## The Natural vs. the Spiritual

The Law of Opposites Part 5

John 6:53-56 (NKJV) "Then Jesus said to them, "Most assuredly, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His blood, you have no life in you. [54] "Whoever eats My flesh and drinks My blood has eternal life, and I will raise him up at the last day. [55] "For My flesh is food indeed, and My blood is drink indeed. [56] "He who eats My flesh and drinks My blood abides in Me, and I in him."

John 6:52 (NKJV) "The Jews therefore quarreled among themselves, saying, "How can this Man give us His flesh to eat?"

John 6:60 (NIV) "On hearing it, many of his disciples said, "This is a hard teaching. Who can accept it?""

John 6:66 (NKJV) "From that time many of His disciples went back and walked with Him no more."

Rev 2:7 (NKJV) ""He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches. To him who overcomes I will give to eat from the tree of life, which is in the midst of the Paradise of God.""

Isa 66:16 (NASB) "For the LORD will execute judgment by fire And by His sword on all flesh, And those slain by the LORD will be many."

Isa 33:14 (NKJV) "The sinners in Zion are afraid; Fearfulness has seized the hypocrites: "Who among us shall dwell with the devouring fire? Who among us shall dwell with everlasting burnings?"

Luke 11:27-28 (NKIV) "And it happened, as He spoke these things, that a <u>certain woman from the crowd</u> raised her voice and said to Him, "**Blessed** *is* **the womb that bore You, and** *the* **breasts which nursed You!**" [28] But He said, "More than that, blessed *are* those who hear the word of God [Genesis to Revelation] and keep it [every jot and tittle]!"

1 Peter 4:1 ( $_{NKJV}$ ) Therefore, since Christ suffered for us in the flesh, **arm yourselves also with the same mind**, for **he who** has suffered in the flesh has ceased from sin,

Col 1:24 (NKJV) "I now rejoice in my sufferings for you, and fill up in my flesh what is lacking in the afflictions of Christ for the sake of His body, which is the church,"

Col 1:26-27 (NKJV) "the mystery which has been hidden from ages and from generations, but now has been revealed to His saints. [27] To them God willed to make known what are the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles: which is Christ in you, the hope of glory."

Luke 9:23-24 (NKJV) Then He said to *them* all, "If anyone desires to come after Me, let him deny himself, and take up his cross daily, and follow Me. [24] For whoever desires to save his life will lose it, but whoever loses his life for My sake will save it."

Rom 6:3-9 (NKJV) "Or do you not know that as many of us as were baptized into Christ Jesus were **baptized into His death**? Therefore we were buried with Him through baptism into death, that just as Christ was raised from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also **should walk in newness of life**. For if we have been united together in the likeness of His death, certainly we also shall be *in the likeness* of His resurrection, howing this, that our old man was crucified with Him, that the body of sin might be done away with, that we should no longer be slaves of sin. For he who has died has been freed from sin. Now if we died with Christ, we believe that we shall also live with Him, howing that Christ, having been raised from the dead, dies no more. Death no longer has dominion over Him."

Gal 2:20 (<sub>KJV</sub>) "I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ liveth in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me."

2 Cor 5:14-15 (NKJV) [14] For the love of Christ compels us, because we judge thus: **that if One died for all, then all died**; [15] and He died for all, that those who live should live no longer for themselves, but for Him who died for them and **rose again**.

Heb 9:27 (KIV) "And as it is appointed unto men once to die, but after this the judgment:"

John 12:31 (KIV) "Now is the judgment of this world: now shall the prince of this world be cast out."

1 Pet 4:17-19 (NKJV) "For the time has come for judgment to begin at the house of God; and if it begins with us first, what will be the end of those who do not obey the gospel of God? [18] Now "If the righteous one is scarcely saved, Where will the ungodly and the sinner appear?" [19] Therefore let those who suffer according to the will of God commit their souls to Him in doing good, as to a faithful Creator."

1 Cor 11:31-32 (NKJV) "For if we would **judge** ourselves, we would not be judged. [32] But when we are judged, we are chastened by the Lord, that we may not be condemned with the world."

Eph 4:30 And grieve not the holy Spirit of God, whereby ye are sealed unto the day of redemption.

Psa 94:12 (NASB) "Blessed is the man whom You chasten, O LORD, And whom You teach out of Your law;

Jer 2:30-32 (NKJV) "In vain I have chastened your children; They received no correction. Your sword has devoured your prophets Like a destroying lion. [31] "O generation, see the word of the LORD! Have I been a wilderness to Israel, Or a land of darkness? Why do My people say, 'We are lords; We will come no more to You'? [32] Can a virgin forget her ornaments, Or a bride her attire? Yet My people have forgotten Me days without number.

Isa 26:10 (NKJV) Let grace be shown to the wicked, **Yet he will not learn righteousness**; In the land of uprightness he will deal unjustly, And will not behold the majesty of the LORD.

Mark 4:11-12 (NKJV) And He said to them, "To you it has been given to know the mystery of the kingdom of God; but to those who are outside, all things come in parables, so that 'Seeing they may see and not perceive, And hearing they may hear and not understand; Lest they should turn, And their sins be forgiven them."

