

Behold! The Lamb

John 1:29-30 (NKJV) "The next day John saw Jesus coming toward him, and said, "**Behold! The Lamb of God who takes away the sin of the world!** [30] "This is He of whom I said, 'After me comes a Man who is preferred before me, for He was before me.'"

Gen 22:8 (NKJV) "And Abraham said, "My son, **God will provide for Himself the lamb for a burnt offering.**" So the two of them went together."

2 Cor 4:18 (NKJV) "while we **do not look at the things which are seen**, but at the things which are not seen. For the things which are seen *are* temporary, but the things which are not seen *are* eternal."

Mal 3:1 "See, **I will send my messenger, who will prepare the way before me. Then suddenly the Lord you are seeking will come to his temple; the messenger of the covenant, whom you desire, will come.**" says the LORD Almighty."

Exo 23:14 (KJV) "**Three times** thou shalt keep a feast unto me **in the year.**"

Exo 23:17 (KJV) "**Three times in the year** all thy males shall appear before the Lord GOD."

Deu 16:16 (KJV) "**Three times in a year** shall all thy males appear before the LORD thy God **in the place which he shall choose**; in the feast of **unleavened bread**, and in the **feast of weeks**, and in the **feast of tabernacles**: and they shall not appear before the LORD empty:"

Deu 12:13-14 (NKJV) ""Take heed to yourself that you **do not offer your burnt offerings in every place that you see**; [14] "**but in the place which the LORD chooses**, in one of your tribes, there you shall offer your burnt offerings, **and there you shall do all that I command you.**" [Do you think the "there" is a physical place]

Deu 12:26 (NKJV) ""Only the holy things which you have, and your vowed offerings, **you shall take and go to the place which the LORD chooses.**"

Deu 16:2 (NKJV) ""Therefore **you shall sacrifice the Passover** to the LORD your God, from the flock and the herd, **in the place where the LORD chooses to put His name.**"

Deu 16:6 (NKJV) ""but at the place **where the LORD your God chooses to make His name abide**, there **you shall sacrifice the Passover at twilight**, at the **going down of the sun**, at the time you came out of Egypt."

John 4:20-21 (NKJV) ""Our fathers worshiped on this mountain, and you *Jews* say that in **Jerusalem is the place where one ought to worship.**" [21] Jesus said to her, "**Woman, believe Me, the hour is coming when you will neither on this mountain, nor in Jerusalem, worship the Father.**"

John 4:23-24 (NKJV) ""But **the hour is coming, and now is**, when the **true worshipers** will worship the Father in spirit and truth; for the Father is seeking such to worship Him. [24] "**God is Spirit**, and those who worship Him **must worship** in spirit and truth.""

John 4:25-26 (NKJV) "The woman said to Him, "**I know that Messiah is coming**" (who is called Christ). "**When He comes, He will tell us all things.**" [26] Jesus said to her, "**I who speak to you am He.**"

Mark 14:58 (NKJV) ""We heard Him say, "**I will destroy this temple made with hands, and within three days I will build another made without hands.**"

2 Cor 5:1 (NKJV) "For we know that if our earthly house, *this* tent, is destroyed, we have a building from God, a house not **made with hands**, eternal in the heavens."

1 Cor 3:16-17 (NKJV) "Do you not know that **you are the temple** of God and *that* the Spirit of God dwells in you? [17] If anyone defiles the temple of God, God will destroy him. For the temple of God is holy, which *temple* you are."

John 17:11 (NASB) ""And I am no more in the world; and *yet* they themselves are in the world, and I come to Thee. Holy Father, **keep them in Thy name, the name which Thou hast given Me**, that they may be one, even as *We are.*" [See also the Aramaic New Testament]

Exo 23:20-21 (NKJV) ""Behold, I send an Angel before you **to keep you in the way and to bring you into the place which I have prepared.** [21] "Beware of Him and obey His voice; do not provoke Him, for He will not pardon your transgressions; **for My name is in Him.**"

Rev 3:12-13 (NKJV) ""He who overcomes, **I will make him a pillar in the temple of My God, and he shall go out no more. And I will write on him the name of My God and the name of the city of My God, the New Jerusalem, which comes down out of heaven from My God. And I will write on him My new name.** [13] "He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches."

