

Lesson 6 Genesis 2 - Part 3

John 4:21-24 (NKJV) "Jesus said to her, "Woman, believe Me, the hour is coming when you will **neither on this mountain, nor in Jerusalem, worship the Father.** [22] "You worship what you do not know; we know what we worship, for salvation is of the Jews. [23] "But the hour is coming, **and now is**, when the true worshipers will worship the Father **in spirit and truth**; for the Father is seeking such to worship Him. [24] "God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth.""

Mat 13:19 (NKJV) ""When **anyone hears the word of the kingdom, and does not understand it**, then **the wicked one comes and snatches away** what **was sown in his heart**. This is he **who received seed** by the wayside."

Mat 22:14 (KJV) "For **many are called**, but few *are* chosen."

Mark 10:31 (NKJV) ""But many *who are* first will be last, **and the last first.**""

Luke 8:11 (NKJV) ""Now the parable is this: **The seed is the word of God.**""

Rev 19:12-13 (NKJV) "His eyes *were* like a flame of fire, and on His head *were* many crowns. **He had a name written that no one knew except Himself.** [13] **He was clothed with a robe dipped in blood**, and **His name is called The Word of God.**"

Isa 43:5-8 (NKJV) "Fear not, for I *am* with you; I will bring your descendants from the east, And gather you from the west; [6] I will say to the north, 'Give them up!' And to the south, 'Do not keep them back!' **Bring My sons from afar, And My daughters from the ends of the earth;** [7] **Everyone who is called by My name**, Whom I have **created for My glory; I have formed him, yes, I have made him.**" [8] Bring out the blind people who have eyes, And the deaf who have ears."

Acts 15:17 (NKJV) "So that the rest of mankind may seek the LORD, **Even all the Gentiles who are called by My name**, Says the LORD who does all these things."

Eph 3:14-15 (NKJV) "For this reason I bow my knees to the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, [15] **from whom the whole family in heaven and earth is named,**"

Rev 19:10 (NKJV) "And I fell at his feet to worship him. But he said to me, "See *that you do not do that!* **I am your fellow servant, and of your brethren who have the testimony of Jesus. Worship God!** For the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy.""

1 John 4:17 (NKJV) "Love has been perfected among us **in this**: that we may have boldness in the day of judgment; because **as He is, so are we in this world.**"

Col 1:27 (NKJV) "To them God willed to make known what are **the riches of the glory of this mystery** among the Gentiles: **which is Christ in you, the hope of glory.**"

Psa 19:7 (NKJV) "The law of the LORD *is* perfect, **converting the soul [nephesh]**; The testimony of the LORD *is* sure, making wise the simple;"

Rom 8:7 (KJV) "Because the **carnal mind is enmity against God**: for it **is not subject to the law of God, neither indeed can be.**"

Rom 8:11 (NKJV) "But **if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you**, He who raised Christ from the dead **will also give life to your mortal bodies through His**

Isa 44:6 (NKJV) ""Thus says the LORD, **the King of Israel, And his Redeemer**, the LORD of hosts: **I am the First and I am the Last**; Besides Me *there is* no God."

Rev 1:17-18 (NKJV) "And when I saw Him, I fell at His feet as dead. But He laid His right hand on me, saying to me, "**Do not be afraid; I am the First and the Last.** [18] "**I am He who lives, and was dead, and behold, I am alive forevermore.** Amen. And I have **the keys of Hades and of Death.**"

Rev 22:13-14 (NKJV) ""**I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End, the First and the Last.**" [14] **Blessed are those who do His commandments, that they may have the right to the tree of life, and may enter through the gates into the city.**"

Rev 21:1 (KJV) "And I saw a new heaven and a new earth: for **the first** heaven and **the first** earth **were passed away**; and there was no more sea."

Genesis 2

There are several topics that we need to cover in this chapter – but of course we will not have enough time to do so in one meeting.

- The Sabbath,
- Man becoming a “living soul” - The first Adam
- The fact that Adam was not formed inside the garden but outside
- The trees God made were “good for food” and “pleasant to the sight”
- Two trees in the midst of the garden which produce opposite fruit.
- A river to water the garden split in 4 rivers
- God’s command to Adam to “keep” protect the garden
- Father told Adam to freely eat of everything He had made - Free choice
- Father commands not to eat of the tree that produces good and evil and the consequences for doing so.
- Eve is Adam’s flesh and bones
- They are both naked and are not ashamed.

