

## Lesson 14 Gen 2

Pleasant to the sight and good for food – part 2

Gen 2:9 (NKJV) "And **out of the ground** the LORD God made **every tree** grow that is **pleasant to the sight and good for food**. The **tree of life** was **also** in the midst of the garden, and **the tree of the knowledge of good and evil.**"

Gen 2:16-17 (NKJV) "And the LORD God commanded the man, saying, "Of every tree of the garden you may freely eat; [17] "**but of the tree of the knowledge of good and evil you shall not eat, for in the day that you eat of it you shall surely die.**"

Mark 4:13 (NKJV) "And He said to them, "**Do you not understand this parable? How then will you understand all the parables?"**

Prov 11:30 (NKJV) "**The fruit of the righteous is a tree of life**, And he who wins souls *is* wise."

Luke 8:11 (NKJV) "**Now the parable is this: The seed is the word of God.**"

Luke 11:35 (NKJV) "**Therefore take heed that the light which is in you is not darkness.**"

Oba 1:3 (NKJV) "**The pride of your heart has deceived you, You who dwell in the clefts of the rock**, Whose habitation is high; **You who say in your heart**, 'Who will bring me down to the ground?'"

Isa 48:1 (NKJV) "'Hear this, O house of Jacob, Who are called by the name of Israel, And **have come forth from the wellsprings of Judah**; Who swear by the name of the LORD, And make mention of the God of Israel, **But not in truth or in righteousness;**"

Psa 119:151 (KJV) "Thou *art* near, O LORD; and **all thy commandments are truth.**"

Psa 119:142 (KJV) "Thy righteousness *is* an everlasting righteousness, and **thy law is the truth.**"

Luke 6:46 (NIV) "**Why do you call me, 'Lord, Lord,' and do not do what I say?"**

Isa 4:1 (KJV) "And in that day **seven women** shall take hold of one man, saying, **We will eat our own bread, and wear our own apparel**: **only let us** be called by thy name, to take away our reproach."

Deu 8:2 (NKJV) "'And you shall remember that the LORD your God **led you** all the way these forty years in the wilderness, **to humble you and test you, to know what was in your heart**, whether you would **keep His commandments** or not."

Deu 8:16-17 (NKJV) "'**who fed you in the wilderness with manna**, which your fathers did not know, **that He might humble you** and **that He might test you**, to do you good in the end; [17] "then **you say in your heart**, 'My power and the might of my hand have gained me this wealth.'"

2 Chr 7:14 (KJV) "**If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray**, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land."

Mat 11:29 (NIV) "**Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart**, and you will find rest for your souls."

Psa 40:8-10 (KJV) "I delight to do thy will, O my God: yea, **thy law is within my heart.** [9] I have preached **righteousness** in the great congregation: lo, I have not refrained my lips, O LORD, thou knowest. [10] I have not hid **thy righteousness within my heart;** I have declared thy **faithfulness and thy salvation:** I have not concealed thy **lovingkindness and thy truth** from the great congregation."

Num 12:3 (NKJV) "(Now the man Moses *was* very humble, more than all men who *were* on the face of the earth.)"

Ezek 28:17 (NIV) "**Your heart became proud on account of your beauty,** and **you corrupted your wisdom because of your splendor.** So I threw you to the earth; I made a spectacle of you before kings."

Rev 18:7 (NKJV) ""In the measure that **she glorified herself** and lived luxuriously, in the same measure give her torment and sorrow; **for she says in her heart, 'I sit as queen, and am no widow, and will not see sorrow.'**"

Rev 17:4 (NIV) "**The woman was dressed in purple** and scarlet, and was glittering with gold, precious stones and pearls. She held a golden cup in her hand, filled with abominable things and the filth of her adulteries."

Luke 12:1 (KJV) "..., **Beware ye of the leaven of the Pharisees, which is hypocrisy.**"

Mat 23:28 (NKJV) ""Even so you also **outwardly appear righteous to men,** but inside you are full of hypocrisy and lawlessness."

