Lesson 11 - Genesis 2

A "living soul" - The first Adam - part 3

1 Pet 1:23 (NKJV) "having <u>been born again</u>, not of corruptible seed but <u>incorruptible</u>, through the word of God which lives and abides forever,"

1 Cor 15:45-50 (NASB) "So also it is written, "The first MAN, Adam, <u>BECAME A LIVING SOUL</u> [psuche:G5590]." The last Adam became a life-giving spirit. [46] However, the spiritual is not first, but the natural; then the spiritual. [47] The first man is from the earth, earthy; the second man is from heaven. [48] As is the earthy, so also are those who are earthy; and as is the heavenly, so also are those who are heavenly. [49] And just as we have borne the image of the earthy, we shall also bear the image of the heavenly. [50] Now I say this, brethren, that flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God; nor does the perishable inherit the imperishable."

Jer 22:29 (NKJV) "O earth, earth, Hear the word of the LORD!"

Rom 8:29-30 (NKJV) "For whom He <u>foreknew</u>, **He also <u>predestined</u>** <u>to be conformed to the image of His Son</u>, that <u>He might be the firstborn among many brethren</u>. [30] Moreover whom He predestined, these He also called; whom He called, these He also justified; and whom He justified, <u>these He also glorified</u>."

John 12:23 (NKJV) "But Jesus answered them, saying, "The hour has come that the Son of Man should be glorified."

2 Tim 2:11 (NKJV) "This is a faithful saying: For if we died with Him, We shall also live with Him."

John 12:27-28 (NKJV) ""Now My soul [psuche:G5590] is troubled, and what shall I say? 'Father, save Me from this hour'? But for this purpose I came to this hour. [28] "Father, glorify Your name." Then a voice came from heaven, saying, "I have both glorified it and will glorify it again.""

Rom 5:19 (NKJV) "For as by one man's disobedience many were made sinners, so also **by one Man's obedience** many will be made righteous."

Eph 2:10 (NKJV) "For we are His workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand that we should walk in them."

John 12:24-25 (NKJV) ""Most assuredly, I say to you, unless a **grain of wheat [I am the wheat]** falls into the ground **and dies**, it remains alone; but **if it dies, it produces much grain**. [25] "He who loves his life will lose it, and he who **hates his life in this world** will keep it **for eternal life**."

James 1:21 (NKJV) "Therefore lay aside all filthiness and overflow of wickedness, and receive with meekness the implanted word, which is able to save your souls."

Rev 1:5 (NKJV) "and from Jesus Christ, the faithful witness, the firstborn from the dead, and the ruler over the kings of the earth. To Him who loved us and washed us from our sins in His own blood,"

Rev 1:18 (NKJV) ""I *am* He who lives, and was dead, and behold, I am alive forevermore. Amen. And I have the keys of Hades and of Death."

Rom 8:34 (NKJV) "Who *is* he who condemns? *It is* Christ who died, and furthermore is also risen, who is even at the right hand of God, who also makes intercession for us."

Phil 2:8 (KJV) "And **being found in fashion as a man**, he **<u>humbled himself</u>**, and became **<u>obedient unto</u> death**, even the death of the cross."

2 Cor 5:14-17 (NKJV) "For the love of Christ compels us, because we judge thus: that if One died for all, then all died; [15] and He died for all, that those who live should live no longer for themselves, but for Him who died for them and rose again. [16] Therefore, from now on, we regard no one according to the flesh. Even though we have known Christ according to the flesh, yet now we know Him thus no longer. [17] Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new."

Rom 8:6-7 (YLT) "for the mind of the flesh is death, and the mind of the Spirit -- life and peace; [7] because the mind of the flesh is enmity to God, for to the law of God it doth not subject itself,"

Rom 8:6-7 (KJV) "For to be **carnally minded** *is* **death**; but to be spiritually minded *is* life and peace. [7] Because the **carnal mind** *is* **enmity against God**: **for it is not subject to the law of God**, neither indeed can be."

Rom 7:22-23 (NKJV) "For **I delight in the law of God according to the inward man**. [23] But **I see another law in my members**, warring against the law of my mind, and bringing me into captivity **to the law of sin which is in my members**."

