

The Garden Part 2

Trees need Water to produce fruit

Deu 11:10-11 (NKJV) For the land which you go to possess **is not like the land of Egypt** from which you have come, where you sowed your seed and **watered it by foot**, as a vegetable garden; ^[111] but the land which you cross over to possess *is* a land of hills and valleys, which **drinks water from the rain of heaven**,

Mat 13:39 (NKJV) **The enemy who sowed them is the devil, the harvest is the end of the age, and the reapers are the angels.**

Mat 9:37-38 (NKJV) Then He said to His disciples, "**The harvest truly *is* plentiful, but the laborers *are* few.** ^[38] Therefore **pray the Lord of the harvest to send out laborers** into His harvest."

John 4:34-36 (NKJV) Jesus said to them, "**My food is to do the will of Him who sent Me**, and to finish His work. ^[35] **Do you not say, There are still four months and then comes the harvest? Behold, I say to you, lift up your eyes and look at the fields, for they are already white for harvest!** ^[36] **And he who reaps receives wages, and gathers fruit for eternal life, that both he who sows and he who reaps may rejoice together.**

Rev 1:8 (NKJV) **"I am the Alpha and the Omega, the Beginning and the End,"** says the Lord, **"who is and who was and who is to come, the Almighty."**

Rev 1:3 (KJV) Blessed *is* he **[in every generation]** that **readeth**, and they that **hear** the words of this prophecy, **and keep** those things which are written therein: **for the time *is* at hand.**

1Tim 6:20-21 (KJV) O Timothy, keep that which is committed to thy trust, avoiding profane *and* vain babblings, **and oppositions of science falsely so called:** ^[21] Which some professing **have erred concerning the faith.** Grace *be* with thee. Amen.

Heb 5:13 (NKJV) For everyone who partakes **only of milk is unskilled in the word of righteousness**, for he is a babe.

1Pet 2:2 (NKJV) as newborn babes, **desire the pure milk of the word, that you may grow thereby.**

Isa 28:9 (KJV) Whom shall he teach knowledge? and whom **shall he make to understand doctrine?** **them that are weaned from the milk, and drawn from the breasts.**

1Cor 2:8 (NKJV) which none of the rulers of this age knew; for **had they known, they would not have crucified the Lord of glory.**

1Cor 15:36-38 (NKJV) **Foolish one, what you sow is not made alive unless it dies.** ^[37] And what you sow, **you do not sow that body that shall be**, but mere grain--**perhaps wheat** or some other *grain*. ^[38] **But God gives it a body as He pleases, and to each seed its own body.**

John 12:24 (KJV) **Verily, verily, I say unto you, Except a corn of wheat fall into the ground and die, it abideth alone: but if it die, it bringeth forth much fruit.**

Lev 2:14 (KJV) And if thou offer a meat **[grain]** offering of **thy firstfruits unto the LORD**, thou shalt offer for the meat offering of thy **firstfruits green ears of corn dried by the fire**, *even* corn beaten out of full ears.

Deu 12:2 (NKJV) You shall utterly destroy all the places where the nations which you shall dispossess served their gods, on the high mountains and on the hills and under **every green tree**.

Psa 37:35 (NKJV) I have seen **the wicked in great power**, And **spreading himself like a native green tree**.

1Cor 15:20-23 (NKJV) But now Christ is risen from the dead, *and* **has become the firstfruits** of those who have fallen asleep. ^[21] **For since by man came death, by Man also came the resurrection of the dead.** ^[22] **For as in Adam all die**, even so in Christ all shall be made alive. ^[23] But **each one in his own order**: Christ the firstfruits, afterward **those who are Christ's at His coming**.

1Cor 15:42-45 (NKJV) So also *is* the resurrection of the dead. *The body* is **sown in corruption**, it is **raised in incorruption**. ^[43] It is **sown in dishonor**, it is **raised in glory**. It is **sown in weakness**, it is **raised in power**. ^[44] It is **sown a natural body**, it is **raised a spiritual body**. There is a **natural body**, and there is a **spiritual body**. ^[45] And so it is written, "**The first man Adam became a living being/soul.**" **The last Adam became a life-giving spirit.**

Hos 10:12-13 (NKJV) **Sow for yourselves righteousness; Reap in mercy;** Break up your fallow ground, For *it is time to seek the LORD*, Till He comes and **rains righteousness on you.** ^[13] You have plowed wickedness; You have reaped iniquity. **You have eaten the fruit of lies, Because you trusted in your own way.** In the multitude of your mighty men.

