

## Lesson 13 Gen 2

### Pleasant to the sight and good for food - part 1

Gen 2:8-9 (NKJV) "The LORD God planted a garden eastward in Eden, and there He put the man whom He had formed. [9] **And out of the ground the LORD God made every tree grow that is pleasant to the sight and good for food.** The tree of life **was also** in the midst of the garden, and the tree of the knowledge of good and evil."

Exo 19:6 (NKJV) "'And **you shall be to Me a kingdom of priests and a holy nation.**' These *are* the words which you shall speak to the children of Israel.'"

1 Cor 15:49 (NKJV) "**And as we** have borne the **image** of the *man* of dust, **we shall also bear the image of the heavenly Man.**"

2 Cor 3:18 (NKJV) "But **we all**, with unveiled face, beholding as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, **are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory**, just as by the Spirit of the Lord."

Heb 10:19 (KJV) "Having therefore, brethren, **boldness to enter into the holiest** by the blood of Jesus,"

Num 3:38 (NKJV) "Moreover those who were to camp **before the tabernacle on the east**, before the tabernacle of meeting, *were* Moses, Aaron, and his sons, keeping charge of **the sanctuary**, to meet the needs of the children of Israel; but **the outsider who came near was to be put to death.**"

Gen 30:6 (NKJV) "Then Rachel said, "**God has judged my case**; and He has also heard my voice and given me a son." Therefore she called his name **Dan.**"

Gen 49:16-17 (NKJV) ""**Dan shall judge his people** As one of the tribes of Israel. [17] **Dan shall be a serpent by the way**, A viper by the path, That bites the horse's heels So that its rider shall fall backward."

Gen 2:9 (NKJV) "And **out of the ground** the LORD God made **every tree** grow that is **pleasant to the sight and good for food.** The tree of life *was also* in the midst of the garden, and the tree of the knowledge of good and evil."

Eccl 3:10-15 (NIV) "I have seen the burden/task God has laid on men. [11] **He has made everything beautiful in its time.** He has also **set eternity in the hearts of men**; yet **they cannot fathom what God has done from beginning to end.** [12] I know that there is nothing better for men than to be happy and do good while they live. [13] That everyone may eat and drink, and find satisfaction in all his toil--this is the gift of God. [14] I know that **everything God does will endure forever**; nothing can be added to it and nothing taken from it. **God does it so that men will revere him.** [15] **Whatever is has already been, and what will be has been before; and God will call the past to account.**"

Eccl 7:29 (NKJV) "Truly, this only I have found: That **God made man upright**, But **they have sought out many schemes.**"

Jer 11:19 (NKJV) "But I *was* like a docile lamb brought to the slaughter; and I did not know that **they had devised schemes against me**, *saying*, "**Let us destroy the tree with its fruit**, and let us **cut him off from the land of the living**, that **his name may be remembered no more.**"

Mat 3:10 (NKJV) ""And **even now** the ax is laid to the root of the trees. Therefore **every tree which does not bear good fruit** is cut down and thrown into the fire."

Gal 5:22-23 (NKJV) "But **the fruit of the Spirit** is **love**, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, **faithfulness**, [23] gentleness, self-control. **Against such there is no law.**"

Eph 5:9 (NKJV) "(for **the fruit of the Spirit is in all goodness, righteousness, and truth**),"

Prov 11:30 (NKJV) "**The fruit of the righteous is a tree of life**, And he who wins souls *is* wise."

Mat 7:20 (NKJV) ""Therefore **by their fruits you will know them.**"

Mat 12:33 (NKJV) ""Either make the tree good and its **fruit** good, or else make the tree bad and its **fruit** bad; **for a tree is known by its fruit.**"

Luke 6:43-46 (NKJV) ""For a **good tree** does not bear bad fruit, nor does a **bad tree** bear good fruit. [44] "**For every tree is known by its own fruit.** For *men* do not gather figs from thorns, nor do they gather grapes from a bramble bush. [45] "**A good man** out of the **good treasure of his heart** brings forth good; and **an evil man** out of the **evil treasure of his heart** brings forth evil. **For out of the abundance of the heart his mouth speaks.** [46] "But why do you call Me 'Lord, Lord,' and do not do the things which I say?"