Rom 8:8-14 (NKJV) "So then, those who are in the flesh cannot please God. [9] But you are not in the flesh but in the Spirit, if indeed the Spirit of God dwells in you. Now if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, he is not His. [10] And if Christ is in you, the body is dead because of sin, but the Spirit is life because of righteousness. [11] But if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, He who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies through His Spirit who dwells in you. [12] Therefore, brethren, we are debtors; not to the flesh, to live according to the flesh. [13] For if you live according to the flesh you will die; but if by the Spirit you put to death the deeds of the body, you will live. [14] For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, these are sons of God."

Luke 20:35-36 (NKJV) ""But those who are **counted worthy** to attain that age, **and the resurrection from the dead**, neither marry nor are given in marriage; [36] "**nor can they die anymore**, for they are equal to the angels **and are sons of God, being sons of the resurrection**."

Rom 7:7 (NKJV) "What shall we say then? Is the law sin? Certainly not! On the contrary, I would not have known sin except through the law. For I would not have known covetousness unless the law had said, "You shall not covet.""

Rom 7:12 (NKJV) "Therefore the law is holy, and the commandment holy and just and good."

Rom 7:13 (NKJV) "Has then what is good become death to me? Certainly not! But sin, that it might appear sin, was producing death in me through what is good, so that sin through the commandment might become exceedingly sinful."

Rom 6:7-10 (NKJV) "For he who has **died** has been **freed from sin**. [8] Now **if we died with Christ**, we believe that we shall also live with Him, [9] knowing that Christ, **having been raised from the dead, dies no more**. **Death no longer has dominion over Him**. [10] For the death that He **died**, **He died to sin once for all**; but the life that He lives, **He lives to God.**"

1 Cor 15:26 (NKJV) "The last enemy that will be destroyed is death."

Exo 4:1-3 (NKJV) "Then Moses answered and said, "But suppose they will not believe me or listen to my voice; suppose they say, 'The LORD has not appeared to you." [2] So the LORD said to him, "What *is* that in your hand?" **He said, "A rod.**" [3] And He said, "Cast it on the ground." **So he cast it on the ground, and it became a serpent**; and Moses fled from it."

Exo 4:6-7 (NKJV) "Furthermore the LORD said to him, "Now put your hand in your bosom." And he put his hand in his bosom, and when he took it out, **behold, his hand** *was* **leprous, like snow**. [7] And He said, "Put your hand in your bosom again." So he put his hand in his bosom again, and drew it out of his bosom, and **behold, it was restored like his** *other* **flesh**."

Exo 4:5 (NKJV) ""that **they may believe that the LORD God of their fathers**, the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac, and the God of Jacob, has appeared to you.""

Exo 4:28-31 (NKJV) "So Moses told Aaron all the words of the LORD who had sent him, and all the signs which He had commanded him. [29] Then Moses and Aaron went and gathered together all the elders of the children of Israel. [30] And Aaron spoke all the words which the LORD had spoken to Moses. Then he did the signs in the sight of the people. [31] So the people believed; and when they heard that the LORD had visited the children of Israel and that He had looked on their affliction, then they bowed their heads and worshiped."

Exo 7:10-12 (KJV) "And Moses and Aaron went in unto Pharaoh, and they did so as the LORD had commanded: and **Aaron cast down his rod before Pharaoh**, and before his servants, **and it became a serpent**. [11] Then Pharaoh also called the wise men and the sorcerers: now the magicians of Egypt, **they also did in like manner with their enchantments**. [12] For they cast down **every man his rod**, and **they became serpents**: **but Aaron's rod swallowed up their rods**."

We know that the rod in ancient Egypt was a symbol of royal authority and power and the snake represented the cobra-goddess of Lower Egypt.

Wadjet, Goddess of Lower Egypt, Papyrus, and Protector of Pharaoh...

