

Yeshua, the Apostles and the Torah Part 2

2 Pet 3:15-16 (NKJV) "and consider *that* the longsuffering of our Lord *is* salvation; as **also our beloved brother Paul**, according to the wisdom given to him, has written to you, [16] as also in all his epistles, **speaking in them of these things**, in which are some things **hard to understand, which untaught and unstable people twist to their own destruction, as they do also the rest of the Scriptures.**"

1 John 2:3-6 (NKJV) "Now by this we know that we know Him, if we **keep His commandments**. [4] **He who says, "I know Him," and does not keep His commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him.** [5] But whoever **keeps His word**, truly the love of God is perfected in him. **By this we know that we are in Him.** [6] **He who says he abides in Him ought himself also to walk just as He walked.**"

1 Cor 11:1 (NKJV) "Imitate me, just as **I also imitate Christ.**"

Mat 7:21-23 (NKJV) ""Not everyone who says to Me, '**Lord, Lord,**' shall enter the kingdom of heaven, **but he who does the will of My Father in heaven.** [22] "Many will say to Me in that day, 'Lord, Lord, have we not **prophesied** in Your name, **cast out demons** in Your name, and **done many wonders** in Your name?' [23] "And then I will declare to them, '**I never knew you; depart from Me, you who practice lawlessness!**'"

1 Cor 1:4-7 (NKJV) "I thank my God always concerning you for the grace of God which was given to you by Christ Jesus, [5] that **you were enriched in everything by Him in all utterance and all knowledge**, [6] even as the testimony of Christ was confirmed in you, [7] **so that you come short in no gift**, eagerly waiting for the revelation of our Lord Jesus Christ,"

1 Cor 1:4-7 (NIV) "I always thank God for you because of his grace given you in Christ Jesus. [5] For in him **you have been enriched in every way--in all your speaking and in all your knowledge--** [6] because our testimony about Christ was confirmed in you. [7] Therefore **you do not lack any spiritual gift** as you eagerly wait for our Lord Jesus Christ to be revealed."

1 Cor 12:1-11 (NKJV) "Now concerning spiritual *gifts*, brethren, I do not want you to be ignorant: [2] You know that **you were Gentiles**, carried away to these dumb idols, however you were led. [3] Therefore I make known to you that no one speaking by the Spirit of God calls Jesus accursed, **and no one can say that Jesus is Lord except by the Holy Spirit**. [4] There are diversities of gifts, but the same Spirit. [5] There are differences of ministries, but the same Lord. [6] And there are diversities of activities, but it is the same God who works all in all. [7] But **the manifestation of the Spirit is given to each one for the profit of all**: [8] for to one is given the **word of wisdom** through the Spirit, to another the **word of knowledge** through the same Spirit, [9] to another **faith** by the same Spirit, to another **gifts of healings** by the same Spirit, [10] to another the **working of miracles**, to another **prophecy**, to another **discerning of spirits**, to another *different* **kinds of tongues**, to another the **interpretation of tongues**. [11] But one and the same Spirit works all these things, distributing to each one individually as He wills."

Mat 7:21 (NKJV) ""**Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,'** shall enter the kingdom of heaven, **but he who does the will of My Father in heaven.**"

Mat 7:22 (NKJV) ""**Many** will **say to Me** in that day, '**Lord, Lord**, have we not prophesied in Your name, cast out demons in Your name, and done many wonders in Your name?'"

Mat 25:11-12 (NKJV) ""Afterward the other virgins came also, saying, '**Lord, Lord**, open to us!' [12] "But he answered and said, '**Assuredly, I say to you, I do not know you.**'"

Luke 13:25-27 (NKJV) ""When once the Master of the house has risen up and shut the door, and you begin to stand outside and knock at the door, saying, 'Lord, Lord, open for us,' and He will answer and say to you, 'I do not know you, where you are from,' [26] "then you will begin to say, 'We ate and drank in Your presence, and You taught in our streets.' [27] "But He will say, 'I tell you I do not know you, where you are from. Depart from Me, all you workers of iniquity.'"