Luke 8:11 (NKJV) ""Now the parable is this: **The seed is the word of God.**"

Psa 143:10 (NKJV) "**Teach me** to do Your will, For You *are* my God; **Your Spirit is good. Lead me in the land of uprightness.**"

1 Sam 16:7 (NKJV) "But the LORD said to Samuel, "**Do not look** at his appearance or at the height of his stature, because I have refused him. **For the Lord does not see as man sees**; for man looks at the outward appearance, but **the LORD looks at the heart.**"

Prov 27:19 (NKJV) "**As in water** face *reflects* face, So **a man's heart reveals the man.**"

Mat 11:29 (NASB) ""Take My yoke upon you, and learn from Me, for **I am gentle and humble in heart**; and **YOU SHALL FIND REST FOR YOUR SOULS.**"

Prov 16:18 (NKJV) "**Pride goes before destruction**, And a haughty spirit before a fall."

Isa 53:2-3 (NKJV) "**For He** shall grow up before Him as a **tender plant**, And as **a root out of dry ground. He has no form or comeliness; And when we see Him, There is no beauty that we should desire Him.** [3] He is despised and rejected by men, A Man of sorrows and acquainted with grief. **And we hid, as it were, our faces from Him**; He was despised, and **we did not esteem Him.**"

Oba 1:3 (NKJV) "**The pride of your heart has deceived you**, *You* who dwell in the clefts of the rock, Whose habitation is high; *You* who say in your heart, 'Who will bring me down to the ground?'"

Gen 1:29-31 (NKJV) "And God said, "**See, I have** given you **every herb** that yields **seed** which *is* on the face of all the earth, and **every tree whose fruit yields seed**; **to you it shall be for food.** [30] "Also, to every beast of the earth, to every bird of the air, and to everything that creeps on the earth, in which *there is* life, **I have given every green herb for food**"; and it was so. [31] Then **God saw everything that He had made, and indeed it was very good.** So the evening and the morning were the sixth day."

Gen 2:9 (NKJV) "And **out of the ground** the LORD God made **every tree** grow that is **pleasant to the sight and good for food**. The **tree of life** was **also** in the midst of the garden, and the **tree of the knowledge of good and evil**."

In reviewing the things Yahweh provided to Adam and Eve in the Garden of Eden that were good for food, we find:

- Every herb/plant bearing seed
- Every tree whose fruit yields seed
- Every tree that is pleasant to the sight and good for food
- Also, the tree of life.

James 1:17 (NKJV) "**Every good gift and every perfect gift** is from above, and comes down from the **Father of lights, with whom there is no variation or shadow of turning**."

1 John 1:5 (NKJV) "This is the message which we have heard from Him and declare to you, that **God is light and in Him is no darkness at all**."

Ezek 18:32 (NKJV) ""For **I have no pleasure in the death of one who dies**," says the Lord GOD. "**Therefore turn and live!**""

2 Pet 3:9 (NKJV) "The Lord is not slack concerning *His* promise, as some count slackness, but is longsuffering toward us, **not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance**."

Mark 12:29 (NIV) ""**The most important one**," answered Jesus, "**is this: 'Hear, O Israel, the Lord our God, the Lord is one**.'"

Mal 3:6 (NKJV) ""For I *am* the LORD, I **do not change**; Therefore you are not consumed, O sons of Jacob."

Psa 12:6 (KJV) "The words of the LORD **are pure words**: as silver tried in a furnace of earth, **purified seven times**."

Prov 30:5 (KJV) "**Every word of God is pure**: he *is* a shield unto them that put their trust in him."

