

The Four Rivers Part 2 continuation

Eph 2:2-3 (NKJV) "in which **you** once walked according to the course of this world, **according to the prince of the power of the air**, the **spirit who now works in the sons of disobedience**, [3] among whom also **we all once conducted ourselves** in the **lusts of our flesh**, fulfilling the desires of the **flesh** and of the mind, **and were by nature children of wrath, just as the others.**"

Mark 9:49 (NKJV) "**For everyone will be seasoned with fire, and every sacrifice will be seasoned with salt.**"

Psa 12:6 (NKJV) "The words of the LORD are **pure words, Like silver tried in a furnace of earth, Purified seven times.**"

Titus 2:11-14 (NKJV) "For **the grace of God that brings salvation** has appeared to all men, [12] **teaching [paideuo:G3811]** us that, **denying ungodliness and worldly lusts**, we should **live soberly, righteously, and godly in the present age**, [13] looking for the **blessed hope** and glorious appearing of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ, [14] who gave Himself for us, that He might **redeem us from every lawless deed** and **purify for Himself His own special people, zealous for good works.**"

Eph 5:26 (KJV) "That he might **sanctify** and **cleanse/purify** it with the washing of **water** by the **word**. [rhema:G4487]"

3811. paideuo, pahee-dyoo'-o; from G3816; **to train up a child**, i.e. educate, or (by impl.) **discipline** (by punishment):--**chasten** (-ise), instruct, learn, teach.

Prov 13:24 (NKJV) "He who spares his **rod** hates his son, But **he who loves him disciplines him promptly.**"

Heb 12:6-8 (NKJV) "For whom the LORD loves He **chastens**, [paideuo:G3811] And **scourges every son whom He receives.**" [7] **If you endure chastening**, God deals with you as with sons; for what **son** is there whom a father does not **chasten [paideuo:G3811]**? [8] But **if you are without chastening**, of which all have become partakers, **then you are illegitimate and not sons.**"

Rev 3:19 (KJV) "**As many as I love, I rebuke and chasten [paideuo:G3811]: be zealous therefore, and repent.**"

Prov 25:4 (KJV) "**Take away the dross from the silver, and there shall come forth a vessel for the finer.**"

1 Pet 4:1 (NKJV) "Therefore, since **Christ suffered for us in the flesh**, arm yourselves also with the same **mind**, for **he who has suffered in the flesh has ceased from sin.**"

1 Cor 3:9-17 (NKJV) "For we are God's fellow workers; **you are God's field, you are God's building.** [10] According to the grace of God which was given to me, as a wise master builder I have laid the foundation, and another builds on it. But **let each one take heed how he builds on it.** [11] **For no other foundation can anyone lay than that which is laid, which is Jesus Christ.** [12] Now if anyone builds on this foundation with **gold, silver, precious stones, wood, hay, straw**, [13] each one's work will become clear; for the Day will declare it, **because it will be revealed by fire**; and **the fire will test each one's work**, of what sort it is. [14] If anyone's **work which he has built on it endures, he will receive a reward.** [15] If anyone's **work is burned**, he will suffer loss; but **he himself will be saved, yet so as through fire.** [16] Do you not know that **you are the temple of God** and that the Spirit of God dwells in you? [17] **If anyone defiles the temple of God, God will destroy him. For the temple of God is holy, which temple you are.**"

Heb 12:29 (NKJV) "**For our God is a consuming fire.**"

Mat 22:2-3 (NKJV) ""**The kingdom of heaven** is like a certain king who arranged a marriage for his son, [3] "and sent out his servants to call those who **were invited to the wedding**; and they **were not willing to come.**""

Mat 22:8-9 (NKJV) ""Then he said to his servants, 'The wedding is ready, but those who were invited were not worthy. [9] 'Therefore go into the highways, and **as many as you find, invite to the wedding.**""