Rev 21:9-11 (NKJV) "Then one of the seven angels who had the seven bowls filled with the seven last plagues came to me and talked with me, saying, "Come, **I will show you the bride, the Lamb's wife.**" [10] And he carried me away in the Spirit to a great and high mountain, and showed me **the great city, the holy Jerusalem, descending out of heaven from God,** [11] having the glory of God. Her light *was* like a most precious stone, like a jasper stone, clear as crystal."

Heb 11:13-16 (NKJV) "These all died in faith, **not having received the promises, but having seen them afar off were assured of them, embraced them and confessed** that they were strangers and pilgrims on the earth. [14] For those who say such things declare plainly that they seek a homeland. [15] And truly if they had called to mind that *country* from which they had come out, they would have had opportunity to return. [16] **But now they desire a better, that is, a heavenly country.** Therefore God is not ashamed to be called their God, for **He has prepared a city for them.**"

Heb 12:22-24 (NKJV) "But you have come to Mount Zion and to **the city of the living God, the heavenly Jerusalem,** to an innumerable company of angels, [23] to **the general assembly and church of the firstborn who are registered in heaven,** to God the Judge of all, to the spirits of just men made perfect, [24] to Jesus the Mediator of the new covenant, and to the blood of sprinkling that speaks better things than *that of* Abel."

Prov 9:1-6 (NKJV) "Wisdom **has built her house,** She has hewn out **her seven pillars;** [2] **She has slaughtered her meat, She has mixed her wine,** She has also furnished her table. [3] She has sent out her maidens, She cries out from the highest places of the city, [4] "**Whoever is simple, let him turn in here!**" As for him who lacks understanding, she says to him, [5] "**Come, eat of my bread And drink of the wine I have mixed.** [6] **Forsake foolishness and live, And go in the way of understanding.**"

Mat 26:26-29 (NKJV) "And as they were eating, **Jesus took bread**, blessed and broke *it*, and gave *it* to the disciples and said, "**Take, eat; this is My body.**" [27] Then **He took the cup**, and gave thanks, and gave *it* to them, saying, "**Drink from it, all of you.**" [28] "**For this is My blood of the new covenant, which is shed for many for the remission of sins.**" [29] "But I say to you, I will not drink of this fruit of the vine from now on until that day when I drink it new with you in My Father's kingdom.""

John 6:48 (NKJV) ""I am the bread of life."

John 6:53-56 (NKJV) "Then Jesus said to them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, **unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His blood, you have no life in you.**" [54] "**Whoever eats My flesh and drinks My blood** has eternal life, and I will raise him up at the last day. [55] "**For My flesh is food indeed, and My blood is drink indeed.**" [56] "He who **eats My flesh and drinks My blood** abides in Me, and I in him."

John 6:63 (NKJV) ""It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh profits nothing. **The words that I speak to you are spirit, and they are life.**"

John 3:16-21 (NKJV) ""**For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life.**" [17] "For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world **through Him might be saved.**" [18] "He who believes in Him is not condemned; but **he who does not believe is condemned already**, because **he has not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God.**" [19] "And **this is the condemnation**, that **the light has come into the world**, and **men loved darkness rather than light**, because their deeds were evil. [20] "For everyone practicing evil hates the light and does not come to the light, lest his deeds should be exposed. [21] "**But he who does the truth [To do the Truth is to walk in His Law - Your Word is Truth] comes to the light, that his deeds may be clearly seen, that they have been done in God.**"

Eph 2:10 (NKJV) "For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them."

Rev 13:8-9 (NKJV) "... **slain from the foundation of the world.**" [9] **If anyone has an ear, let him hear.**"

(Mark 7:6-9 NIV) "He replied, "Isaiah was right when he prophesied about you **hypocrites**; as it is written: "**These people honor me with their lips, but their hearts are far from me.**" [7] They worship me in vain; **their teachings are but rules taught by men.**" [8] **You have let go of the commands of God and are holding on to the traditions of men.**" [9] And he said to them: "You have a fine way of setting aside the commands of God in order to observe your own traditions!"

