

## The Natural vs. The Spiritual The Law of Opposites Part 3

Prov 30:4-5 (NKJV) "**Who has ascended into heaven, or descended?** Who has gathered the wind in His fists? Who has bound the waters in a garment? Who has established all the ends of the earth? **What is His name,** and **what is His Son's name, if you know?** [5] **Every word of God is pure;** He is a shield to those who put their trust in Him."

John 1:1-5 (NKJV) "**In the beginning was the Word,** and **the Word was with God,** and **the Word was God.** [2] He was in **the beginning** with God. [3] All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made. [4] In Him was life, and **the life was the light of men.** [5] And the **light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not comprehend it.**"

Rev 1:8 (NKJV) ""I am **the Alpha** and the Omega, **the Beginning and the End,**" says the Lord, "who is and who was and who is to come, the Almighty.""

Isa 46:10 (NKJV) "**Declaring the end from the beginning,** And from ancient times *things* that are not yet done, Saying, 'My counsel shall stand, And I will do all My pleasure,'"

Psa 90:10-12 (NIV) "**The length of our days is seventy years-- or eighty,** if we have the strength; yet their **span is but trouble and sorrow,** for they quickly pass, and we fly away. [11] Who knows the power of your anger? For your wrath is as great as the fear that is due you. [12] **Teach us to number our days aright, that we may gain a heart of wisdom.**"

Isa 45:7 (KJV) "I form the **light,** and create **darkness;** I make **peace,** and create **evil:** I the LORD do all these things."

Deu 30:15 (NKJV) ""See, **I have set** before you today **life** and **good,** **death** and **evil,**"

Mat 7:13-16 (NKJV) ""Enter by the **narrow gate;** for **wide is the gate** and **broad is the way** that leads to destruction, and **there are many who go in by it.** [14] "Because **narrow is the gate** and **difficult/narrow is the way which leads to life,** and there are few who find it. [15] "**Beware of false prophets,** who come to you in sheep's clothing, but inwardly they are ravenous wolves. [16] "**You will know them by their fruits.** Do men gather grapes from thornbushes or figs from thistles?"

Sir 33:14-15 (KJVA) **Good** is set against **evil,** and **life** against **death;** so is the **godly** against the **sinner,** and the **sinner** against the **godly.** [15] So **look upon all the works of the most High;** and there are **two and two, one against another.**

Eph 5:8 (NKJV) "For **you were once darkness,** but now **you are light in the Lord.** Walk as children of light"

2 Cor 5:17 (NKJV) "Therefore, if anyone *is* in Christ, [**the beginning and the end**] *he is* a **new creation;** old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new."

John 1:4 (NKJV) "In Him was life, and the **life was the light** of men."

John 8:12 (NKJV) "Then Jesus spoke to them again, saying, "**I am the light of the world. He who follows Me shall not walk in darkness, but have the light of life.**""

Eph 2:1 (NASB) "And you **were dead** in your trespasses and sins,"

1 Cor 15:22 (NKJV) "For as **in Adam all die,** even so **in Christ all shall be made alive.**"

1 Cor 15:47-48,50 (NKJV) "**The first man was of the earth, made of dust**; the second Man *is* the Lord from heaven. [48] **As was the man of dust, so also are those who are made of dust**; and as *is* the heavenly Man, so also are those who are heavenly... [50] Now this I say, brethren, **that flesh and blood cannot inherit the kingdom of God**; nor does corruption inherit incorruption... [53] **For this corruptible must put on incorruption, and this mortal must put on immortality.**"

Luke 22:44 (NKJV) "And **being in agony**, He prayed more earnestly. Then **His sweat became like great drops of blood** falling down to the ground."

Isa 53:2-3 (NKJV) "For He shall grow up before Him as a tender plant, And as a root out of dry ground. He has no form or comeliness; And when we see Him, *There is* no beauty that we should desire Him. [3] He is **despised and rejected by men**, **A Man of sorrows and acquainted with grief**. And we hid, as it were, *our* faces from Him; **He was despised**, and we did not esteem Him."

John 18:1 (NIV) "When he had finished praying, Jesus left with his disciples and crossed the Kidron Valley. On the other side there was **an olive grove**, and he and his disciples went into it."

Mat 26:36-38 (NKJV) "Then Jesus came with them to a place called **Gethsemane**, and said to the disciples, **"Sit here while I go and pray over there."** [37] And He took with Him Peter and the two sons of Zebedee, and **He began to be sorrowful and deeply distressed**. [38] Then He said to them, **"My soul is exceedingly sorrowful, even to death. Stay here and watch with Me."**

Gethsemane, g'eth-say-man-ay'; of Chald. or. [comp. **H1660** and **H8081**]; **oil-press**; Gethsemane, a garden near Jerus.:--Gethsemane.

**1660. gath**, gath; prob. from H5059 (in the sense of treading out grapes); **a wine-press** (or vat for holding the grapes in pressing them):--(wine-) press (fat).

**8081. shemen**, sheh'-men; from H8080; grease, espec. liquid (as **from the olive, often perfumed**); fig. richness:--**anointing**, X fat (things), X **fruitful**, oil ([-ed]), **ointment, olive**, + pine.