Rev 21:5 (NKJV) Then He who sat on the throne said, "Behold, <u>I make all things new</u>." And He said to me, "Write, for these words are true and faithful."

Eph 4: 20-24 (NKJV) "But you have not so learned Christ, if indeed you have heard Him and have been taught by Him, as the truth is in Jesus: [22] that you put off, concerning your former conduct, the old man which grows corrupt according to the deceitful lusts, [23] and be renewed in the spirit of your mind, [24] and that you put on the new man which was created according to God, in true righteousness and holiness."

2 Cor 5:16-17 (NKJV) "Therefore, from now on, we regard no one according to the flesh. Even though we have known Christ according to the flesh, yet now we know *Him thus* no longer. [17] Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, he is a new creation; old things have passed away; behold, all things have become new."

Mark 9:49 (NKIV) "For everyone will be seasoned with fire, and every sacrifice will be seasoned with salt."

Rev 22:19-20 (NKJV) "and if anyone takes away from the words of the book of this prophecy, God shall take away his part from the Book of Life, from the holy city, and from the things which are written in this book. [20] He who testifies to these things says, "Surely I am coming quickly." Amen. Even so, come, Lord Jesus!"

1 Cor 15:48-49 ( $_{NASB}$ ) "As is the earthy, so also are those who are earthy; and as is the heavenly, so also are those who are heavenly. [49] And just as we have borne the image of the earthy, we shall also bear the image of the heavenly."

1 John 4:17 ( $_{NKJV}$ ) "Love has been perfected among us in this: that we may have boldness in the day of judgment; **because as He is, so are we in this world**."

Eccl 2:14 (NKJV) "The wise man's eyes are in his head, But the fool walks in darkness. Yet I myself perceived That the same event happens to them all."

Rev 21:1 (NKJV) "Now I saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away. Also there was no more sea."

Gen 1:9-13 (NKJV) "Then God said, "Let the <u>waters under the heavens</u> be gathered together into one place, and <u>let the dry land appear</u>"; and it was so. [10] And God called <u>the dry land Earth</u>, and the <u>gathering together of the waters</u> <u>He called Seas</u>. And God saw that it was good. [11] Then God said, "<u>Let the earth bring forth</u> grass, the herb that yields seed, and <u>the fruit tree that yields fruit according to its kind</u>, <u>whose seed is in itself</u>, on the <u>earth</u>"; and it was so. [12] And <u>the earth brought forth</u> grass, the herb that yields seed according to its kind, and <u>the tree that yields fruit</u>, <u>whose seed is in itself according to its kind</u>. And God saw that it was good. [13] So the evening and the morning were the third day."

Mark 4:13 (NKIV) And He said to them, "Do you not understand this parable? How then will you understand all the parables?

Luke 8:11 (NKJV) "Now the parable is this: The seed is the word of God."

Mat 13:4 (NKJV) And as he sowed, some *seed* fell by the wayside; and the birds came and devoured them.

Mat 13:19 (NKJV) "When anyone hears the word of the kingdom, and does not understand it, then the wicked one comes and snatches away what was sown in his heart. This is he who received seed by the wayside."

Jer 22:29 (KJV) " O earth, earth, earth, hear the word of the LORD."

Mat 7:16 (NKJV) "You will know them by their fruits. Do men gather grapes from thornbushes or figs from thistles?"

Mat 7:19 (NKJV) "Every tree that does not bear good fruit is cut down and thrown into the fire."

Jer 2:21 (NKJV) Yet I had planted you a noble vine, a seed of highest quality. How then have you turned before Me Into the degenerate plant of an alien vine?

Psa 52:8 (NKJV) But I am like a green olive tree in the house of God; I trust in the mercy of God forever and ever.

Isa 26:8-9 (NKJV) "Yes, in the way of Your judgments, O LORD, we have waited for You; The desire of *our* soul *is* for Your name And for the remembrance of You. <sup>[9]</sup> With my soul **I have desired You** in the night, Yes, by my spirit within me I will seek You early; For when Your judgments *are* in the earth, The inhabitants of the world will learn righteousness."

John 4:13-14 (NKJV) "Jesus answered and said to her, "Whoever drinks of this water [waters below] will thirst again, [14] but whoever drinks of the water [waters above] that I shall give him will never thirst. But the water that I shall give him will become in him a fountain of water springing up into everlasting life."

Rev 17:15 (NKIV) "Then he said to me, "The waters which you saw, where the harlot sits, are peoples, multitudes, nations, and tongues."

Psa 29:3 (NKJV) The voice of the LORD is over the waters; The God of glory thunders; The LORD is over many waters.

Psalm 2:1-3 (<sub>NKJV</sub>) Why do **the nations rage**, And the <u>people plot a vain thing</u>? <sup>[2]</sup> The kings of the earth set themselves, And the rulers take counsel together, <u>Against the LORD and against His Anointed</u>, *saying*, <sup>[3]</sup> "Let us break Their bonds in pieces And cast away Their cords from us."