Heb 10:15-16 (NKJV) "But **the Holy Spirit also witnesses to us**; for after He had said before, [16] "This is the covenant that I will make with them after those days, says the LORD: **I will put My laws into their hearts, and in their minds I will write them,**"

Luke 6:46-47 (NKJV) ""**But why do you call Me 'Lord, Lord,' and do not do the things which I say?** [47] "Whoever comes to Me, and **hears My sayings and does them**, I will show you whom he is like:"

1 Cor 3:1-3 (NKJV) "And I, brethren, **could not speak to you as to spiritual** people **but as to carnal**, as to babes in Christ. [2] **I fed you with milk** and **not with solid food**; for until now you were not able to receive it, **and even now you are still not able**; [3] **for you are still carnal**. For where *there are* envy, strife, and divisions among you, are you not carnal and behaving like *mere* men?"

Heb 5:13-14 (NKJV) "For everyone who partakes *only* of milk is **unskilled in the word of righteousness**, for he is a babe. [14] But **solid food** belongs to those who are of **full age**, *that is*, **those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.**"

Rom 8:5-8 (NKJV) "For those who live according to the flesh set their minds on the things of the flesh, but those *who live* according to the Spirit, the things of the Spirit. [6] **For to be carnally minded is death**, but to be spiritually minded *is* life and peace. [7] **Because the carnal mind is enmity against God; for it is not subject to the law of God, nor indeed can be.** [8] So then, those who are in the flesh cannot please God."

Gen 3:15 (NKJV) "And **I will put** enmity Between you and the woman, And **between your seed and her Seed**; He shall bruise your head, And you shall bruise His heel.""

John 5:42 (NKJV) ""**But I know you, that you do not have the love of God in you.**"

1 John 5:3 NASB "For this is the love of God, that **we keep His commandments**; and **His commandments are not burdensome.**"

John 7:19 (NKJV) ""Did not Moses give you the law, yet **none of you keeps the law?** Why do you seek to kill Me?""

John 14:15 (NKJV) ""If you **love** Me, **keep My commandments.**" (What would be the Remez/ or Hint level of interpretation for this verse?

John 14:21 (NKJV) ""He who **has My commandments and keeps them**, it is he who **loves Me**. And he who **loves Me** will be **loved by My Father**, and **I will love him and manifest Myself to him.**"" (Emphasis is in keeping them not just having them - or knowing about them)

John 15:10 (NKJV) ""If you keep My commandments, you will abide in **My love**, just as **I have kept My Father's commandments and abide in His love.**"

1 John 3:24 (NKJV) "Now **he who keeps His commandments abides in Him**, and **He in him**. And by this we know that He abides in us, by the Spirit whom He has given us."

1 Cor 13:4-10 (NKJV) "**Love suffers long and is kind; love does not envy; love does not parade itself, is not puffed up; [5] does not behave rudely, does not seek its own, is not provoked, thinks no evil; [6] does not rejoice in iniquity, but rejoices in the truth; [thy word is truth John 17:17] [7] bears all things, believes all things, hopes all things, endures all things. [8] Love never fails. But whether there are prophecies, they will fail; whether there are tongues, they will cease; whether there is knowledge, it will vanish away. [9] For we know in part and we prophesy in part. [10] But when that which is perfect has come, then that which is in part will be done away.**"

2 John 1:6 (NKJV) "**This is love, that we walk according to His commandments. This is the commandment, that as you have heard from the beginning, you should walk in it.**"

Deu 10:12-19 (NKJV) "'And now, Israel, **what does the LORD your God require of you, but to fear the LORD your God, to walk in all His ways and to love Him, to serve the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul, [13] and to keep the commandments of the LORD and His statutes which I command you today for your good? [14] Indeed heaven and the highest heavens belong to the LORD your God, also the earth with all that is in it. [15] The LORD delighted only in your fathers, to love them; and He chose their descendants after them, you above all peoples, as it is this day. [16] Therefore circumcise the foreskin of your heart, and be stiff-necked no longer. [17] For the LORD your God is God of gods and Lord of lords, the great God, mighty and awesome, who shows no partiality nor takes a bribe. [18] He administers justice for the fatherless and the widow, and loves the stranger, giving him food and clothing. [19] Therefore love the stranger, for you were strangers in the land of Egypt.**"

1 Cor 12:8-11 (NIV) "To one there is given through the Spirit the message of wisdom, to another the message of knowledge by means of the same Spirit, [9] to another faith by the same Spirit, to another gifts of healing by that one Spirit, [10] to another **miraculous powers**, to another **prophecy**, to another distinguishing between spirits, to another speaking in different kinds of tongues, and to still another the interpretation of tongues. [11] **All these are the work of one and the same Spirit, and he gives them to each one, just as he determines.**"