John 15:8 (NKJV) **By this My Father is glorified, that you bear much fruit;** so you will be My disciples.

Rom 2:13 (NKJV) (for not the hearers of the law *are* just in the sight of God, but **the doers of the law will be justified;**

Luke 3:9 (NKJV) And **even now the ax is laid to the root of the trees.** Therefore **every tree which does not bear good fruit** is cut down and thrown into the fire."

Lev 26:4 (NKJV) then **I will give you rain in its season,** the **land shall yield its produce,** and the **trees of the field shall yield their fruit.**

Exo 15:23-27 (KJV) And when they came to Marah, they **could not drink of the waters** of Marah, **for they were bitter:** therefore the name of it was called Marah. ^[24] And the people murmured against Moses, saying, What shall we drink? ^[25] And he cried unto the LORD; **and the LORD shewed him a tree,** which when he had cast into the waters, **the waters were made sweet:** **there he made for them a statute and an ordinance,** and there he proved them. ^[26] And said, If thou wilt **diligently hearken to the voice of the LORD thy God,** and wilt do that which is right in his sight, and wilt give ear to his **commandments,** and **keep all his statutes,** **I will put none of these diseases** upon thee, which I have brought upon the Egyptians: **for I am the LORD that healeth thee.** ^[27] And they came to Elim, where were **twelve wells of water,** and **threescore and ten palm trees:** and they encamped there by the waters.

Exo 15:17 (NKJV) You will bring them in and **plant them In the mountain of Your inheritance,** In the place, O LORD, which You have made For Your own dwelling, **The sanctuary, O LORD, which Your hands have established.**

Amos 6:12 (NKJV) Do horses run on rocks? Does *one* plow *there* with oxen? Yet you have turned **justice** into **gall,** And **the fruit of righteousness into wormwood.**

Jer 9:14-15 (NKJV) but they have walked **according to the dictates of their own hearts** and after the Baals, which their fathers taught them," ^[15] therefore thus says the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel: "Behold, **I will feed them, this people, with wormwood,** and **give them water of gall to drink.**

Rev 8:10-11 (NKJV) Then the **third angel sounded:** And **a great star fell from heaven,** burning like a torch, and **it fell on a third of the rivers and on the springs of water.** ^[11] **The name of the star is Wormwood.** A third of **the waters became wormwood,** and many men died from the water, **because it was made bitter** [G4087 pikrainu]

Deu 29:18-20 (KJV) Lest there should be among you man, or woman, or family, or tribe, **whose heart turneth away** this day from the LORD our God, to go *and* serve the gods of these nations; lest there should be **among you a root that beareth gall and wormwood;** ^[19] And it come to pass, when he heareth the words of this curse, that he bless himself in his heart, saying, I shall have peace, **though I walk in the imagination of mine heart,** to add drunkenness to thirst: ^[20] The LORD will not spare him, but then the anger of the LORD and his jealousy shall smoke against that man, and all the curses that are written in this book shall lie upon him, and **the LORD shall blot out his name from under heaven.**

Rev 22:2 (NKJV) In the middle of its street, and on **either side of the river,** was **the tree of life,** which **bore twelve fruits,** each *tree* yielding its fruit every month. **The leaves of the tree were for the healing of the nations.**

Gen 2:10 (KJV) And **a river went out of Eden to water the garden;** and from thence it was parted, and became into four heads.

Gen 2:6 (NKJV) but a **mist went up from the earth and watered the whole face of the ground.**

Genesis 2:6 (NASB) But a **mist** used to **rise from the earth** and water the whole surface of the ground.

Genesis 2:6 (NIV) but **streams** came **up from the earth** and watered the whole surface of the ground.

