Lesson 17 Genesis 2 Wisdom & Understanding The Tree of Life Part 2

Prov 15:33 (NKJV) "The fear of the LORD is the instruction of wisdom, And before honor is humility."

Prov 11:2 (NKJV) "When pride comes, then comes shame; But with the humble is wisdom."

Psa 19:7 (NKJV) "The law of the LORD is perfect, converting the soul; The testimony of the LORD is sure, making wise the simple;"

Rev 19:10 (NKJV) "And I fell at his feet to worship him. But he said to me, "See *that you do* not *do that!* I am your fellow servant, and of your brethren who have the testimony of Jesus. Worship God! For the testimony of Jesus is the spirit of prophecy.""

John 6:63 (NKJV) ""<u>It is the Spirit who gives life</u>; the flesh profits nothing. <u>The words that I speak to you are spirit</u>, and *they* are life."

Gen 2:9-10 (KJV) "And out of the ground made the LORD God to grow every tree that is pleasant to the sight, and good for food; the tree of life also in the midst of the garden, and the tree of knowledge of good and evil. [10] And a river went out of Eden to water the garden; and from thence it was parted, and became into four heads."

Prov 3:13-19 "Blessed is the man who finds wisdom, the man who gains understanding, [14] for she is more profitable than silver and yields better returns than gold. [15] She is more precious than rubies; nothing you desire can compare with her. [16] Long life is in her right hand; in her left hand are riches and honor. [17] Her ways are pleasant ways, and all her paths are peace. [18] She is a tree of life to those who embrace her; those who lay hold of her will be blessed. [19] By wisdom the LORD laid the earth's foundations, by understanding he set the heavens in place;"

Prov 9:1-6 (NKJV) "Wisdom has built her house, She has hewn out her seven pillars; [2] She has slaughtered her meat, She has mixed her wine, She has also furnished her table. [3] She has sent out her maidens, She cries out from the highest places of the city, [4] "Whoever is simple, let him turn in here!" As for him who lacks understanding, she says to him, [5] "Come, eat of my bread And drink of the wine I have mixed. [6] Forsake foolishness and live, And go in the way of understanding."

2 Cor 3:5 (NKJV) "Not that we are sufficient of ourselves to think of anything as being from ourselves, but our sufficiency is from God,"

John 2:19 (NKJV) "Jesus answered and said to them, "Destroy this temple, and in three days <u>I will raise it up</u>... [21] But He was speaking of the <u>temple of His body</u>.""

Exo 36:1 (KJV) "Then wrought <u>Bezaleel</u> and <u>Aholiab</u>, and <u>every wise hearted man</u>, in <u>whom the LORD put wisdom and understanding</u> to know how to work all manner of work for the service of the sanctuary, according to all that the LORD had commanded."

Acts 7:48-50 (NKJV) ""However, the Most High does not dwell in temples made with hands, as the prophet says: [49] 'Heaven is My throne, And earth is My footstool. What house will you build for Me? says the LORD, Or what is the place of My rest? [50] Has My hand not made all these things?" (Isa 66:1-2; Psalm 102:25)

Acts 17:24-25 (NKJV) ""God, who made the world and everything in it, since He is Lord of heaven and earth, **does not dwell in temples made with hands**. [25] "**Nor is He worshiped with men's hands**, as though He needed anything, since He gives to all life, breath, and all things."

1 Cor 2:7 (NKJV) "But we speak the wisdom of God in a mystery, the hidden wisdom which God ordained before the ages for our glory,"

1 Cor 1:24 (NKJV) "but to those who are called, both Jews and Greeks, Christ the power of God and the wisdom of God."

Mark 2:28 (NKJV) ""Therefore the Son of Man is also Lord of the Sabbath.""

Exo 33:12-15 (NKJV) "Then Moses said to the LORD, "See, You say to me, 'Bring up this people.' But You have not let me know whom You will send with me. Yet You have said, 'I know you by name, and you have also found grace in My sight.' [13] "Now therefore, I pray, if I have found grace in Your sight, show me now Your way, that I may know You and that I may find grace in Your sight. And consider that this nation is Your people." [14] And He said, "My Presence will go with you, and I will give you rest. [15] Then he said to Him, "If Your Presence does not go with us, do not bring us up from here.""

Mat 11:28-30 (NKJV) ""Come to Me, all *you* who labor and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest. [29] "Take My yoke upon you and learn from Me, for I am gentle and lowly in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. [30] "For My yoke is easy and My burden is light.""

Col 1:26-27 (NKJV) "the mystery which has been hidden from ages and from generations, but now has been revealed to His saints. [27] To them God willed to make known what are the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles: which is Christ in you, the hope of glory."

Eph 2:20-22 (NKJV) "having been built on the foundation of the apostles and prophets, <u>Jesus Christ Himself being the chief corner stone</u>, [21] in whom the whole building, being joined together, <u>grows into a holy temple in the Lord</u>, [22] in whom you also are being built together for a dwelling place of God in the Spirit."