1 Cor 12:31 (NKJV) "But earnestly desire the best gifts. And yet **I show you a more excellent way.**"

1 Cor 13:1-8 (NKJV) "Though I speak with the tongues of men and of angels, but have **not love, I have become sounding brass or a clanging cymbal. [2] And though I have the gift of prophecy, and understand all mysteries and all knowledge, and though I have all faith, so that I could remove mountains, but have not love, I am nothing. [3] And though I bestow all my goods to feed the poor, and though I give my body to be burned, but have not love, it profits me nothing.**

1 Cor 14:37 (NKJV) "If anyone thinks himself to be a prophet or spiritual, let him acknowledge that **the things which I write to you are the commandments of the Lord.**"

Rom 13:8 (NKJV) "Owe no one anything except to love one another, for **he who loves another has fulfilled the law.**"

Rom 13:10 (NKJV) "Love does no harm to a neighbor; therefore **love is the fulfillment of the law.**"

Gal 5:14 (NKJV) "**For all the law is fulfilled** in one word, *even* in this: "**You shall love your neighbor as yourself.**"

Lev 19:18 (NKJV) "'You shall not take vengeance, nor bear any grudge against the children of your people, but **you shall love your neighbor as yourself: I am the LORD.**"

1 John 4:20 (NKJV) "If someone says, "I love God," and hates his brother, he is a liar; for he who does not love his brother whom he has seen, **how can he love God whom he has not seen?"**

Mark 12:28-33 (NKJV) "Then one of the scribes came, and having heard them reasoning together, perceiving that He had answered them well, asked Him, "Which is the first commandment of all?" [29] Jesus answered him, "The **first of all the commandments** is: '**Hear, O Israel, the LORD our God, the LORD is one.**' [30] 'And you shall love the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, with all your mind, and with all your strength.' This is the first commandment. [31] "And the second, like it, is this: 'You shall love your neighbor as yourself.' There is no other commandment greater than these." [32] So **the scribe said to Him, "Well said, Teacher. You have spoken the truth,** for there is one God, and there is no other but He. [33] "And to love Him with all the heart, with all the understanding, with all the soul, and with all the strength, and to love one's neighbor as oneself, **is more than all the whole burnt offerings and sacrifices.**"

Mat 22:36-40 (NKJV) ""Teacher, **which is the great commandment in the law?**" [37] Jesus said to him, "You shall **love** the LORD your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind.' [38] "This is *the* first and great commandment. [39] "And **the second is like it:** 'You shall **love** your neighbor as yourself.' [40] "**On these two commandments hang all the Law and the Prophets.**"

Acts 5:32 "We are witnesses of these things, and so is **the Holy Spirit, whom God has given to those who obey him.**"

John 5:39-40 (NKJV) ""You search the Scriptures, for in them you think you have eternal life; and these are **they which testify of Me.** [40] "But you are not willing to come to Me that you may have life."

Mat 15:8-9 (NKJV) ""These people draw near to Me **with their mouth,** And honor Me **with their lips,** **But their heart is far from Me.** [9] And **in vain they worship Me, Teaching as doctrines the commandments of men.**"

Luke 24:25-27 "He said to them, "**How foolish you are, and how slow of heart to believe all that the prophets have spoken!** [26] Did not the Christ have to suffer these things and then enter his glory?" [27] **And beginning with Moses and all the Prophets, he explained to them what was said in all the Scriptures concerning himself.**"

Luke 24:44-45 "He said to them, "This is what **I told you while I was still with you: Everything must be fulfilled that is written about me in the Law of Moses, the Prophets and the Psalms.**" [45] Then **he opened their minds so they could understand the Scriptures.**"

Isa 42:18-21 (NKJV) ""**Hear, you deaf;** And look, you blind, that you may see. [19] Who is blind but My servant, Or deaf as My messenger *whom* I send? Who is blind as *he who is* perfect, And blind as the Lord's servant? [20] Seeing many things, but you do not observe; Opening the ears, but he does not hear." [21] The LORD is well pleased for His righteousness' sake; **He will exalt the law and make it honorable.**"