Genesis 2:6 (HCSB) But **water** would **come out of the ground** and **water the entire surface of the land.**

Ezekiel 31:3-5, 8-9 (KJV) Behold, **the Assyrian** was a cedar in **Lebanon** with fair branches, and with a shadowing shroud, and of an high stature; and his top was among the thick boughs. ^[4] **The waters made him great,** **the deep [tehom] set him up on high with her rivers** running round about his plants, and **sent out her little rivers unto all the trees of the field.** ^[5] Therefore **his height was exalted** above all the trees of the field, and his boughs were multiplied, and his branches became long **because of the multitude of waters,** when he shot forth...^[8] The cedars in **the garden of God** could not hide him: the fir trees were not like his boughs, and the chesnut trees were not like his branches; **nor any tree in the garden of God** was like unto him in his beauty. [9] I have made him fair by the multitude of his branches: so that **all the trees of Eden, that were in the garden of God, envied him.**

Hos 9:3 (NKJV) They shall not dwell in the LORD'S land, But Ephraim shall **return to Egypt**, And **shall eat unclean things in Assyria**. [see also Eze 4:12-13]

John 4:12-14 (NKJV) Are You greater than our father Jacob, who gave us the well, and **drank from it himself, as well as his sons and his livestock**?"

John 4: 13-14 - Jesus answered and said to her, "**Whoever drinks of this water will thirst again,** ^[14] **but whoever drinks of the water that I shall give him will never thirst. But the water that I shall give him will become in him a fountain of water springing up into everlasting life.**"

James 4:14 (NKJV) "whereas you do not know what *will happen* tomorrow. **For what is your life?** It is **even a vapor that appears for a little time and then vanishes away.**"

1 Cor 15:45-46, 49-50 (KJV) And so it is written, The first man Adam was made **a living soul**; the **last Adam was made a quickening spirit**. ^[46] Howbeit **that was not first which is spiritual, but that which is natural**; and afterward that which is spiritual... ^[49] And as **we have borne the image of the earthy, we shall also bear the image of the heavenly**. ^[50] Now this I say, brethren, that **flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God**; neither doth corruption inherit incorruption.

Rom 14:2 (KJV) For one believeth that he may eat all things: another, **who is weak, eateth herbs**.

Isa 45:8 (NKJV) "**Rain down, you heavens**, from above, **And let the skies pour down righteousness; Let the earth open**, let them bring forth **salvation [Yeshua]**, And let righteousness spring up together. I, the LORD, have created it.

Psa 46:4-5 (NKJV) *There is a river* whose streams **shall make glad the city of God, The holy place of the tabernacle of the Most High**. ^[5] *God is in the midst of her*, she shall not be moved; God shall help her, **just at the break of dawn**.

Psa 16:11 (NKJV) **You will show me the path of life**; In Your presence *is* fullness of joy; At **Your right hand are pleasures** forevermore.

Psa 36:7-11 (NKJV) "How precious *is* Your lovingkindness, O God! Therefore the children of men **put their trust under the shadow of Your wings**. [8] They are abundantly satisfied with the fullness of Your house, And **You give them drink from the river of Your pleasures [eden:H5730]**. [9] **For with You is the fountain of life; In Your light we see light**. [10] Oh, **continue Your lovingkindness to those who know You**, And Your righteousness to the upright in heart. [11] **Let not the foot of pride come against me**, And let not the hand of the wicked drive me away."

Isaiah 55:10-11 (NKJV) ^[10] "**For as the rain comes down**, and **the snow from heaven**, And do not return there, **But water the earth, And make it bring forth and bud**, That it may give seed to the sower And bread to the eater, ^[11] **So shall My word be that goes forth from My mouth**; It shall not return to Me void, But it shall accomplish what I please, And it shall prosper *in the thing* for which I sent it.

Deu 32:1-2 (KJV) **Give ear**, O ye **heavens**, and I will speak; and hear, O **earth, the words of my mouth**. ^[2] **My doctrine shall drop as the rain, my speech shall distil [cleanse, disinfect, sanitize, clean, filter] as the dew**, as the small rain upon the **tender herb**, and as the **showers upon the grass**:

Heb 6:7-8 (NKJV) **For the earth which drinks in the rain** that often comes upon it, and **bears herbs** useful for those by whom it is cultivated, **receives blessing from God**; ^[8] but **if it bears thorns and briars, it is rejected and near to being cursed, whose end is to be burned**.

Jer 22:29 (KJV) O **earth, earth, earth, hear the word of the LORD**.

