

The Righteousness of Faith! Part 2-b

Heb 3 (NKJV) "Therefore, holy brethren, partakers of the heavenly calling, consider the Apostle and High Priest of our confession, Christ Jesus, [2] **who was faithful to Him** who appointed Him, **as Moses also was faithful in all His house.** [3] For this One has been counted worthy of more glory than Moses, inasmuch as He who built the house has more honor than the house. [4] For every house is built by someone, but He who built all things *is* God. [5] **And Moses indeed was faithful in all His house as a servant, for a testimony of those things which would be spoken afterward,** [6] but **Christ as a Son over His own house,** whose house we are **if we hold fast the confidence and the rejoicing of the hope firm to the end.** [7] **Therefore, as the Holy Spirit says: "Today, if you will hear His voice,** [8] Do not harden your hearts as in the rebellion, In the day of trial in the wilderness, [9] Where your fathers tested Me, tried Me, And saw My works forty years. [10] Therefore I was angry with that generation, And said, **'They always go astray in their heart, And they have not known My ways.'** [11] So **I swore in My wrath,** **'They shall not enter My rest.'** (Psalm 95:7-11) [12] Beware, brethren, lest there be in any of you an **evil heart of unbelief in departing from the living God;** [13] but exhort one another **daily, while it is called "Today,"** lest any of you be hardened through the deceitfulness of sin. [14] **For we have become partakers of Christ if we hold the beginning of our confidence steadfast to the end,** [15] while it is said: **"Today, if you will hear His voice, Do not harden your hearts as in the rebellion."** [16] For who, **having heard, rebelled?** Indeed, *was it not all who came out of Egypt, led by Moses?* [17] Now with whom was He angry forty years? **Was it not with those who sinned,** whose corpses fell in the wilderness? [18] And **to whom did He swear** that they would not enter His rest, **but to those who did not obey?** [19] So we see that **they could not enter in because of unbelief."**

Heb 11 (NKJV) "... [3] **By faith we** understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that the things which are seen were not made of things which are visible." [4] **By faith Abel** offered to God a more excellent sacrifice than Cain,... [5] **By faith Enoch** was taken away so that he did not see death,... [6] But **without faith it is impossible to please Him,** for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and **that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.** [7] **By faith Noah,** being divinely warned of things not yet seen, moved with godly fear,... and became heir of the righteousness which is according to faith. [8] **By faith Abraham obeyed** when he was called... And he went out, not knowing where he was going. [9] **By faith he dwelt in the land of promise as in a foreign country,** dwelling in tents with Isaac and Jacob, the **heirs with him of the same promise;** [10] for he waited for the city which has foundations, whose builder and maker *is* God. [11] **By faith Sarah** herself also received strength to conceive seed, and she bore a child when she was past the age, [13] **These all died in faith, not having received the promises,** but having seen them afar off were assured of them, ... [17] **By faith Abraham,** when he was tested, offered up Isaac,... [20] **By faith Isaac** blessed Jacob and Esau concerning things to come. [21] **By faith Jacob,** when he was dying, blessed each of the sons of Joseph, and worshiped, *leaning on the top of his staff.* [22] **By faith Joseph, when he was dying, made mention of the departure of the children of Israel, and gave instructions concerning his bones.**

Gen 26:5 ""because Abraham **obeyed My voice** and kept My charge, My commandments, My statutes, and My laws.""

John 8:39 (NKJV) "They answered and said to Him, "Abraham is our father." Jesus said to them, **"If you were Abraham's children, you would do the works of Abraham."**

Heb 11:23 (NKJV) **"By faith Moses,** when he was born, **was hidden** three months by his parents, **because they saw he was a beautiful child;** and **they were not afraid of the king's command."**

Exo 2:1-2 (NKJV) "And a man of the house of Levi went and took *as wife* a daughter of Levi. [2] So the woman conceived and bore a son. And when **she saw that he was a beautiful child,** **she hid him three months."**

Exo 1:17-21 (NKJV) "But **the midwives feared God**, and did not do as the king of Egypt commanded them, but saved the male children alive.. [20]... [21] And so it was, **because the midwives feared God**, that **He provided households for them**."

Gen 50:25 (NKJV) "Then **Joseph took an oath from the children of Israel**, saying, "**God will surely visit you, and you shall carry up my bones from here.**"

Gen 15:13-14 (NIV) "Then the LORD said to him, "**Know for certain** that your descendants will be strangers in a country not their own, and they **will be enslaved** and mistreated **four hundred years**. [14] But I will punish the nation they serve as slaves, and **afterward they will come out with great possessions.**"

Heb 11:22 (NKJV) "**By faith Joseph**, when he was dying, made mention of the departure of the children of Israel, and **gave instructions concerning his bones.**"

Exo 2:2 (KJV) "And the woman conceived, and bare a son: and when **she saw him that he was a goodly child**, she hid him three months."

Acts 7:20 (NASB) ""And it was at this time that Moses was born; and he was lovely in the sight of God ; and he was nurtured three months in his father's home."	Acts 7:20 (NKJV) "" At this time Moses was born , and was well pleasing to God ; and he was brought up in his father's house for three months."

Acts 7:17 (NKJV) ""But when **the time of the promise drew near** which **God had sworn to Abraham**, the people grew and multiplied in Egypt"

Acts 13:23 (NKJV) "From this man's seed, **according to the promise**, God raised up **for Israel a Savior; Jesus;**"

John 1:4 (NIV) "In him was life, and **that life was the light of men.**"

Prov 16:15 (NKJV) "**In the light of the king's face is life**, And his favor *is* like a cloud of the latter rain."

