

Lesson 7 Genesis 2 Sabbath part 2

Exo 33:14 (NKJV) "And He said, "**My Presence** will go *with you*, and **I will give you rest**. [nuwach:H5117- from where we get the word Noah] ""

1 Cor 10:4 (NKJV) "and all drank the same spiritual drink. For they drank of that **spiritual Rock that followed them, and that Rock was Christ**."

Prov 14:25 (NKJV) "**A true witness delivers [saves] souls**, But a deceitful *witness* speaks lies."

John 6:63 (NKJV) ""It is the Spirit who gives life; **the flesh profits nothing**. The words that I speak to you **are spirit, and they are life**."

Mat 23:25-28 (NKJV) ""Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! **For you cleanse the outside of the cup and dish**, but inside they are full of extortion and self-indulgence. [26] "Blind Pharisee, **first cleanse the inside of the cup and dish, that the outside of them may be clean also**. [27] "Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you are like whitewashed tombs which indeed **appear beautiful outwardly, but inside** are full of dead *men's* bones and all uncleanness. [28] "Even so **you also outwardly appear righteous to men, but inside you are full of hypocrisy and lawlessness**."

Mat 23:23-24 (NKJV) ""Woe to you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! For you pay tithes of mint and anise and cummin, and **have neglected the weightier matters of the law: justice and mercy and faith**. These you ought to have done, without leaving the others undone. [24] "**Blind guides, who strain out a gnat and swallow a camel!**""

Mat 12:5-8 (NIV) "Or haven't you read in the Law that on **the Sabbath the priests in the temple desecrate the day and yet are innocent?** [6] **I tell you that one greater than the temple is here**. [7] If you had known what these words mean, **I desire mercy, not sacrifice**,' you would not have condemned **the innocent**. [8] **For the Son of Man is Lord of the Sabbath**.""

John 6:66 (NKJV) "From that *time* **many of His disciples** went back [lift-up their heel] and **walked with Him no more**."

1 Cor 2:14 (NKJV) "But **the natural man does not receive the things of the Spirit of God**, for they are foolishness to him; **nor can he know them**, because **they are spiritually discerned**."

1 Cor 2:13 (NKJV) "These things we also speak, **not in words which man's wisdom teaches** but which the Holy Spirit teaches, **comparing spiritual things with spiritual**."

Rom 1:20 (NKJV) "For since the creation of the world **His invisible attributes** are clearly seen, **being understood by the things that are made**, *even* His eternal power and Godhead, so that they are without excuse,"

Prov 12:18 (NKJV) "**There is one who speaks like the piercings of a sword**, But **the tongue of the wise promotes health**."

Luke 10:22 (NKJV) ""**All things** have been delivered to Me by My Father, and **no one knows who the Son is except the Father, and who the Father is except the Son, and the one to whom the Son wills to reveal Him**.""

Mat 7:23 (NKJV) ""And then I will declare to them, **I never knew you; depart from Me, you who practice lawlessness!**""

Mat 11:28-30 (NKJV) ""Come to Me, all *you* who **labor and are heavy laden**, and **I will give you rest**. [29] "**Take My yoke upon you** and **learn from Me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart**, and **you will find rest for your souls**. [30] "For My yoke *is* easy and My burden is light.""

Eph 6:5-8 (NKJV) "**Bondservants, be obedient to those who are your masters according to the flesh, with fear and trembling, in sincerity of heart, as to Christ**; [6] not with eyeservice, as men-pleasers, but as bondservants of Christ, **doing the will of God from the heart**, [7] with goodwill doing service, as to the Lord, and not to men, [8] knowing that whatever good anyone does, he will receive the same from the Lord, whether *he* is a slave or free."

Psa 40:6-10 (NKJV) "Sacrifice and offering You did not desire; **My ears You have opened**. Burnt offering and sin offering You did not require. [7] Then I said, "**Behold, I come; In the scroll of the book it is written of me**. [8] **I delight to do Your will**, O my God, And **Your law is within my heart**." [9] **I have proclaimed the good news of righteousness In the great assembly**; Indeed, I do not restrain my lips, O LORD, You Yourself know. [10] **I have not hidden Your righteousness within my heart**; I have declared Your **faithfulness** and **Your salvation**; I have not concealed **Your lovingkindness and Your truth** From the great assembly."

Psa 119:25 (NKJV) "My soul clings to the dust; **Revive me according to Your word**."

Psa 119:45 (NKJV) "And I will **walk at liberty**, For I seek Your precepts."