Col 2:3-4 (NKJV) "in whom are hidden all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge. [4] Now this I say lest anyone should deceive you with persuasive words."

1 Cor 2:5 (NKJV) "that your **faith** should **not be in the wisdom of men** but in the power of God."

Eph 1:7-8 (NIV) "In him we have redemption through his blood, the forgiveness of sins, in accordance with **the riches of God's grace** [8] that **he lavished on us with all wisdom and understanding**."

Deu 13:1-4 (NKJV) ""If there arises among you a prophet or a dreamer of dreams, and he gives you a <u>sign or a wonder</u>, [2] "and the sign or the wonder comes to pass, of which he spoke to you, saying, 'Let us go after other gods'; which you have not known; 'and let us serve them,' [3] "you shall not listen to the words of that prophet or that dreamer of dreams, for the LORD your God is testing you to know whether you love the LORD your God with all your heart and with all your soul. [4] "You shall walk after the LORD your God and fear Him, and keep His commandments and obey His voice, and you shall serve Him and hold fast to Him."

Psa 119:105 (NKJV) "Your word is a lamp to my feet And a light to my path."

Prov 6:23 (NKJV) "For the commandment is a lamp, And the law a light; Reproofs of instruction are the way of life,"

Prov 13:12-14 (NKJV) "Hope deferred makes the heart sick, But when the desire comes, it is a tree of life. [13] He who despises the word will be destroyed, But he who fears the commandment will be rewarded. [14] The law [Torah] of the wise is a fountain of life, To turn one away from the snares of death. [15] Good understanding gains favor [chen H2580 = grace], But the way of the unfaithful is hard."

Prov 18:4 (NKJV) "The words of a man's mouth are deep waters; The wellspring of wisdom is a flowing brook."

Rev 12:15 (NKJV) "So <u>the serpent spewed water out of his mouth</u> like a flood after the woman, that he might cause her to be carried away by the flood."

Psa 37:30-32 (NKJV) "The mouth of the righteous speaks wisdom, And his tongue talks of justice. [31] The law of his God is in his heart; None of his steps shall slide. [32] The wicked watches the righteous, And seeks to slay him."

Prov 15:4 (NKJV) "A wholesome tongue is a tree of life, But perverseness in it breaks the spirit."

Rom 7:20-21 (NKJV) "Now if I do what I will not *to do*, it is no longer I who do it, but sin that dwells in me. [21] I find then a law, that evil is present with me, the one who wills to do good."

Prov 18:21 (NKJV) "Death and life are in the power of the tongue, And those who love it will eat its fruit."

Rom 2:13 (NKJV) "(for not the hearers of the law are just in the sight of God, but the doers of the law will be justified;"

James 1:22 (NKJV) "But be doers of the word, and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves."

Gal 3:21 (NKJV) "Is the law then against the promises of God? Certainly not! For if there had been a law given which could have given life, truly righteousness would have been by the law."

Luke 2:40 (NKJV) "And the Child grew and became strong in spirit, filled with wisdom; and the grace of God was upon Him."

Luke 2:52 (KJV) "And Jesus increased in wisdom and stature, and in favour with God and man."

Job 28:12-28 (NKJV) ""But where can wisdom be found? And where is the place of understanding? [13] Man does not know its value, Nor is it found in the land of the living. [14] The deep says, 'It is not in me'; And the sea says, 'It is not with me.' [15] It cannot be purchased for gold, Nor can silver be weighed for its price. [16] It cannot be valued in the gold of Ophir, In precious onyx or sapphire. [17] Neither gold nor crystal can equal it, Nor can it be exchanged for jewelry of fine gold. [18] No mention shall be made of coral or quartz, For the price of wisdom is above rubies. [19] The topaz of Ethiopia cannot equal it, Nor can it be valued in pure gold. [20] "From where then does wisdom come? And where is the place of understanding? [21] It is hidden from the eyes of all living, And concealed from the birds of the air. [22] Destruction and Death say, 'We have heard a report about it with our ears.' [23] God understands its way, And He knows its place. [24] For He looks to the ends of the earth, And sees under the whole heavens, [25] To establish a weight for the wind, And apportion the waters by measure. [26] When He made a law for the rain, And a path for the thunderbolt, [27] Then He saw wisdom and declared it; He prepared it, indeed, He searched it out. [28] And to man He said, 'Behold, the fear of the Lord, that is wisdom, And to depart from evil is understanding.""