Rev 9:2-4 (KJV) And he opened the bottomless pit; and there **arose a smoke out of the pit**, as the smoke of a great furnace; and **the sun and the air were darkened by reason of the smoke of the pit**. ^[3] And there came **out of the smoke locusts upon the earth**: and unto them was given power, **as the scorpions of the earth have power**. ^[4] And it was commanded them that **they should not hurt the grass of the earth, neither any green thing, neither any tree; but only those men which have not the seal of God in their foreheads**.

Prov 16:4 (KJV) The LORD hath made all *things* for himself: yea, **even the wicked for the day of evil**.

Isa 9:14-15 (KJV) Therefore the LORD will cut off **from Israel head and tail**, branch and rush, in one day. ^[15] The ancient and honourable, he *is* the head; and **the prophet that teacheth lies, he is the tail**.

Prov 4:19 (KJV) **The way of the wicked is as darkness:** they know not at what they stumble.

Isa 59:15 (NKJV) **So truth fails, And he who departs from evil makes himself a prey.** Then the LORD saw *it*, and it displeased Him That *there was* no justice.

Gal 4:29 (KJV) But as then he that was **born after the flesh persecuted him that was born after the Spirit, even so it is now.**

2Tim 3:12-13 (NKJV) Yes, and all who **desire to live godly in Christ** Jesus **will suffer persecution.** ^[13] But evil men and impostors will grow worse and worse, deceiving and being deceived.

Exo 10:5 (NKJV) And **they shall cover the face of the earth**, so that **no one will be able to see the earth**; and they shall eat the residue of what is left, **which remains to you from the hail**, and **they shall eat every tree which grows up for you out of the field.**

Luke 18:8 (NKJV) **I tell you that He will avenge them speedily. Nevertheless, when the Son of Man comes, will He really find faith on the earth?"**

Rev 8:7 (NKJV) The first angel sounded: And **hail and fire followed, mingled with blood**, and they were **thrown to the earth**. And **a third of the trees were burned up, and all green grass was burned up.**

Isa 28:2-3,17-18, 23 (NKJV) Behold, the Lord has a mighty and strong one, **Like a tempest of hail and a destroying storm, Like a flood of mighty waters overflowing.** Who will bring *them* down to the earth with *His* hand. ^[3] **The crown of pride, the drunkards of Ephraim, Will be trampled underfoot;...** ^[17] Also I will make **justice** the measuring line, And **righteousness** the plummet; **The hail will sweep away the refuge of lies**, And **the waters will overflow the hiding place.** ^[18] **Your covenant with death will be annulled**, And your agreement with Sheol will not stand; When the overflowing scourge passes through, Then **you will be trampled down by it...** ^[23] Give ear and **hear my voice, Listen and hear my speech.**

Isa 1:27-31 (NKJV) Zion shall be redeemed with **justice**, And her penitents with **righteousness.** ^[28] The destruction of **transgressors and of sinners shall be** together, And **those who forsake the LORD shall be consumed.** ^[29] For they shall be ashamed of **the terebinth trees Which you have desired**; And **you shall be embarrassed because of the gardens Which you have chosen.** ^[30] For **you shall be as a terebinth whose leaf fades**, And **as a garden that has no water.** ^[31] The strong shall be as tinder, And the work of it as a spark; **Both will burn together.** And no one shall quench *them*.

Hos 10: 13 "You have plowed wickedness; You have reaped iniquity. **You have eaten the fruit of lies, Because you trusted in your own way,** In the multitude of your mighty men.

Isa 53:6 (NKJV) **All we** like sheep have gone astray; **We have turned, every one, to his own way;** And the LORD has **laid on Him the iniquity of us all.**

Isa 66:16 (NKJV) For **by fire and by His sword The LORD will judge all flesh**; And the slain of the LORD **shall be many.**

1Peter 4:17 (NKJV) For the time *has come* **for judgment to begin at the house of God**; and if *it begins* **with us first**, what will *be* the end of those who do not obey the gospel of God?

James 5:7-8 (NKJV) Therefore be patient, brethren, until the coming of the Lord. See *how* **the farmer waits for the precious fruit of the earth**, waiting patiently for it **until it receives the early and latter rain.** ^[8] You also be patient. **Establish your hearts, for the coming of the Lord is at hand.**