The Sabbath

Gen 2:1-6 (NKJV) "Thus the heavens and the earth, and all the host of them, were finished. [2] And on the **seventh day** God ended His work which He had done, and He rested [shabath:H7673] on the **seventh day** from all His work which He had done. [3] **Then God blessed the seventh day and sanctified it**, because in it He rested [shabath:H7673] from all His work which God had created and made. [4] This *is* the history of the heavens and the earth when they were created, in the day that the LORD God made the earth and the heavens, [5] before any plant of the field was in the earth and before any herb of the field had grown. For the LORD God had not caused it to rain on the earth, and *there was* no man to till the ground; [6] but a mist went up from the earth and watered the whole face of the ground."

Psa 119:18-19 (NKJV) "Open my eyes, that I may see Wondrous things from Your law. [19] *I am* a stranger in the earth; Do not hide Your commandments from me."

(Rom 10:8 NKJV) "But what does it say? "The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart" (that is, the word of faith which we preach):"

James 1:21-22 (NKJV) "Therefore lay aside all filthiness and overflow of wickedness, and **receive with meekness the implanted word, which is able to save your souls.** [22] **But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves.**"

1 John 2:6 (NKJV) "He who says he abides in Him ought himself also to **walk just as He walked.**"

Col 2:20-23 (NKJV) "Therefore, **if you died with Christ from the basic principles of the world**, why, as *though* living in the world, do you subject yourselves to regulations; [21] **"Do not touch, do not taste, do not handle,"** [22] **which all concern things which perish with the using; according to the commandments and doctrines of men?** [23] These things indeed have an appearance of wisdom in **self-imposed religion, false humility, and neglect of the body, but are** of no value against the indulgence of the flesh." [Isa 28:12-13 tells you the same thing]

Col 3:1-4 (NKJV) "If then you were raised with Christ, **seek those things which are above**, where Christ is, sitting at the right hand of God. [2] **Set your mind on things above, not on things on the earth.** [3] For you died, and your life is hidden with Christ in God. [4] When Christ *who is* our life appears, then you also will appear with Him in glory."

Jer 6:16 (NKJV) "Thus says the LORD: "Stand in the ways and see, And **ask for the old paths, where the good way is**, And **walk in it; Then you will find rest** [margowa':H4771] **for your souls** [nephesh]. But they said, 'We will not walk *in it*.'"

Exo 33:14 (NKJV) "And He said, **"My Presence will go with you, and I will give you rest."**

Psa 116:5-8 (NKJV) "Gracious *is* the LORD, and righteous; Yes, our God *is* merciful. [6] **The LORD preserves the simple**; I was brought low, and He saved me. [7] **Return [shuwb:H7725] to your rest, O my soul [nephesh]**, For the LORD has dealt bountifully with you. [8] For **You have delivered my soul [nephesh] from death**, My eyes from tears, *And* my feet from falling."

Mat 11:28-30 (NKJV) ""**Come to Me**, all *you* who labor and are heavy laden, and **I will give you rest**. [29] **Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me**, for **I am gentle and lowly in heart**, and **you will find rest for your souls [psuche]**. [30] "For My yoke *is* easy and My burden is light.""

Heb 3:9-11 (NKJV) "Where your fathers tested Me, tried Me, And saw My works forty years. [10] Therefore I was angry with that generation, And said, '**They always go astray in their heart, And they have not known My ways.**' [11] So I swore in My wrath, '**They shall not enter My rest.**'""

Heb 4:1-6 (NRSV) "Therefore, while **the promise of entering his rest is still open**, let us take care that none of you should seem to have failed to reach it. [2] For indeed the **good news [gospel]** came to us just as to them; but the message they heard did not benefit them, because they were not united by faith with those who listened. [3] **For we who have believed enter that rest**, just as God has said, "As in my anger I swore, '**They shall not enter my rest,**'" **though his works were finished at the foundation of the world**. [4] For in one place it speaks about the seventh day as follows, "And God rested on the seventh day from all his works." [5] **And again in this place it says, "They shall not enter my rest."** [6] **Since therefore it remains open for some to enter it**, and those who formerly received the good news failed to enter because of **disobedience**,"

Heb 4:7-11 (NRSV) "again he sets a certain day--" **today**--saying through David much later, in the words already quoted, "**Today, if you hear his voice, do not harden your hearts.**" [8] For **if Joshua had given them rest**, God would not speak later about another day. [9] **So then, a sabbath rest still remains for the people of God**; [10] for **those who enter God's rest also cease from their labors as God did from his**. [11] Let us therefore make every effort to enter that rest, **so that no one may fall through such disobedience as theirs.**"

1 Cor 15:27-28 (NKJV) "For "He has put all things under His feet." But when He says "all things are put under *Him*," *it is* evident that He who put all things under Him is excepted. [28] Now when all things are made subject to Him, **then the Son Himself will also be subject to Him who put all things under Him, that God may be all in all.**"