Psa 119:30 (NKJV) "I have chosen **the way of truth**; Your judgments I have laid *before me*."

Psa 119:165 (NKJV) "Great **peace have those who love Your law**, And nothing causes them to stumble."

Psa 19:7 (NKJV) "for the law of Yahweh is perfect converting, **(restoring, reviving) the soul...**"

Jer 8:7-9 (NKJV) ""Even the stork in **the heavens Knows her appointed times [mow'ed:H4150]**; And the turtledove, the swift, and the swallow **Observe [shamar:H8104]** the time of their coming. **But My people do not know the judgment of the LORD**. [8] "How can you say, 'We *are* wise, And the law of the LORD *is* with us'? **Look, the false pen of the scribe certainly works falsehood**. [9] The wise men are ashamed, They are dismayed and taken. **Behold, they have rejected the word of the LORD; So what wisdom do they have?**"

Exo 20:8-11 (NKJV) ""**Remember the Sabbath day**, to keep it holy. [9] Six days you shall labor and do all your work, [10] but **the seventh day is** the Sabbath of the LORD your God. *In it* you shall do no work: you, nor your son, nor your daughter, nor your male servant, nor your female servant, nor your cattle, nor your stranger who *is* within your gates. [11] **For in six days the LORD made the heavens and the earth, the sea, and all that is in them, and rested the seventh day. Therefore the LORD blessed the Sabbath day and hallowed it.**"

Deu 5:12-15 (NKJV) ""**Observe the Sabbath day**, to keep it holy, as the LORD your God commanded you. [13] Six days you shall labor and do all your work, [14] but **the seventh day is** the Sabbath of the LORD your God. *In it* you shall do no work: you, nor your son, nor your daughter, nor your male servant, nor your female servant, nor your ox, nor your donkey, nor any of your cattle, nor your stranger who *is* within your gates, that your male servant and your female servant may rest as well as you. [15] **And remember that you were a slave in the land of Egypt, and the LORD your God brought you out from there by a mighty hand and by an outstretched arm; therefore the LORD your God commanded you to keep the Sabbath day.**"

Mat 12:10-14 (NKJV) "And behold, there was a man who had a withered hand. And they asked Him, saying, "**Is it lawful to heal on the Sabbath?**"; **that they might accuse Him**. [11] Then He said to them, "**What man is there among you who has one sheep, and if it falls into a pit on the Sabbath, will not lay hold of it and lift it out?** [12] "**Of how much more value then is a man than a sheep?** Therefore **it is lawful to do good on the Sabbath**." [13] Then He said to the man, "**Stretch out your hand**." And he stretched *it* out, and it was restored as whole as the other. [14] Then the Pharisees went out and plotted against Him, how they might destroy Him."

Mark 3:1-6 (NKJV) "And He entered the synagogue again, and a man was there who had a withered hand. [2] **So they watched Him closely, whether He would heal him on the Sabbath, so that they might accuse Him.** [3] And He said to the man who had the withered hand, "Step forward." [4] Then He said to them, "**Is it lawful on the Sabbath to do good or to do evil, to save life or to kill?**" **But they kept silent.** [5] And when He had looked around at them with anger, **being grieved by the hardness of their hearts,** He said to the man, "Stretch out your hand." And he stretched it out, and his hand was restored as whole as the other. [6] Then the Pharisees went out and immediately plotted with the Herodians against Him, how they might destroy Him."

John 5:5-18 (NKJV) "Now a certain man was there who had an infirmity thirty-eight years. [6] When Jesus saw him lying there, and knew that he already had been *in that condition* a long time, He said to him, "**Do you want to be made well?**" [7] The sick man answered Him, "Sir, I have no man to **put me into the pool when the water is stirred up;** but while I am coming, another steps down before me." [8] Jesus said to him, "**Rise, take up your bed and walk.**" [9] And immediately the man was made well, took up his bed, and walked. **And that day was the Sabbath.** [10] The Jews therefore said to him who was cured, "**It is the Sabbath; it is not lawful for you to carry your bed.**" [11] He answered them, "He **who made me well** said to me, 'Take up your bed and walk.'" [12] Then they asked him, "Who is the Man who said to you, 'Take up your bed and walk?'" [13] But the one who was healed did not know who it was, for Jesus had withdrawn, a multitude being in *that place*. [14] Afterward Jesus found him in the temple, and said to him, "See, **you have been made well. Sin no more, lest a worse thing come upon you.**" [15] The man departed and told the Jews that it was Jesus who had made him well. [16] For this reason the Jews persecuted Jesus, and sought to kill Him, **because He had done these things on the Sabbath.** [17] But Jesus answered them, "**My Father has been working until now, and I have been working.**" [18] **Therefore the Jews sought all the more to kill Him, because He not only broke the Sabbath, but also said that God was His Father, making Himself equal with God.**"

Isa 29:18 (NKJV) "In that day the deaf shall hear the words of the book, And the eyes of **the blind** shall see out of obscurity and out of darkness."

