The Garden Part 3 The Bitter Waters

Job 14:7-9 (NKJV) ""For there is hope for a tree, If it is cut down, that it will sprout again, And that its tender shoots will not cease. [8] Though its root may grow old in the earth, And its stump may die in the ground, [9] Yet at the scent of water it will bud And bring forth branches like a plant."

John 11:25-26 (NKJV) Jesus said to her, "<u>I am</u> the resurrection and the life. He who believes in Me, though he may die, he shall live. [26] And whoever lives and believes in Me shall never die. <u>Do you believe this?</u>"

Lev 26:4 (NKJV) then <u>I will give you rain in its season</u>, the <u>land shall yield its produce</u>, and the trees of the field shall yield their fruit.

Isa 45:8 (NKJV) "Rain down, you heavens, from above, And let the skies pour down righteousness; Let the earth open, let them bring forth salvation [Yesha], And let righteousness spring up together. I, the LORD, have created it.

Isaiah 55:10-11 (NKJV) [10] "For as the rain comes down, and the snow from heaven, And do not return there, But water the earth, And make it bring forth and bud, That it may give seed to the sower And bread to the eater, [11] So shall My word be that goes forth from My mouth; It shall not return to Me void, But it shall accomplish what I please, And it shall prosper in the thing for which I sent it.

Deu 32:1-2 (_{KJV}) <u>Give ear</u>, O ye <u>heavens</u>, and I will speak; and hear, O <u>earth</u>, <u>the words of my mouth</u>. ^[2] <u>My doctrine shall drop as the rain</u>, <u>my speech shall distil</u> [cleanse, disinfect, sanitize, clean, filter] <u>as the dew</u>, as the small rain upon the <u>tender herb</u>, and as the <u>showers upon the grass</u>:

Psa 46:4-5 (NKJV) *There is* a <u>river</u> whose streams **shall** <u>make glad</u> the city of God, The holy *place* of the tabernacle of the Most High. [5] God *is* in the midst of her, she shall not be moved; God shall help her, just at the break of dawn.

Psa 36:7-11 (NKJV) "How precious is Your lovingkindness, O God! Therefore the children of men <u>put their trust</u> under the shadow of Your wings. [8] They are abundantly satisfied with the fullness of Your house, And <u>You give them drink from the river of Your pleasures</u> ['eden:H5730]. [9] For with You is the fountain of life; In Your light we see light. [10] Oh, continue <u>Your lovingkindness to those who know You</u>, And <u>Your righteousness to the upright in heart</u>. [11] Let not the foot of pride come against me, And let not the hand of the wicked drive me away."

Psa 16:11 (NKJV) You will show me the path of life; In Your presence is fullness of joy; At Your right hand are pleasures forevermore.

Rev 8:10-11 (_{KJV}) And the **third angel sounded**, and there **fell a great star from heaven**, **burning as it were a lamp**, [lampas G2985] and it fell upon the third part of the rivers, and upon the fountains of waters; [11] And the name of the star is called Wormwood: and the third part of the waters became wormwood; and many men died of the waters, because they were made **bitter** [G4087 pikrainu].

Rev 12:9,12 (NKJV) So the great dragon was cast out, that serpent of old, called the Devil and Satan, who deceives the whole world; he was cast to the earth, and his angels were cast out with him... [12] Therefore rejoice, O heavens, and you who dwell in them! Woe to the inhabitants of the earth and the sea! For the devil has come down to you, having great wrath, because he knows that he has a short time."

Rom 7:23 ($_{KJV}$) But I see another law <u>in my members</u>, warring against the law of my mind, and bringing me into captivity to <u>the law of sin which is in my members</u>.

Col 3:5-7 (NKJV) Therefore **put to death your members which are on the earth**: fornication, uncleanness, passion, evil desire, and covetousness, which is idolatry. ^[6] Because of these things the wrath of God is coming upon the sons of disobedience, ^[7] in which you yourselves once walked when you lived in them.

Psa 119:105 (KIV) **Thy word is a lamp unto my feet**, and a light unto my path.

1John 4:1 (NKJV) Beloved, **do not believe every spirit**, **but test the spirits**, whether they are of God; because many **false prophets** have gone out into the world.

Deu 29:18-20 (_{KJV}) Lest there should <u>be among you</u> man, or woman, or family, or tribe, <u>whose heart turneth away</u> this day from the LORD our God, to go *and* serve the gods of these nations; lest there should be <u>among you</u> <u>a root that</u> <u>beareth gall and wormwood</u>; ^[19] And it come to pass, when he heareth the words of this curse, that he bless himself in his heart, saying, I shall have peace, **though I walk in the imagination of mine heart**, to add drunkenness to thirst:

Prov 14:12 (NKJV) There is a way that seems right to a man, But its end is the way of death.