Psa 5:4-5 (NKJV) "For You *are* not a God who takes pleasure in wickedness, Nor shall evil dwell with You. [5] The boastful shall not stand in Your sight; You hate all workers of iniquity."

Hab 1:13 (NIV) "**Your eyes are too pure to look on evil; you cannot tolerate wrong**. Why then do you tolerate the treacherous? Why are you silent while the wicked swallow up those more righteous than themselves?"

James 3:11-13 (NKJV) "**Does a spring send forth fresh water and bitter from the same opening?** [12] **Can a fig tree, my brethren, bear olives, or a grapevine bear figs?** Thus no spring yields both salt water and fresh. [13] **Who is wise and understanding among you?** Let him show by good conduct **that his works are done in the meekness of wisdom**."

James 3:17-18 (NKJV) "But **the wisdom that is from above is first pure**, then peaceable, gentle, willing to yield, full of mercy and good fruits, without partiality and without hypocrisy. [18] Now **the fruit of righteousness** is sown in peace by those who make peace."

Prov 3:13-18 (NKJV) "**Happy is the man who finds wisdom**, And the man *who* gains understanding; [14] For her proceeds *are* better than the profits of silver, And her gain than fine gold. [15] She *is* more precious than rubies, And all the things you may desire cannot compare with her. [16] Length of days *is* in her right hand, In her left hand riches and honor. [17] Her ways *are* ways of pleasantness, And all her paths *are* peace. [18] **She is a tree of life to those who take hold of her, And happy are all who retain her.**"

2 Tim 2:13 (NKJV) "If we are faithless, He **remains faithful; He cannot deny Himself.**"

Lev 19:19 (NKJV) "'**You shall** keep My statutes. You shall not let your livestock breed with another kind. **You shall not sow your field with mixed seed.** Nor shall a garment of mixed linen and wool come upon you."

Deu 22:9 (NKJV) "'**You shall not sow your vineyard with different kinds of seed, lest the yield of the seed which you have sown and the fruit of your vineyard be defiled.**"

Mat 7:18 (NKJV) "'**A good tree cannot bear bad fruit, nor can a bad tree bear good fruit.**"

Mat 13:24-26 (NKJV) "**Another parable** He put forth to them, saying: "The kingdom of heaven is **like a man who sowed good seed in his field**; [25] "but while men [Adam] slept, **his enemy came and sowed tares among the wheat and went his way.** [26] "But when the grain had sprouted and produced a crop, then the tares also appeared."

Mat 13:36-40 (NKJV) "**Then Jesus** sent the multitude away and went into the house. And His disciples came to Him, saying, "Explain to us the parable of the tares of the field." [37] He answered and said to them: "**He who sows the good seed is the Son of Man.** [38] "The field is the world, the **good seeds are the sons of the kingdom**, but **the tares are the sons of the wicked one.** [39] "**The enemy who sowed them is the devil**, the harvest is the end of the age, and the reapers are the angels. [40] "Therefore as the tares are gathered and burned in the fire, so it will be at the end of this age."

Mat 15:13 (NKJV) "But He answered and said, "**Every plant which My heavenly Father has not planted will be uprooted.**"

Rev 22:2 (NKJV) "In the middle of its street, and on either side of the river, **was the tree of life**, which bore twelve fruits, **each tree yielding its fruit every month.** The leaves of the **tree were** for the healing of the nations."

Rev 22:14 (NKJV) "Blessed *are* those who do His commandments, **that they may have the right to the tree of life**, and may enter through the gates into the city."

Rev 2:7 (NKJV) "'**He who has an ear**, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches. To him who overcomes **I will give to eat from the tree of life, which is in the midst of the Paradise of God.**"

Ezek 28:17 (NIV) "**Your heart became proud on account of your beauty**, and **you corrupted your wisdom because of your splendor.** So I threw you to the earth; I made a spectacle of you before kings."