Rev 19:13 (NKJV) "He was clothed with a robe dipped in blood, and **His name is called The Word of God.**"

Prov 2:1-10 (NKJV) "My son, if you receive my words, And treasure my commands within you, [2] So that you incline your ear to wisdom, And apply your heart to understanding; [3] Yes, if you cry out for discernment, And lift up your voice for understanding, [4] If you seek her as silver, And search for her as for hidden treasures; [5] Then you will understand the fear of the LORD, And find the knowledge of God. [6] For the LORD gives wisdom; From His mouth come knowledge and understanding; [7] He stores up sound wisdom for the upright; He is a shield to those who walk uprightly; [8] He guards the paths of justice, And preserves the way of His saints. [9] Then you will understand righteousness and justice, Equity and every good path. [10] When wisdom enters your heart, And knowledge is pleasant to your soul,"

Prov 4:5 (NKJV) "Get wisdom! Get understanding! Do not forget, nor turn away from the words of my mouth."

Prov 4:10-13 (NKJV) "Hear, my son, and receive my sayings, And the years of your life will be many. [11] I have taught you in the way of wisdom; I have led you in right paths. [12] When you walk, your steps will not be hindered, And when you run, you will not stumble. [13] Take firm hold of instruction, do not let go; Keep her, for she is your life."

Deu 4:5-6 (NKJV) ""Surely I have taught you statutes and judgments, just as the LORD my God commanded me, that you should act according to them in the land which you go to possess. [6] "Therefore be careful to observe them; for this is your wisdom and your understanding in the sight of the peoples who will hear all these statutes, and say, 'Surely this great nation is a wise and understanding people."

Prov 8:20 (KJV) "I lead in the way of righteousness, in the midst of the paths of judgment:"

Prov 8:7-8 (NKJV) "For my mouth will speak <u>truth</u>; Wickedness *is* an abomination to my lips. [8] All the words of my mouth *are* with righteousness; Nothing crooked or perverse *is* in them."

Prov 8:35 (NKJV) "For whoever finds me finds life, And obtains favor from the LORD;"

John 14:6 (NKJV) "Jesus said to him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me."

Prov 16:15-16 (NKJV) "In the light of the king's face is life, And his favor is like a cloud of the latter rain. [16] How much better to get wisdom than gold! And to get understanding is to be chosen rather than silver."

John 1:4-5 (NKJV) "In Him was life, and the life was the light of men. [5] And the light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not comprehend it."

Rom 11:36 (NKJV) "For of Him and through Him and to Him are all things, to whom be glory forever. Amen."

Psa 1:1-3 (NKJV) "Blessed *is* the man Who walks not in the counsel of the ungodly, Nor stands in the path of sinners, Nor sits in the seat of the scornful; [2] But his delight *is* in the law of the LORD, And in His law he meditates day and night. [3] He shall be like a tree Planted by the rivers of water, That brings forth its fruit in its season, Whose leaf also shall not wither; And whatever he does shall prosper."

Jer 17:7-8 (NKJV) ""Blessed is the man who trusts in the LORD, And whose hope is the LORD. [8] For he shall be like a tree planted by the waters, Which spreads out its roots by the river, And will not fear when heat comes; But its leaf will be green, And will not be anxious in the year of drought, Nor will cease from yielding fruit."

Titus 1:14-16 (NKJV) "not giving heed to Jewish fables and **commandments of men who turn from the truth**. [15] To the pure all things are pure, but to those who are defiled and unbelieving nothing is pure; but even their mind and conscience are defiled. [16] **They profess to know God**, but in works they deny Him, being abominable, disobedient, and disqualified for every good work."

Rom 15:4 (NKJV) "For whatever things were written before were written for our learning, that we through the patience and comfort of the Scriptures might have **hope**."

Rom 15:18 (NKJV) "For I will not dare to speak of any of those things which Christ has not accomplished through me, in word and deed, **to make the Gentiles obedient**;"

Hosea 7:10 (NKJV) "And the pride of Israel testifies to his face, But they do not return to the LORD their God, Nor seek Him for all this."

Hosea 10:13 (NKJV) "You have plowed wickedness; You have reaped iniquity. You have eaten the fruit of lies, Because you trusted in your own way, In the multitude of your mighty men."

Neh 9:28-29 (NKJV) ""But after they had rest, They again did evil before You. Therefore You left them in the hand of their enemies, So that they had dominion over them; Yet when they returned and cried out to You, You heard from heaven; And many times You delivered them according to Your mercies, [29] And testified against them, That You might bring them back to Your law. Yet they acted proudly, And did not heed Your commandments, But sinned against Your judgments, 'Which if a man does, he shall live by them.' And they shrugged their shoulders, Stiffened their necks, And would not hear."

Jer 8:8-9 (NKJV) ""How can you say, 'We are wise, And the law of the LORD is with us'? Look, the false pen of the scribe certainly works falsehood. [9] The wise men are ashamed, They are dismayed and taken. Behold, they have rejected the word of the LORD; So what wisdom do they have?"

Rev 2:7 (NKJV) ""He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches. **To him who overcomes I** will give to eat from the tree of life, which is in the midst of the Paradise of God.""