Prov 3:13, 18 (_{KJV}) Happy *is* the man *that* findeth <u>wisdom</u>, and the man *that* getteth <u>understanding</u>...^[18] She *is* a tree of life to them that lay hold upon her: and happy *is every one* that retaineth her.

Psalm 119:103 (KJV) How sweet are thy words unto my taste! yea, sweeter than honey to my mouth!

Prov 5:1-6 (NKJV) My son, pay attention to my wisdom; Lend your ear to my understanding, [2] That you may preserve discretion, And your lips may keep knowledge. [3] For the lips of an immoral woman drip honey, And her mouth is smoother than oil; [4] But in the end she is bitter as wormwood, Sharp as a two-edged sword. [5] Her feet go down to death, Her steps lay hold of hell. [6] Lest you ponder her path of life-- Her ways are unstable; You do not know them.

Deu 18:20-22 (NKJV) But the prophet who presumes to speak a word in My name, which <u>I have not commanded</u> him to speak, or who speaks in the name of other gods, **that prophet shall die**. And if you say in your heart, <u>How shall we know the word which the LORD has not spoken</u>?'-- [22] when a prophet speaks in the name of the LORD, if the thing does not happen or come to pass, that *is* the thing which the LORD has not spoken; **the prophet has spoken it presumptuously**; <u>you shall not be afraid of him</u>.

Prov 5:7-23 (NKIV) Therefore hear me now, my children, And do not depart from the words of my mouth. [8] Remove your way far from her, And do not go near the door of her house, others, And your years to the cruel one; [10] Lest aliens be filled with your wealth, And your labors go to the house of a foreigner; [11] And you mourn at last, When your flesh and your body are consumed, [12] And say: "How I have hated instruction, And my heart despised correction! [13] I have not obeyed the voice of my teachers, Nor inclined my ear to those who instructed me! [14] I was on the verge of total ruin, In the midst of the assembly and congregation." [15] Drink water from your own cistern, And running water from your own well. [16] Should your fountains be dispersed abroad, Streams of water in the streets? [17] Let them be only your own, And not for strangers with you. [18] Let your fountain be blessed, And rejoice with the wife of your youth. [19] As a loving deer and a graceful doe, Let her breasts satisfy you at all times; And always be enraptured with her love. [20] For why should you, my son, be enraptured by an immoral woman, And be embraced in the arms of a seductress? [21] For the ways of man are before the eyes of the LORD, And He ponders all his paths. [22] His own iniquities entrap the wicked man, And he is caught in the cords of his sin. [23] He shall die for lack of instruction [discipline], And in the greatness of his folly he shall go astray.

Jer 9:13-16 (NKJV) And the LORD said, "Because they have forsaken My law which I set before them, and have not obeyed My voice, nor walked according to it, [14] but they have walked according to the dictates of their own hearts and after the Baals, which their fathers taught them," [15] therefore thus says the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel: "Behold, I will feed them, this people, with wormwood, and give them water of gall to drink. I will scatter them also among the Gentiles, whom neither they nor their fathers have known. And I will send a sword after them until I have consumed them."

Jer 23:11, 17-17 (NKJV) "For both prophet and priest are profane; Yes, in My house I have found their wickedness," says the LORD ... [15] "Therefore thus says the LORD of hosts concerning the prophets: 'Behold, I will feed them with wormwood, And make them drink the water of gall; For from the prophets of Jerusalem Profaneness has gone out into all the land." [16] Thus says the LORD of hosts: "Do not listen to the words of the prophets who prophesy to you. They make you worthless; They speak a vision of their own heart, Not from the mouth of the LORD. [17] They continually say to those who despise Me, "The LORD has said, "You shall have peace"; And to everyone who walks according to the dictates of his own heart, they say, 'No evil shall come upon you.'"

Exo 15:25-26 (NKJV) So he cried out to the LORD, and the LORD showed him a tree. When he cast it into the waters, the waters were made sweet. There He made a statute and an ordinance for them. And there He tested them, [26] and said, "If you diligently heed the voice of the LORD your God and do what is right in His sight, give ear to His commandments and keep all His statutes, I will put none of the diseases on you which I have brought on the Egyptians. For I am the LORD who heals you."