Isa 17:12-13 (NKJV) Woe to the multitude of many people *Who* make a noise like the <u>roar of the seas</u>, And to the rushing of nations *That* make a <u>rushing like the rushing of mighty waters</u>! [13] The nations will rush like the rushing of many waters; But *God* will rebuke them and they will flee far away, And be chased like the chaff of the mountains before the wind, Like a rolling thing before the whirlwind.

2 Sam 22:16-18 (NKJV) Then the channels of the **sea** were seen, The foundations of the world were uncovered, **At the rebuke** of the **LORD**, At the blast of the breath of His nostrils. <sup>[17]</sup> "**He sent from above, He took me, He drew me out of many** waters. <sup>[18]</sup> He delivered me from my strong enemy, From those who hated me; For they were too strong for me.

Acts 4:25-28 (NKJV) "who by the mouth of Your servant David have said: 'Why did the nations rage, And the people plot vain things? The kings of the earth took their stand, And the rulers were gathered together Against the LORD and against His Christ.' To truly against Your holy Servant Jesus, whom You anointed, both Herod and Pontius Pilate, with the Gentiles and the people of Israel, were gathered together to be done."

Rev 17:18 And the woman which thou sawest is that great city, which reigneth over the kings of the earth

Exo 14:21-22 (NKJV) "Then Moses stretched out his hand over the sea; and the LORD caused the sea to go back by a strong east wind all that night, and made the sea into dry land, and the waters were divided. So the children of Israel went into the midst of the sea on the dry ground, and the waters were a wall to them on their right hand and on their left."

Exo 14:13 (NKJV) And Moses said to the people, "Do not be afraid. Stand still, and see the salvation [yeshua] of the LORD, which He will accomplish for you today. For the Egyptians whom you see today, you shall see again no more forever.

Gen 1:20-21 (NKJV) "Then God said, "Let the waters abound with an abundance of living creatures, and let birds fly above the earth across the face of the firmament of the heavens." So God created great sea whale/creatures [tannîym H8577] and every living thing that moves, with which the waters abounded, according to their kind, and every winged bird according to its kind. And God saw that *it was* good."

Mark 1:17 (NKJV) "Then Jesus said to them, "Follow Me, and I will make you become fishers of men.""

Jer 16:16 (<sub>KJV</sub>) [16] Behold, **I will send for many fishers, saith the LORD, and they shall fish them**; and after will I send for many hunters, and they shall hunt them from every mountain, and from every hill, and out of the holes of the rocks."

Mat 13:47-48 (<sub>KJV</sub>) "Again, the kingdom of heaven is like unto a net, that was cast into the sea, and gathered of every kind: [48] Which, when it was full, they drew to shore, and sat down, and gathered the good into vessels, but cast the bad away.

Psa 74:13-14 (NKJV) "You <u>divided the sea</u> by Your strength; You broke the heads of <u>the sea serpents</u> [tanniyn:H8577] in the waters. [14] You broke the heads of Leviathan in pieces, And gave him as food to the people inhabiting the wilderness."

Is a 27:1 (<sub>KJV</sub>) In that day the LORD with his sore and great and strong sword shall <u>punish leviathan</u> the <u>piercing serpent</u>, even <u>leviathan that crooked serpent</u>; and he shall slay **the dragon** [Tanniym] that is in the sea.

Ezekiel 29:3 (<sub>KJV</sub>) Speak, and say, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, I *am* against thee, Pharaoh king of Egypt, the **great dragon** [tanniyn:H8577] that lieth in the midst of his rivers, which hath said, My river *is* mine own, and I have made *it* for myself.

Mat 4:8-9 (NKJV) Again, the devil took Him up on an exceedingly high mountain, and showed Him all the kingdoms of the world and their glory. [9] And he said to Him, "All these things I will give You if You will fall down and worship me."

Rev 12:9 And the great dragon was cast out, that old serpent, called the Devil, and Satan, which deceive the whole world: he was cast out into the earth, and his angels were cast out with him.

Mat 13:4 (NKJV) And as he sowed, some seed fell by the wayside; and the birds came and devoured them... [19] When anyone hears the word of the kingdom, and does not understand it, then the wicked one comes and snatches away what was sown in his heart. This is he who received seed by the wayside.

Mat 23:15 (<sub>KJV</sub>) Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye **compass sea and land** to make one proselyte, and when he is made, ye make him **twofold more the child of hell than yourselves**.

Rev 17:1 ( $_{KJV}$ ) And there came one of the seven angels which had the seven vials, and talked with me, saying unto me, Come hither; I will shew unto thee the judgment of the great whore that sitteth upon many waters,

Rev 17:15 ( $_{KJV}$ ) And he saith unto me, The waters which thou sawest, where the whore sitteth, are peoples, and multitudes, and nations, and tongues.

John 6:63-64 (NKJV) It is the Spirit who gives life; the flesh profits nothing. The words that I speak to you are spirit, and they are life. [64] But there are some of you who do not believe." For Jesus knew from the beginning who they were who did not believe, and who would betray Him.
