Deu 30:15,19 (NKJV) "See, <u>I have set before you today life</u> and <u>good</u>, <u>death</u> and <u>evil</u>,... [19] I call heaven and earth as witnesses today against you, *that* <u>I have set before you</u> life and death, blessing and cursing; <u>therefore choose life</u>, that both you and your descendants may live;""

Isa 45:7 (KJV) "I form the light, and create darkness: I make peace, and create evil: I the LORD do all these things."

Prov 16:4 (KIV) "The LORD hath made all *things* for himself: yea, even the wicked for the day of evil."
