ends of the ages have come.**"

Mat 2:14-15 (NKJV) "When he arose, he (**Joseph**) took the **young Child** and His mother by night and departed for Egypt, [15] and was there until the death of Herod, **that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the Lord through the prophet**, saying, "**Out of Egypt I called My Son.**""

Acts 7:39 (NKJV) ""whom our fathers would not obey, but rejected. And **in their hearts they turned back to Egypt,**"

Isa 49:1-9 (NKJV) ""Listen, O coastlands, to Me, And take heed, you peoples from afar! **The LORD has called Me from the womb; From the matrix of My mother He has made mention of My name.** [2] And He has made **My mouth like a sharp sword** [SEE REV 1:16, 2:16, 19:15]; In the shadow of His hand He has hidden Me, And made Me a polished shaft; In His quiver He has hidden Me." [3] "And He said to me, '**You are My servant, O Israel, In whom I will be glorified.**' [4] Then I said, 'I have labored in vain, I have spent my strength for nothing and in vain; Yet surely my just reward *is* with the LORD, And my work with my God.'" [5] "And now the LORD says, Who formed Me from the womb *to be* His

Servant, **To bring Jacob back to Him, So that Israel is gathered to Him** (For I shall be glorious in the eyes of the LORD, And My God shall be My strength), [6] Indeed He says, 'It is too small a thing that You should be My Servant To raise up the tribes of Jacob, And to restore the preserved ones of Israel; **I will also give You as a light to the Gentiles, That You should be My salvation to the ends of the earth.**' [7] Thus says the LORD, The Redeemer of Israel, their Holy One, To Him whom **man [nephesh]** despises, To Him whom the nation abhors, To the Servant of rulers: "Kings shall see and arise, Princes also shall worship, Because of the LORD who is faithful, The Holy One of Israel; And He has chosen You." [8] Thus says the LORD: "In an acceptable time I have heard You, And in the day of salvation **[Yeshua]** I have helped You; **I will preserve You and give You As a covenant to the people, To restore the earth,** To cause them to inherit the desolate heritages; [9] **That You may say to the prisoners, 'Go forth,' To those who are in darkness, 'Show yourselves.'** "They shall feed along the roads, And their pastures *shall be* on all desolate heights."

Gal 3:16 (NKJV) "Now **to Abraham and his Seed were the promises made. He does not say, "And to seeds,"** as of many, **but as of one, "And to your Seed,"** who is Christ."

Luke 8:11 (NKJV) **"Now the parable is this: The seed is the word of God."**

Rev 19:13 (NIV) "He is dressed in a robe dipped in blood, and **his name is the Word of God.**"

2 Cor 1:19-20 (NKJV) "For the Son of God, Jesus Christ, who was preached among you by us; by me, Silvanus, and Timothy; **was not Yes and No, but in Him was Yes.** [20] **For all the promises of God in Him are Yes,** and in Him Amen, to the glory of God through us."

Rom 8:29 (NKJV) "For whom He foreknew, He also predestined *to be* conformed to the image of His Son, that **He might be the firstborn among many brethren.**"

Col 1:15 (NKJV) "He is the image of the invisible God, **the firstborn over all creation.**"

Col 1:18 (NKJV) "And **He is the head of the body,** the church, who is the beginning, **the firstborn from the dead, that in all things He may have the preeminence.**"

Heb 1:6 (NKJV) "But when He again brings the **firstborn** into the world, He says: "Let all the angels of God worship Him.""