Amos 6:12 (NKJV) Do horses run on rocks? Does *one* plow *there* with oxen? Yet **you have turned justice** into **gall**, And **the <u>fruit of righteousness</u> into <u>wormwood</u>,**

Lam 3:15-21 (_{KJV}) <u>He hath filled me with bitterness, he hath made me drunken with wormwood</u>. ^[16] He hath also broken my teeth with gravel stones, he hath covered me with ashes. ^[17] And thou hast **removed my soul far off from peace**: I forgat prosperity. ^[18] And I said, <u>My strength and my hope is perished from the LORD</u>: ^[19] Remembering mine affliction and my misery, the wormwood and the gall. ^[20] My soul hath them still in remembrance, and is humbled in me. ^[21] This I recall to my mind, therefore have I hope.

Luke 22:31-32 (NKJV) And the Lord said, "Simon, Simon! Indeed, Satan has asked for you, that he may sift you as wheat. But I have prayed for you, that your faith should not fail; and when you have returned to Me, strengthen your brethren."

Mat 4:1 (KJV) Then was Jesus led up of the Spirit into the wilderness to be tempted of the devil.

2Thess 2:9-12 (NKJV) The coming of the *lawless one* is according to the working of Satan, with all power, <u>signs</u>, and <u>lying wonders</u>, ^[10] and with all <u>unrighteous deception</u> among those who perish, <u>because they did not receive the love of the truth</u>, that they might be saved. ^[11] And **for this reason** <u>God will send them strong delusion</u>, that <u>they should believe the lie</u>, ^[12] that they all may be condemned who <u>did not believe the truth</u> but had pleasure in unrighteousness.

Rom 3:10 (NKIV) As it is written: "There is none righteous, no, not one;

Rom 3:19,23 (_{NKJV}) Now we know that **whatever the law says**, it says to those who are under the law, that every mouth may be stopped, and **all the world may become guilty before God**...^[23] **For all have sinned**, and come short of the glory of God;

Luke 13:32 (NKJV) And He said to them, "Go, tell that fox, 'Behold, I cast out demons and perform cures **today and tomorrow**, and the **third** *day* **I shall be perfected**.'

Exo 23:30 (NKJV) Little by little I will drive them out from before you, until you have increased, and you inherit the land.

Deu 7:22 (NKJV) And the LORD your God will drive out those nations before you little by little; you will be unable to destroy them at once, lest the beasts of the field become too numerous for you.

Heb 3:13 (NKJV) but <u>exhort one another daily</u>, while it is called <u>"Today,"</u> lest any of you [us] be hardened through <u>the deceitfulness of sin</u>.

Eze 31:4-5 (_{KJV}) The waters made him great, the <u>deep</u> [tehom] set him up on high with <u>her rivers</u> running round about his plants, and <u>sent out her little rivers unto all the trees of the field</u>. ^[5] Therefore his height was exalted above all the trees of the field, and his boughs were multiplied, and his branches became long because of the multitude of waters, when he shot forth.

Ezek 31:14-18 (NKJV) "'So that no trees by the waters may ever again exalt themselves for their height, nor set their tops among the thick boughs, that no tree which drinks water may ever be high enough to reach up to them. 'For they have all been delivered to death, To the depths of the earth, Among the children of men who go down to the Pit.' [15] "Thus says the Lord GOD: 'In the day when it went down to hell, I caused mourning. I covered the deep because of it. I restrained its rivers, and the great waters were held back. I caused Lebanon to mourn for it, and all the trees of the field wilted because of it. [16] 'I made the nations shake at the sound of its fall, when I cast it down to hell together with those who descend into the Pit; and all the trees of Eden, the choice and best of Lebanon, all that drink water, were comforted in the depths of the earth [Prov 14:32]. [17] 'They also went down to hell with it, with those slain by the sword; and those who were its strong arm dwelt in its shadows among the nations. [18] 'To which of the trees in Eden will you then be likened in glory and greatness? Yet you shall be brought down with the trees of Eden to the depths of the earth; you shall lie in the midst of the uncircumcised, with those slain by the sword. This is Pharaoh and all his multitude,' says the Lord GOD.""

Psa 1:1-4 (NKJV) "Blessed is the man Who walks not in the counsel of the ungodly, Nor stands in the path of sinners, Nor sits in the seat of the scornful; [2] But his delight is in the law of the LORD, And in His law he meditates day and night. [3] He shall be like a tree Planted by the rivers of water, That brings forth its fruit in its season, Whose leaf also shall not wither; And whatever he does shall prosper. [4] The ungodly are not so, But are like the chaff which the wind drives away."

1Cor 15:33 (NKJV) Do not be deceived: "Evil company corrupts good habits."

Gen 2:10-15 (KJV) "And <u>a river</u> went out of <u>Eden</u> to water the garden; <u>and from thence</u> <u>it was parted</u>, <u>and became into four heads</u> [ro'sh:H7218].