John 6:63 (NKJV) ""It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh profits nothing. The words that I speak to you are spirit, and they are life."

Col 2:22-23 (NKJV) "which all concern things which perish with the using; according to **the commandments and doctrines of men**?" [23] These things indeed have an appearance of wisdom in self-imposed religion, *false* humility, and neglect of the body, *but are* of no value against the indulgence of the flesh."

Psa 107:14-20 (NKJV) "**He brought them out of darkness and the shadow of death**, And broke their chains in pieces. [15] Oh, that *men* would give thanks to the LORD *for* His goodness, And *for* His wonderful works to the children of men! [16] For He has broken the gates of bronze, And cut the bars of iron in two. [17] Fools,

because of their transgression, And because of **their iniquities,** were afflicted. [18] **Their soul abhorred all manner of food,** And they drew near to the gates of death. [19] Then they cried out to the LORD in their trouble, *And* He saved them out of their distresses. [20] **He sent His word and healed them, And delivered them from their destructions."**

Rom 14:23 (NKJV) "But he who doubts is condemned if he eats, because *he does not eat* from faith; for **whatever is not from faith is sin."**

Mat 16:6-12 (NKJV) "Then Jesus said to them, "Take heed and beware of the leaven of the Pharisees and the Sadducees." [7] And they reasoned among themselves, saying, "It is because we have taken no bread." [8] But Jesus, being aware of *it,* said to them, "**O you of little faith, [whatever is not of faith is sin] why do you reason among yourselves because you have brought no bread?** [9] "Do you not yet understand, or remember the five loaves of the five thousand and how many baskets you took up? [10] "Nor the seven loaves of the four thousand and how many large baskets you took up? [11] "**How is it you do not understand that I did not speak to you concerning bread?; but to beware of the leaven of the Pharisees and Sadducees."** [12] Then they understood that **He did not tell them to beware of the leaven of bread, but of the doctrine of the Pharisees and Sadducees."**

Luke 12:1 (NKJV) "In the meantime, when an innumerable multitude of people had gathered together, so that they trampled one another, He began to say to His disciples first *of all,* "**Beware of the leaven of the Pharisees, which is hypocrisy."**

1 Cor 5:1-2 (NKJV) "It is actually reported *that there is* sexual immorality among you, and such sexual immorality as is not even named among the Gentiles; that a man has his father's wife! [2] And you are puffed up,"

1 Cor 5:6-8 (NKJV) "Your glorying *is* not good. **Do you not know that a little leaven leavens the whole lump?** [7] Therefore **purge out the old leaven,** that you may be a new lump, since you truly are unleavened. **For indeed Christ, our Passover, was sacrificed for us.** [8] Therefore **let us keep the feast,** not with old leaven, nor with **the leaven of malice and wickedness,** but with **the unleavened bread of sincerity and truth."**

1 Cor 11:23-29 (NKJV) "For I received from the Lord that which I also delivered to you: that the Lord Jesus on the *same* night in which He was betrayed took bread; [24] and when He had given thanks, He broke *it* and said, "**Take, eat; this is My body which is broken for you; do this in remembrance of Me.**" [25] In the same manner *He* also took the cup after supper, saying, "**This cup is the new covenant in My blood. This do, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of Me.**" [26] For as often as you **eat this** bread and drink this cup, you proclaim the Lord's death till He comes. [27] Therefore whoever eats this bread or drinks *this* cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner will be guilty of the body and blood of the Lord. [28] But let a man examine himself, and so let him eat of the bread and drink of the cup. [29] For he who eats and drinks in an unworthy manner eats and drinks judgment to himself, not discerning the Lord's body."

John 6:54-55 (NKJV) ""Whoever eats My flesh and drinks My blood has eternal life, and I will raise him up at the last day. [55] "For My flesh is food indeed, and My blood is drink indeed."

His flesh and blood is the "sum" of His Word!