Heb 12:22-23 (NKJV) "But you have come to Mount Zion and to the city of the living God, **the heavenly Jerusalem,** to an innumerable company of angels, [23] to the **general assembly and church of the firstborn who are registered in heaven,** to God the Judge of all, **to the spirits of just men made perfect,**"

Rev 1:5 (NKJV) "and from Jesus Christ, the faithful witness, **the firstborn from the dead,** and the ruler over the kings of the earth. To Him who loved us and washed us from our sins in His own blood,"

Rom 9:6-9 (NKJV) "But it is not that the word of God has taken no effect. **For they are not all Israel who are of Israel,** [7] **nor are they all children because they are the seed of Abraham;** but, **"In Isaac your seed shall be called."** [8] That is, **those who are the children of the flesh, these are not the**

**children of God;** but **the children of the promise are counted as the seed.** [9] For this *is* the word of promise: "At this time I will come and Sarah shall have a son."

John 8:31-39 (NKJV) "Then Jesus said to those **Jews who believed Him**, "If you **abide in My word**, you are My disciples indeed. [32] "And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free." [33] They answered Him, "We are Abraham's descendants, and have never been in bondage to anyone. How *can* you say, 'You will be made free'?" [34] Jesus answered them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, whoever commits sin is a slave of sin. [35] "And a slave does not abide in the house forever, *but a son abides forever.* [36] "Therefore if the Son makes you free, you shall be free indeed. [37] "**I know that you are Abraham's descendants, but you seek to kill Me, because My word has no place in you.** [38] "I speak what I have seen with My Father, and you do what you have seen with your father." [39] They answered and said to Him, "Abraham is our father." Jesus said to them, "**If you were Abraham's children, you would do the works of Abraham.**"

Col 3:9-11 (NKJV) "Do not lie to one another, since **you have put off the old man with his deeds,** [10] **and have put on the new man who is renewed in knowledge according to the image of Him who created him,** [11] where there is neither Greek nor Jew, circumcised nor uncircumcised, barbarian, Scythian, slave *nor* free, **but Christ is all and in all."**

## Genesis 2

There are several topics that we need to cover in this chapter – but of course we will not have enough time to do so in one meeting.

- The Sabbath,
- Man becoming a “living soul” - The first Adam
- The fact that Adam was not formed inside the garden but outside
- The trees God made were “good for food” and “pleasant to the sight”
- Two trees in the midst of the garden which produce opposite fruit.
- God’s command to Adam to “keep” protect the garden
- Free choice Father gave Adam to freely eat of everything He had made
- Father command not to eat of the tree that produces good and evil and the consequences for doing so.
- Eve is Adam’s flesh and bones
- They are both naked and don’t even know it.

Mat 11:28-30 (NKJV) ""Come to Me, all *you* who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. [29] "Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and **you will find rest for your souls.** [30] "For My yoke *is* easy and My burden is light.""

Heb 4:1-6 (NRSV) "Therefore, while **the promise of entering his rest is still open,** let us take care that none of you should seem to have failed to reach it. [2] For indeed the good news came to us just as to them; but the message they heard did not benefit them, because they were not united by faith with those who listened. [3] **For we who have believed enter that rest,** just as God has said, "As in my anger I swore, "They shall not enter my rest," **though his works were finished at the foundation of the**

**world.** [4] For in one place it speaks about the seventh day as follows, "And God rested on the seventh day from all his works." [5] **And again in this place it says, "They shall not enter my rest."** [6] **Since therefore it remains open for some to enter it,** and those who formerly received the good news failed to enter because of disobedience,"

Heb 4:7-11 (NRSV) "again he sets a certain day--" today"--saying through David much later, in the words already quoted, "**Today, if you hear his voice, do not harden your hearts.**" [8] For if Joshua had given them rest, God would not speak later about another day. [9] **So then, a sabbath rest still remains for the people of God;** [10] for **those who enter God's rest also cease from their labors as God did from his.** [11] Let us therefore make every effort to enter that rest, so that no one may fall through such disobedience as theirs."

1 Cor 15:27-28 (NKJV) "For "He has put all things under His feet." But when He says "all things are put under *Him*," *it is* evident that He who put all things under Him is excepted. [28] Now when all things are made subject to Him, then the Son Himself will also be subject to Him who put all things under Him, that God may be all in all."