Mat 22:11-14 (NKJV) ""But when the king came in to see the guests, **he saw a man there who did not have on a wedding garment.** [12] "So he said to him, 'Friend, how did you come in here without a wedding garment?' **And he was speechless.** [13] "Then the king said to the servants, '**Bind him hand and foot, take him away, and cast him into outer darkness; there will be weeping and gnashing of teeth.**' [14] "**For many are called, but few are chosen.**""

Hosea 2:19-20 (KJV) "And I will betroth thee unto me for ever; yea, I will betroth thee unto me in righteousness, and in judgment, and in lovingkindness, and in mercies. [20] I will even betroth thee unto me in faithfulness: **and thou shalt know the LORD.**"

Eph 5:8-10 (NKJV) "For **you were** once **darkness**, but now **you are light in the Lord.** **Walk** as children of light [9] (for the fruit of the Spirit *is in all goodness, righteousness, and truth*), [10] **finding out what is acceptable to the Lord.**"

Phil 2:13 (NKJV) "for **it is God who works in you** both **to will and to do** for *His* good pleasure."

Hag 2:7-9 (NKJV) ""and I will shake all nations, and they shall come to the Desire of All Nations, and I will fill this temple with glory,' says the LORD of hosts. [8] '**The silver is Mine, and the gold is Mine,**' says the **LORD of hosts.** [9] '**The glory of this latter temple shall be greater than the former,**' says the LORD of hosts. 'And **in this place I will give peace,**' [shalowm:H7965] says the LORD of hosts.""

John 12:32 (NKJV) ""**And I, if I am lifted up from the earth, will draw all peoples to Myself.**""

Num 31:22-23 (NKJV) ""Only the **gold**, the **silver**, the **bronze**, the **iron**, the **tin**, and the **lead**, [23] everything that can **endure fire**, you **shall put through the fire, and it shall be clean**; and **it shall be purified with the water of purification.** But all that cannot endure fire you shall put through water."

Rev 15:2-3 (NKJV) "And I saw *something* like **a sea of glass mingled with fire**, and **those who have the victory over the beast, over his image and over his mark and over the number of his name, standing on the sea of glass, having harps of God.** [3] **They sing the song of Moses**, the servant of God, and **the song of the Lamb**, saying: "**Great and marvelous are Your works, Lord God Almighty! Just and true are Your ways,** O King of the saints!"

Exo 30:17-21 (NKJV) "Then the LORD spoke to Moses, saying: [18] "You shall also **make a laver of bronze, with its base also of bronze, for washing.** You shall **put it between the tabernacle of meeting and the altar.** **And you shall put water in it,** [19] "**for Aaron and his sons** shall wash their hands and their feet in water from it. [20] "When they go into the tabernacle of meeting, or when they come near the altar to minister, to burn an offering made by fire to the LORD, **they shall wash with water, lest they die.** [21] "So they shall wash their hands and their feet, lest they die. And it shall be a statute forever to them; **to him and his descendants throughout their generations.**""

Exo 40:7 (NKJV) "And you shall set the laver between the tabernacle of meeting and the altar, and **put water in it.**"

1 Ki 7:23-25 (NKJV) "And **he made the Sea** of cast **bronze**, **ten** cubits from one brim to the other; *it was completely round.* Its height *was* **five** cubits, and a line of thirty cubits measured its circumference. [24] Below

its brim *were* ornamental buds encircling it all around, **ten** to a cubit, all the way around the **Sea**. The ornamental buds *were* cast in two rows when it was cast. [25] It stood on twelve oxen: three looking toward the north, three looking toward the west, three looking toward the south, and three looking toward the east; the **Sea** *was set* upon them, and all their back parts *pointed* inward."