"Often shown as a rearing cobra, she was a protector of the pharaoh, ready to strike and kill his enemies. She was also depicted as a woman-headed cobra, a winged cobra, a lion-headed woman, or a woman wearing the red crown of Lower Egypt." [highlight mine]

In his book "The Two Babylons, pg 227" Hislop writes,

"In Egypt...the serpent was held to have been the great enlightener of the spiritual, by giving mankind the "knowledge of good and evil".

Num 21:5-9 (NKJV) "And the people spoke against God and against Moses: "Why have you brought us up out of Egypt to die in the wilderness? For there is no food and no water, and our soul [nephesh:H5315] loathes this worthless bread." [6] So the LORD sent fiery serpents [nachash:H5175] among the people, and they bit the people; and many of the people of Israel died. [7] Therefore the people came to Moses, and said, "We have sinned, for we have spoken against the LORD and against you; pray to the LORD that He take away the serpents [nachash:H5175] from us." So Moses prayed for the people. [8] Then the LORD said to Moses, "Make a fiery serpent [saraph:H8314], and set it on a pole; and it shall be that everyone who is bitten, when he looks at it, shall live." [9] So Moses made a bronze serpent, and put it on a pole; and so it was, if a serpent had bitten anyone, when he looked at the bronze serpent, he lived."

Deu 8:15-16 (NKJV) ""who led you through that great and terrible wilderness, in which were fiery serpents and scorpions and thirsty land where there was no water; who brought water for you out of the flinty rock; [16] "who fed you in the wilderness with manna, which your fathers did not know, that He might humble you and that He might test you, to do you good in the end;"

John 12:31-34 (KJV) "Now is the judgment of this world: now shall the prince of this world be cast out. [32] And I, if I be lifted up from the earth, will draw all men unto me. [33] This he said, signifying what death he should die. [34] The people answered him, We have heard out of the law that Christ abideth for ever: and how sayest thou, The Son of man must be lifted up? who is this Son of man?"

1 Cor 2:7-8 (NKJV) "But we speak the wisdom of God in a mystery, the hidden *wisdom* which God ordained before the ages for our glory, [8] which none of the rulers of this age knew; for had they known, they would not have crucified the Lord of glory."

John 3:10, 12 (NKJV) "Jesus answered and said to him, "Are you the teacher of Israel, and do not know these things?[12] "If I have told you earthly things and you do not believe, how will you believe if I tell you heavenly things?

John 3:14-18 (NKJV) ""And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, even so must the Son of Man be lifted up, [15] "that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have eternal life. [16] "For God so loved the world that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him should not perish but have everlasting life. [17] "For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but that the world through Him might be saved. [18] "He who believes in Him is not condemned; but he who does not believe is condemned already, because he has not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God."

Heb 2:14-15 (KJV) "Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood, he also himself likewise took part of the same; that through death he might destroy him that had the power of death, that is, the devil; [15] And deliver them who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage."

1 Cor 15: 51-58 (NKJV) "Behold, I tell you a mystery: We shall <u>not all sleep</u>, but we shall all be changed; [52] in a moment, in the twinkling of an eye, at the last trumpet. For the trumpet will sound, and the <u>dead will be raised incorruptible</u>, and we shall be changed. [53] For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal must put on immortality. [54] So when this corruptible has put on incorruption, and this mortal has put on immortality, then shall be brought to pass the saying that is written: "Death is swallowed up in victory." [55] "O Death, where is your sting? O Hades, where is your victory?" [56] The sting of death is sin, and the strength of sin is the law. [57] But thanks be to God, who gives us the victory through our Lord Jesus Christ. [58] Therefore, my beloved brethren, be steadfast, immovable, always <u>abounding in the work of the Lord</u>, knowing that your labor is not in vain in the Lord.

Heb 10:39 (NKJV) "But we are not <u>of those</u> who draw back to perdition, but <u>of those who believe to the saving of the soul</u>."

Rev 3:21-22 (NKJV) ""To him who overcomes I will grant to sit with Me on My throne, as I also overcame and sat down with My Father on His throne. [22] "He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches." ""

Rev 1:18 (NKJV) ""I *am* He who lives, and was dead, and behold, I am alive forevermore. Amen. And I have the keys of Hades and of Death."