Heb 11:24-26 (NKJV) "**By faith Moses**, when he became of age, **refused to be called the son of Pharaoh's daughter**, [25] **choosing rather to suffer affliction with the people of God than to enjoy the passing pleasures of sin**, [26] **esteeming the reproach of Christ greater riches than the treasures in Egypt**; for he looked to the reward."

Exo 2:11-12 (NKJV) "Now it came to pass in those days, when Moses was grown , that he went out to his brethren and looked at their burdens . And he saw an Egyptian beating a Hebrew, one of his brethren. [12] So he looked this way and that way , and when he saw no one, he killed the Egyptian and hid him in the sand."	Acts 7:23-24 (NKJV) ""Now when he was forty years old, it came into his heart to visit his brethren, the children of Israel . [24] "And seeing one of them suffer wrong , he defended and avenged him who was oppressed , and struck down the Egyptian."

Num 12:3 (NKJV) "(Now the man Moses *was* very **humble**, more than all men who *were* on the face of the earth.)"

Exo 3:11 (NKJV) "But Moses said to God, "**Who am I that I should go to Pharaoh**, and that I should bring the children of Israel out of Egypt?"

Exo 4:10 (NKJV) "Then Moses said to the LORD, "**O my Lord, I am not eloquent, neither before nor since You have spoken to Your servant**; but **I am slow of speech and slow of tongue.**"

Acts 7:22 (NKJV) ""And Moses was learned in all the wisdom of the Egyptians , and was mighty in words and deeds. "	Acts 7:22 (NASB) ""And Moses was educated in all the learning of the Egyptians , and he was a man of power in words and deeds. "

1 Cor 1:27 (NKJV) "But **God has chosen the foolish things of the world** to put to shame the wise, and God has chosen the weak things of the world to put to shame the things which are mighty;"

Phil 2:6-8 (NKJV) "who, being in the form of God, did not consider it robbery to be equal with God, [7] but **made Himself of no reputation, taking the form of a bondservant**, and coming in the likeness of men. [8] And being found in appearance as a man, **He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death**, even the death of the cross."

Heb 5:7-9 (NKJV) "who, in the days of His flesh, when **He had offered up prayers and supplications**, with vehement cries and tears **to Him who was able to save Him from death, and was heard because of His godly fear**, [8] **though He was a Son, yet He learned obedience by the things which He suffered**. [9] And having been perfected, **He became the author of eternal salvation to all who obey Him**."

Heb 13:12-14 (NASB) "Therefore Jesus also, that He might sanctify the people through His own blood, suffered outside the gate. [13] **Hence, let us go out to Him outside the camp, bearing His reproach**. [14] **For here we do not have a lasting city, but we are seeking the city which is to come**."

Col 1:23-24 (NKJV) "**if indeed you continue in the faith**, grounded and steadfast, and are **not moved away from the hope of the gospel** which you heard, **which was preached to every creature under heaven**, of which I, Paul, became a minister. [24] **I now rejoice in my sufferings for you, and fill up in my flesh what is lacking in the afflictions of Christ**, for the sake of His body, which is the church,"

Heb 11:27-29 (NKJV) "**By faith he forsook Egypt, not fearing the wrath of the king; for he endured as seeing Him who is invisible**. [28] **By faith he kept the Passover and the sprinkling of blood**, lest he who destroyed the firstborn should touch them. [29] **By faith they passed through the Red Sea** as by dry *land*, whereas the Egyptians, attempting to do so, were drowned."

Exo 2:13-15 (NKJV) "And when he went out the second day, behold, two Hebrew men were fighting, and he said to the one who did the wrong, "**Why are you striking your companion?**" [14] Then he said, "**Who made you a prince and a judge over us?** Do you intend to kill me as you killed the Egyptian?" **So Moses feared and said, "Surely this thing is known!"** [15] When Pharaoh heard of this matter, he sought to kill Moses. **But Moses fled from the face of Pharaoh** and dwelt in the land of Midian; and he sat down by a well."

Acts 7:25-29 (NKJV) ""For **he supposed that his brethren would have understood that God would deliver them by his hand, but they did not understand**. [26] "And the next day he appeared to two of them as they were fighting, and **tried to reconcile** them, saying, '**Men, you are brethren; why do you wrong one another?**' [27] "But he who did his neighbor wrong pushed him away, saying, '**Who made you a ruler and a judge over us?**' [28] 'Do you want to kill me as you did the Egyptian yesterday?' [29] "**Then, at this saying, Moses fled and** became a dweller in the land of Midian, where he had two sons."

Acts 7:35-39 (NKJV) ""This Moses whom they rejected, saying, '**Who made you a ruler and a judge?**' is the one **God sent to be a ruler and a deliverer by the hand of the Angel who appeared to him in the bush**. [36] "... [37] "This is that Moses who said to the children of Israel, 'The LORD your God **will raise up for you a Prophet like me from your brethren. Him you shall hear**.' [38] "This is he who was in the church in the wilderness with the Angel who spoke to him on Mount Sinai, and *with* our fathers, **the one who received the living oracles to give to us**, [39] "**whom our fathers would not obey**, but rejected. **And in their hearts they turned back to Egypt**,"

2 Cor 13:5 (NASB) "**Test yourselves to see if you are in the faith**; examine yourselves! Or do you not recognize this about yourselves, that Jesus Christ is in you-- **unless indeed you fail the test?**"