Isa 35:4-7 (NKJV) "Say to those *who are* fearful-hearted, "Be strong, do not fear! **Behold, your God will come with vengeance, With the recompense of God; He will come and save you.**" [5] **Then the eyes of the blind shall be opened, And the ears of the deaf shall be unstopped.** [6] **Then the lame shall leap like a deer, And the tongue of the dumb sing. For waters shall burst forth in the wilderness, And streams in the desert.** [7] The parched ground shall **become a pool,** And the **thirsty land springs of water;** In the habitation of jackals, where each lay, *There shall be* grass with reeds and rushes."

Jer 17:21-23 (NKJV) "'Thus says the LORD: "Take heed to yourselves, and **bear no burden [massa':H4853] on the Sabbath day, nor bring it in by the gates of Jerusalem;** [22] **"nor carry a burden [massa':H4853] out of your houses on the Sabbath day,** nor do any work, but hallow the Sabbath day, as I commanded your fathers. [23] "But they did not obey nor incline their ear, but made their neck stiff, that they might not hear nor receive instruction."

4853. massa', mas-saw'; from H5375; a **burden**; spec. tribute, or (abstr.) portage; fig. **an utterance**, chiefly a doom, espec. singing; **mental, desire**:--burden, carry away, **prophecy**, X they set, song, tribute.

Exo 5:5 (KJV) "And Pharaoh said, Behold, the people of the land now *are* many, and ye make them rest **[shabath:H7673] from their burdens [cebalah:H5450].**"

H5450. cebalah, seb-aw-law'; from H5447; portage:--burden.

Psa 38:4 (NKJV) "For **my iniquities** have gone over my head; **Like a heavy burden [massa':H4853] they are too heavy for me.**"

Jer 23:36 (KJV) "And the **burden** [massa':H4853] of the LORD shall ye mention no more: **for every man's word shall be his burden** [massa':H4853]; **for ye have perverted the words of the living God, of the LORD of hosts our God.**"

John 5:5-17-18 "But Jesus answered them, **"My Father has been working until now, and I have been working."** [18] **Therefore the Jews sought all the more to kill Him, because He not only broke the Sabbath, but also said that God was His Father, making Himself equal with God.** "

Mark 2:27 (KJV) "... **The sabbath was made for man, and not man for the sabbath:**"

John 5:21 (NKJV) **"For as the Father raises the dead and gives life to *them*, even so the Son gives life to whom He will."**

Luke 13:32 (NKJV) "And He said to them, "Go, tell that fox, 'Behold, I cast out demons and perform cures today and tomorrow, and the third *day* I shall **be perfected.**'"

John 7:19-24 (NKJV) **"Did not Moses give you the law, yet none of you keeps the law? Why do you seek to kill Me?"** [20] The people answered and said, "You have a demon. Who is seeking to kill You?" [21] Jesus answered and said to them, **"I did one work, and you all marvel. [22] "Moses therefore gave you circumcision (not that it is from Moses, but from the fathers), and you circumcise a man on the Sabbath. [23] "If a man receives circumcision on the Sabbath, so that the law of Moses should not be broken, are you angry with Me because I made a man completely well on the Sabbath? [24] "Do not judge according to appearance, but judge with righteous judgment."**"

Isa 58:12-14 (NKJV) "Those from among you Shall **build the old waste places**; You shall raise up the foundations of many generations; And you shall be called the Repairer of the Breach, The Restorer of Streets to Dwell In. [13] "If you **turn away your foot from the Sabbath, From doing your pleasure** on My holy day, And **call the Sabbath a delight**, The holy *day* of the LORD honorable, And shall honor Him, **not doing your own ways, Nor finding your own pleasure, Nor speaking your own words**, [14] Then you shall delight yourself in the LORD; And I will cause you to ride on the high hills of the earth, And feed you with the heritage of Jacob your father. The mouth of the LORD has spoken."