Isa 33:14-17 (NKJV) "**The sinners in Zion** are afraid; **Fearfulness has seized the hypocrites:** "**Who among us shall dwell with the devouring fire? Who among us shall dwell with everlasting burnings?**" [15] **He who walks righteously** and speaks uprightly, He who despises the gain of oppressions, Who gestures with his hands, refusing bribes, Who stops his ears from hearing of bloodshed, And shuts his eyes from seeing evil: [16] He will dwell on high; His place of defense *will be* the fortress of rocks; **Bread will be given him,** **His water will be sure.** [17] **Your eyes will see the King in His beauty; They will see the land that is very far off.**"

Job 13:15 (KJV) "**Though he slay me,** yet will I trust in him: **but I will maintain mine own ways before him.**"

Job 13:15 (NIV) "Though he slay me, yet will I hope in him; **I will surely defend my ways to his face.**"

Job 27:1-6 (NKJV) "Moreover Job continued his discourse, and said: [2] "As God lives, *who* has taken away my justice, And the Almighty, *who* has made my soul bitter, [3] **As long as my breath is in me,** And the breath of God in my nostrils, [4] My lips will not speak wickedness, Nor my tongue utter deceit. [5] Far be it from me That I should say you are right; **Till I die I will not put away my integrity from me.** [6] **My righteousness I hold fast,** and will not let it go; My heart shall not reproach *me* as long as I live."

Job 27:1-6 (NIV) "And Job continued his discourse: [2] "As surely as God lives, *who* **has denied me justice,** the Almighty, *who* has made me taste bitterness of soul, [3] **as long as I have life within me,** the breath of God in my nostrils, [4] my lips will not speak wickedness, and my tongue will utter no deceit. [5] **I will never admit you are in the right; till I die, I will not deny my integrity.** [6] **I will maintain my righteousness and never let go of it;** my conscience will not reproach me as long as I live."

Job 12:22 (NKJV) "He **uncovers deep things out of darkness,** And brings the shadow of death to light."

1 John 2:16 (NKJV) "For all that *is* in the world; the lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and **the pride of life;** is not of the Father but **is of the world.**"

John 12:24-25 (NKJV) ""**Most assuredly**, I say to you, **unless a grain of wheat falls into the ground and dies, it remains alone; but if it dies, it produces much grain.** [25] "He who loves his life will lose it, and he who hates his life in this world will keep it for eternal life."

Phil 2:8 (NKJV) "And being found in appearance as a man, **He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death**, even the death of the cross."

Prov 6:23 (NKJV) "For **the commandment is a lamp**, And **the law a light**; Reproofs of instruction *are* the way of life,"

Psa 119:105 (NKJV) "**Your word is a lamp** to my feet And a light to my path."

Psa 51:6 (NKJV) "Behold, **You desire truth [Torah/LAW/light] in the inward parts**, And in the hidden *part* You **will make me to know wisdom.**"

Isa 53:2-3 (NKJV) "**For He** shall grow up before Him as a **tender plant**, And as **a root out of dry ground. He has no form or comeliness; And when we see Him, There is no beauty that we should desire Him.** [3] He is despised and rejected by men, A Man of sorrows and acquainted with grief. **And we hid, as it were, our faces from Him**; He was despised, and **we did not esteem Him.**"

Lev 19:19 (NKJV) ""**You shall** keep My statutes. You shall not let your livestock breed with another kind. **You shall not sow your field with mixed seed.** Nor shall a garment of mixed linen and wool come upon you."

Deu 22:9 (NKJV) ""**You shall not sow your vineyard with different kinds of seed, lest the yield of the seed which you have sown and the fruit of your vineyard be defiled.**"

Mat 13:25 (KJV) "But while **men** slept, **his enemy came and sowed tares** among the wheat, and went his way."