2 Chr 4:6 (NKJV) "He also made ten lavers, and put five on the right side and five on the left, to wash in them; such things as they offered for the burnt offering they would wash in them, **but the Sea was for the priests to wash in.**"

Mat 3:11 (NKJV) ""I indeed **baptize you with water** unto repentance, but He who is coming after me is mightier than I, whose sandals I am not worthy to carry. **He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire.**"

John 3:3-7 (NKJV) "Jesus answered and said to him, "**Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born again, he cannot see the kingdom of God.**" [4] Nicodemus said to Him, "How can a man be born when he is old? Can he enter a second time into his mother's womb and be born?" [5] Jesus answered, "**Most assuredly, I say to you, unless one is born of water and the Spirit, he cannot enter the kingdom of God.** [6] "That which is born of the flesh is flesh, and that which is **born of the Spirit is spirit.** [7] "Do not marvel that I said to you, 'You must be **born again.**'"

Rev 12:11 (NKJV) ""And **they overcame him (mark of the beast.) by the blood of the Lamb and by the word of their testimony**, and **they did not love their lives to the death.**"

Isa 33:14-17 (NKJV) "The sinners in Zion are afraid; Fearfulness has seized the **hypocrites: "Who among us shall dwell with the devouring fire? Who among us shall dwell with everlasting burnings?"** [15] **He who walks righteously and speaks uprightly**, He who despises the gain of oppressions, Who gestures with his hands, refusing bribes, Who stops his ears from hearing of bloodshed, And shuts his eyes from seeing evil: [16] **He will dwell on high**; His place of defense *will be* **the fortress of rocks**; Bread will be given him, **His water will be sure.** [17] Your eyes will see the King in His beauty; **They will see the land that is very far off.**"

Ezek 16:11-13 (NKJV) ""**I adorned you with ornaments**, put bracelets on your wrists, and a chain on your neck. [12] "And I put a jewel in your nose, earrings in your ears, and a beautiful crown on your head. [13] "**Thus you were adorned with gold and silver**, and your clothing *was of* fine linen, silk, and embroidered cloth. You ate *pastry of* **fine flour**, honey, and oil. You were exceedingly beautiful, **and succeeded to royalty.**"

Ezek 16:15-17 (NKJV) ""But **you trusted in your own beauty**, played the harlot because of your fame, and poured out your harlotry on everyone passing by who *would have* it. [16] "You took some of your garments and adorned multicolored high places for yourself, and played the harlot on them. *Such* things should not happen, nor be. [17] "**You have also taken your beautiful jewelry from My gold and My silver**, which I had given you, and made for yourself male images and played the harlot with them."

Rev 3:18 (NKJV) ""**I counsel you to buy from Me gold refined in the fire**, that you may be rich; and **white garments**, that you may be clothed, **that the shame of your nakedness may not be revealed**; and **anoint your eyes with eye salve**, that you may see."

Mat 6:19-21 (NKJV) ""**Do not lay up for yourselves treasures on earth**, where **moth** and **rust** destroy and where **thieves** break in and steal; [20] "but **lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven**, where neither **moth** nor rust destroys and where thieves do not break in and steal. [21] "**For where your treasure is, there your heart will be also.**"

Job 23:10 (NKJV) "But He knows **the way** that I take; **When He has tested me, I shall come forth as gold.**"

Zec 13:9 (NKJV) "**I will bring the one-third through the fire, Will refine them as silver is refined, And test them as gold is tested. They will call on My name, And I will answer them.** I will say, 'This is My people'; And each one will say, 'The LORD is my God.'"

Dan 12:10 (NKJV) ""Many shall be **purified**, made white, and **refined**, **but the wicked shall do wickedly**; and **none of the wicked shall understand, but the wise shall understand.**"

Prov 8:10-21 (NKJV) "**Receive my instruction, [paideia] and not silver**, And knowledge rather than **choice gold**; [11] **For wisdom is better than rubies**, And all the things one may desire cannot be compared with her....[13] **The fear of the LORD is to hate evil; Pride and arrogance and the evil way And the perverse mouth I hate.** [14] Counsel is mine, and sound wisdom; I am understanding, I have strength....[17] "I love those who love me, And those who seek me diligently will find me. [18] **Riches and honor are with me, Enduring riches and righteousness.** [19] **My fruit is better than gold, yes, than fine gold, And my revenue than choice silver.** [20] I traverse the way of **righteousness**, In the midst of the paths of **justice**. [21] That I may cause those who love me to inherit wealth, That I may fill their treasuries."