Mat 26:39 (NKJV) "He went a little farther and fell on His face, and prayed, saying, **"O My Father, if it is possible, let this cup pass from Me; nevertheless, not as I will, but as You will."**

Lev 24:2 (NKJV) ""Command the children of Israel that they bring to you **pure oil of pressed olives for the light**, to **make the lamps burn continually.**"

Luke 9:24 (NKJV) ""**For whoever desires to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for My sake will save it.**"

Acts 14:22 (NKJV) "strengthening the souls of the disciples, exhorting *them* to **continue in the faith**, and *saying*, **"We must through many tribulations enter the kingdom of God."**

1 Pet 4:1-2 (NKJV) "Therefore, **since Christ suffered for us in the flesh, arm yourselves also with the same mind**, for **he who has suffered in the flesh has ceased from sin**, [2] that he **no longer should live the rest of his time in the flesh for the lusts of men, but for the will of God.**"

Isa 57:1-2 (NKJV) "**The righteous perishes**, And no man takes *it* to heart; **Merciful men are taken away**, While no one considers **That the righteous is taken away from evil**. [2] **He shall enter into peace**; They shall rest in their beds, *Each one walking in* his uprightness."

Heb 4:9-10 (NKJV) "**There remains therefore a rest for the people of God.** [10] For he who has entered His rest has himself also **ceased from his works** as God *did* from His."

Prov 29:2 (NKJV) "When **the righteous are in authority**, the people rejoice; But when a wicked *man* rules, the people groan."

Gen 1:26-28 (NKJV) "Then God said, "Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness; let them **have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over the cattle, over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth.**" [27] So God created man in His *own* image; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them. [28] Then God blessed them, and God said to them, "Be fruitful and multiply; **fill the earth and subdue it; have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over every living thing that moves on the earth.**"

Acts 10:11-12 (NKJV) "and saw heaven opened and an object like a great sheet bound at the four corners, descending to him and let down to the earth. [12] In it were all kinds of **four-footed animals of the earth, wild beasts, creeping things, and birds of the air.**"

Ezek 34:5-6 (NKJV) ""So they were scattered because *there was* **no shepherd**; and **they became food for all the beasts of the field** when they were scattered. [6] "**My sheep** wandered through all the mountains, and on every high hill; yes, **My flock** was scattered over the whole face of the earth, and no one was seeking or searching *for them.*""

Dan 7:17 (NKJV) "Those great **beasts**, which are four, *are* four kings *which* **arise out of the earth.**"

Micah 5:8 (NKJV) "And the remnant of Jacob Shall be among the Gentiles, In the midst of many peoples, **Like a lion among the beasts of the forest, Like a young lion among flocks of sheep**, Who, if he passes through, Both treads down and tears in pieces, And none can deliver."

Ecc 3:18 (KJV) "I said in mine heart concerning the estate of the sons of men, that God might manifest them, and **that they might see that they themselves are beasts.**"

2 Pet 2:12,15,17,19 (NKJV) "But these, like **natural brute beasts** made to be caught and destroyed, **speak evil** of the things they do not understand, and will utterly perish in their own corruption, [15] **They have forsaken the right way** and gone astray, following **the way of Balaam the son of Beor**, who **loved the wages of unrighteousness**; [17] These are **wells without water, clouds** carried by a tempest, for whom is reserved the **blackness of darkness** forever. [19] While they promise them liberty, they themselves **are slaves of corruption**; for by whom a person is overcome, by him also **he is brought into bondage.**"

Jude 1:10-13 (KJV) "But these **speak evil** of those things which they know not: **but what they know naturally, as brute beasts**, in those things they corrupt themselves. [11] Woe unto them! for they have gone in the way of Cain, and ran greedily after the error of **Balaam** for reward, and perished in the gainsaying of Core. [12] These are spots in your feasts of charity, when they feast with you, feeding themselves without fear: **clouds they are without water**, carried about of winds; **trees whose fruit withereth**, without fruit, twice dead, plucked up by the roots; [13] **Raging waves of the sea**, foaming out their own shame; **wandering stars**, to whom is reserved the blackness of darkness for ever."

Rev 13:1 (KJV) "And I stood upon the sand of the sea, and saw a **beast** rise up out of the sea, having seven heads and ten horns, and upon his horns ten crowns, and upon his heads **the name of blasphemy**... [5] And he was given a mouth **speaking great things and blasphemies**, and he was given authority to continue for forty-two months. [6] Then he **opened his mouth in blasphemy against God**, to blaspheme His name, His tabernacle, and those who dwell in heaven."

Rev 13:11 (NKJV) "Then **I saw another beast coming up out of the earth**, and he **had two horns like a lamb and spoke like a dragon**."

Gen 1:9-10 (NKJV) "Then God said, "Let the **waters under the heavens** be gathered together into one place, and **let the dry land appear**"; and it was so. [10] And God called **the dry land Earth**, and the **gathering together of the waters He called Seas**. And God saw that *it was good*."

Rev 17:15 (NKJV) "Then he said to me, "**The waters** which you saw, where the harlot sits, are peoples, multitudes, nations, and tongues."