Mat 13:37-39 (KJV) "He answered and said unto them, **He that soweth the good seed is the Son of man; [38] The field is the world; the good seed are the children of the kingdom; but the tares are the children of the wicked one; [39] The enemy that sowed them is the devil;** the harvest is the end of the world; and the reapers are the angels."

Mat 15:13 (NKJV) "But He answered and said, "**Every plant which My heavenly Father has not planted will be uprooted.**"

Rev 2:7 (NKJV) ""**He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches. To him who overcomes I will give to eat from the tree of life, which is in the midst of the Paradise of God.**""

Ezek 18:32 "For **I take no pleasure in the death of anyone**, declares the Sovereign LORD. **Repent and live!**"

Mat 18:14 (NKJV) ""**Even so it is not the will of your Father who is in heaven that one of these little ones should perish.**"

James 1:12-15 (NKJV) "**Blessed is the man who endures temptation**; for when he has been approved, he will receive the crown of life which the Lord has promised to those who love Him. [13] **Let no one say when he is tempted, "I am tempted by God"**"; for **God cannot be tempted by evil, nor does He Himself tempt anyone.** [14] But each one is tempted when he is drawn away by **his own desires** and enticed. [15] Then, when desire has conceived, it gives birth to sin; and sin, when it is full-grown, brings forth death."

Gen 3:6 (KJV) "And when the woman saw that the tree *was* good for food, and that it *was* pleasant to the eyes, **and a tree to be desired to make one wise**, she took of the fruit thereof, and did eat, and gave also unto her husband with her; and he did eat."

Mat 24:24 (NKJV) ""For false christs and false prophets will rise and show great signs and wonders to deceive, if possible, even the **elect**."

John 17:17 (NKJV) ""Sanctify them by Your truth. **Your word is truth**."

Prov 16:18 (NKJV) "**Pride goes before destruction**, And **a haughty spirit before a fall**."

Rom 11:20-21 (NKJV) "Well *said*. Because of unbelief they were broken off, and **you stand by faith**. **Do not be haughty, but fear**. [21] For if God did not spare the natural branches, He may not spare you either."

2 Cor 11:3-4 (NKJV) "But I fear, lest somehow, **as the serpent deceived Eve** by his **craftiness**, so **your minds [noema:G3540] may be corrupted** from the simplicity that is in Christ. [4] For if he who comes preaches **another Jesus** whom we have not preached, or *if* you receive a **different spirit** which you have not received, or a **different gospel** which you have not accepted; you may well put up with it!"

Eph 1:11 (NKJV) "In Him also we have obtained an inheritance, **being predestined** according to the purpose of Him **who works all things according to the counsel of His will**,"

Hab 2:4 (NKJV) ""Behold the proud, **His soul [nephesh:H5315] is not upright in him**; But the just shall live by his **faith**."

Jer 17:9-10 (NKJV) ""**The heart is deceitful above all things**, And **desperately wicked**; **Who can know it?** [10] I, the LORD, search the **heart**, I test the **mind**, Even to give every man according to his ways, **According to the fruit of his doings**."

Gen 3:5 (NKJV) ""For God knows that in the **day you eat** of it your eyes will be opened, and **you will be like God, knowing good and evil**.""

Gen 1:26 (NKJV) "Then God said, "Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness; **let them have dominion** over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over the cattle, over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth.""

Gen 1:28 (NKJV) "Then God blessed them, and God said to them, "Be fruitful and multiply; **fill the earth and subdue it; have dominion** over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over every living thing that moves on the earth.""

Gen 2:15 (KJV) "And the LORD God took the man, and put him into the garden of Eden to dress it and to **keep [shamar:H8104] it**."

Mat 13:24-25 (NKJV) "Another parable He put forth to them, saying: "**The kingdom of heaven is like a man who sowed good seed in his field; [25] "but while men [anthropos:G444/ Adam] slept**, his enemy came and sowed tares among the wheat and went his way."

Mat 25:5 (NKJV) ""**But while the bridegroom was delayed, they all slumbered and slept**."
